

RULES FOR HAPPY CAMPING

REGISTRATION: Please register and pay upon arrival. Registration hours depend on the season. If you are arriving later, please let us know so we can leave instructions and directions to your site.

CHECK-IN: Check-ins and visitors must stop at office.

CHECK-OUT: Check-out times are 12:00 noon for campsites and 11:00 a.m. for cabins and other lodging units. Please return keys to office.

CAMPSITE MANNERS: Campsites are inspected for cleanliness during and after each occupancy. Please keep your site neat. Please "strip" all cigarette butts and place them with other trash, in trash cans located throughout the campground. Volume for radios, TVs, etc., is for your site only. Quiet hours are observed from 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. and weekends from 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. Firecrackers and noisemakers are NOT PERMITTED. Keep all hook-ups on gravel as much as possible. Please no lights, poles, etc., in grass. You are responsible to take trash to dumpsters.

CARPETS/RUGS: No Carpets/rugs on grass next to rigs.

CABIN RENTALS: Our cabins are smoke-free facilities. NO PETS are allowed in the cabins. Please do not remove any items from the cabin. Leave your linens and towels, for the cabins that have them, inside the cabin so our cleaners can pick them up after your stay. TV with Wi-Fi. • NOTE TO WINTER CAMPERS: Please do not turn the heat off when you leave the cabin, and please leave a little water running in the sink upon departure.

UTILITIES: Hook-ups of 20, 30 and 50 amps are available. • NOTE TO WINTER CAMPERS: Our water system provides water to your site year-round, however, in severe cold, please fill your tank and disconnect your hose so that it will not freeze and cause your lines and ours to burst. Use one connection to the post and everything else should be hooked up through your RV. High speed Wi-Fi for streaming. TV service available direct from local provider.

CAMPFIRES: Please confine fires to fire rings at each site. Do not leave fires unattended. Firewood in convenient bundles is available at our "Trading Post" camp store at low prices. Please feel free to use fire rings for campfires, but do not change fire ring locations! Be sure to tend your fire carefully, for safety's sake. Do not burn any limbs that do not fit inside ring.

BATHHOUSES AND LAUNDRY: We appreciate the many compliments we receive on our bathhouses. Flush-toilets, hot showers, and laundry facilities are provided and maintained for your comfort and convenience. Our hot water is free (no "quarter meters"), so we ask you to be considerate and keep our costs down by limiting your showers to 3-5 minutes. Dishwashing is prohibited in the bathhouses, but there is a dishwashing station located behind the upper bathhouse. Quarters for the laundry machines are available at the office. Do not adjust, unplug, or turn off heat in the bathhouses. It is regulated for your convenience. Please help us to keep our bathhouses neat and clean, so that everyone can enjoy them. Report any problems to campground personnel or to the office immediately. WE GREATLY APPRECIATE YOUR HELP AND CONSIDERATION.

TRADING POST: For the benefit of our guests, the Trading Post offers bundled firewood, ice, limited groceries, camping supplies and a selection of other items. Hours vary, depending on the season. Borrow and return all sports items in the office.

PETS: Pets love camping, and we love pets! Please keep them leashed and under control at all times. Do not leave your pet unattended. You must clean up after your pet. NO PETS are allowed in the cabins.

VEHICLES: Please obey the speed limit of 10 MPH. Violators may be asked to leave without refunds. **One vehicle per site**, please. Fee for additional vehicle. There are parking areas available for additional vehicles. Please be respectful of the sites when parking your vehicle, including the grass, and only drive on the roads. Be careful where you drive large or low clearance vehicles. We charge to tow. Washing vehicles is NOT PERMITTED! We do NOT allow vehicle/ev charging on the property.

RESPECT THE ENVIRONMENT: Please do not chop, saw, strip or trample any trees or shrubs. Nothing should be pounded into or hung on a tree. Do not hang hammocks outside of your site.


CHILDREN AND GUESTS: You are responsible for the actions and safety of children and guests using or visiting your campsite or cabin. This includes any damages. Young children should always be accompanied by an adult.

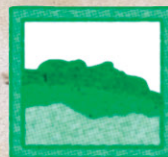
COMPUTER CONNECTION: The Wi-Fi Hotspot is the GCG-PUBLIC network.


