## Activities and Facilities

**Camping** — Check-in is between 1pm and 10pm. Check-out is before 12pm.

The campground offers 35 developed sites with water and electrical hook-ups including eight platform sites for tents only. Two comfort stations with hot showers, flush toilets, and a sanitary disposal station are provided. Reservations are accepted up to 13 months in advance.

**Bluebird Cottage** — A four bedroom cottage located on the golf course available for golf packages and getaways. Check-in not guaranteed until 4pm and check-out is at 11am. Call the park office for check-in procedures.

**Biking** — Bikes are welcome on all park roads and trails, with the exception of Victoria's Path. All riders under the age of 16 must wear a helmet.

**Pioneer Camping** — Organized groups may use the large pioneer campground. They offer water spigots, restrooms, showers, Adirondack shelters, five large elevated tent platforms, lantern posts, a picnic shelter and storage. Reservations are allowed up to 14 months in advance.

**Picnicking** — Facilities include 100 picnic tables and five shelters in the day-use area. Shelters can be reserved up to 14 months in advance.

**Fishing** — Two seasonal fishing ponds are located in the park. Persons age 16 or older must have a valid resident/non-resident fishing license. Due to restocking both ponds are closed for fishing during the months of December thru April.

**Swimming** — A swimming pool and bathhouse are open seasonally. Call the office for pool hours. The pool is closed on Monday and Tuesday. Call the Park office to schedule pool parties. Qualified lifeguards are on duty. An admission fee is required.

**Hiking** — The half-mile Victoria's Path Nature Trail, 3.2-mile Perimeter Trail, 3.5-mile Broad River Loop Trail and 2.3-mile Inner Loop Trail offer a variety of hiking experiences.

**Golf** — An 18-hole golf course and driving range are available for public play. The pro shop rents golf carts, pull carts and clubs. Tee times are recommended.

**Playgrounds** — There are three playgrounds in the park: two in the day-use area and one in the campground (for campers' use only). Adults should supervise young children at all times.

**Archery Range** — 7 static targets and 25 3D targets. Guests must carry a purchased pass with them while shooting on the range. A parking fee is required. No broadheads allowed.

**Directions to St. Mary's Sacred Heart:**

At park entrance, make a left turn onto Hwy 327. Travel approximately 2 miles until you reach the four (4) way stop at Hwy 327 & Hwy 51. Go straight through the four way, and continue straight on Hwy 327, until Hwy 327 dead ends into GA 17. Take a left onto GA 17 (going towards Lavonia). At first red light (downtown Lavonia), take a left onto Hwy 59 and go approximately one mile. Turn right onto Clear Creek Parkway, which dead ends into St. Mary's Sacred Heart.
