# General Information

## FOR EVERYONE'S ENJOYMENT, PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING RULES

**GUESTS AND VISITORS:** Everyone entering campground must register at the office.

**CHECK-OUT TIME:** 12:00 noon.

**RESTROOMS:** We try to keep our restrooms "just like home." Please help us keep them this way.

**WATER:** Please help us practice good water conservation habits and be sure that no one in your family lets water run when not necessary.

**QUIET HOURS:** Night Owls and Early Birds, please note: Quiet hours are 11:30 PM to 7:30 AM. No noise please. Please be considerate of your fellow campers.

**LITTER:** Keep your campsite litter-free, including cigarette butts.

**SPEED LIMIT:** No more than 5 MPH on all roads. Please watch for pedestrians and our resident birds and wildlife.

No parking or driving on the grass.

**POOL:** Open year-round. No lifeguard on duty. Swimwear and swim diapers only. Children under 16 must be accompanied.

**VEHICLE POLICY:** Contact office before washing any vehicle, motorhome or trailer. Vehicle repairs not permitted without permission. ATVs & Golf Carts welcome with permit.

**TREES AND OTHER VEGETATION:** A \$100.00 fine will be assessed for removal or cutting of trees or plants without permission from the office.

**CAMPFIRES:** Are allowed in fire rings. Firewood is for sale at the office.

**PETS:** Keep pets on leash no longer than 6 feet except in designated areas. Please clean up after your pets immediately. No pet shall be left unattended. No pets (except for service animals) are permitted in park buildings, store, restrooms, laundry, pool area or playground.

## Lake Corpus Christi

In January, 1929, Lake Lovenskoild was created with the construction of La Fruita Dam across the Nueces River approximately 35 miles upstream from Calallen. This dam washed out in 1929, was rebuilt in 1935 and the name was changed to Lake Corpus Christi. As the new reservoir lost storage capacity from silting and consumer demand continued to accelerate, it became evident that a new dam and reservoir were needed. After a great deal of opposition to the new dam by the owners of land in the reservoir area, Wesley Seale Dam was completed in 1958.

Lake Corpus Christi is one of the largest artificial bodies of fresh water in Texas. It is 21,000 acres in area with a capacity of 300,000 acre-feet at a spillway elevation of 94 feet above mean sea level. The dam is designed to be raised 10 feet sometime in the future, which would increase lake area to 33,100 acres and capacity to 575,000 acre-feet.

## To Our Guests...

Our campground is located on a truly unique property. As a wildlife preserve, it abounds with a myriad of wildlife that considers Texas its home. While roaming the grounds, you may encounter Wild Turkeys, Pelicans, Spoonbills, Javelina and Armadillo, to name just a few of the birds and animals which are natural to Texas.

Our campground is the site of an ancient Indian campground and is a Texas Archaeological Landmark as designated by the Texas Antiquities Committee. Our artifact collection, begun in 1983, tells part of the story of the people who inhabited this area during various historical periods. Study of the collection helps lead us to a greater insight concerning their cultures and lifestyles. The oldest artifacts could be as much as 11,000 years old, according to the Assistant State Archaeologist.

We certainly hope that during your stay here, you'll take the opportunity to see and enjoy all of our forty-seven acres and two miles of lakeshore.
