Recreational Activities

-  **CAMPING:** In addition to the family camping area, a primitive camping area is available for organized groups. Please call the Ranger Station for primitive site reservations.
-  **SWIMMING:** Daytime swimming is provided in the clear natural spring which is 68 to 72 degrees Fahrenheit or 20 to 22 degrees Celsius year round. Scuba diving is not allowed.
-  **FISHING:** Largemouth bass, bluegill and redbreast sunfish may be caught in the Wekiwa River and Rock Springs Run. Because of the swampy shorelines and overhanging vegetation, a canoe or rowboat is needed to gain access to the most productive areas. A Florida freshwater fishing license is required for persons 16 years of age or older.
-  **PADDLING:** Canoes and kayaks may be launched from a sandy beach downstream from the footbridge on the south side of the Wekiwa River.
-  **CONCESSION:** A concession provides a range of food and beverages, canoe and kayak rentals, gifts and merchandise. For concession questions, please call 407-884-4311.
-  **HIKING TRAIL:** The diversity of the park's plant communities and upland wildlife can best be seen while walking the 13 miles of hiking trails. QR maps are available at the Ranger Station, Sand Lake and Spring trailheads.
-  **HORSE TRAIL:** An 8.5-mile day use horseback riding trail is available for those wishing to ride their own horses. A fenced parking area provides horse-trailer convenience. Proof of negative coggins is required.
-  **ACCESSIBILITY:** Some facilities and activities are accessible to all. If you require any special accommodations during your visit, please notify park staff.

Park Rules & Regulations


1. Be bear aware. Feeding bears, either by direct handouts or by leaving garbage, barbecue grills, pet food and bird feeders outside, leads to problems with bears.
2. All plants, animals and park property are protected. Collection, destruction, disturbance, or feeding of wildlife is prohibited.
3. Park hours are 8:00 AM to sunset. Check-in time is after 3:00 PM. Check-out is 1:00 PM.
4. Quiet time is 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM and is to be observed by all campers.
5. A campsite may be occupied by one family or group of up to 8 people. No person under 18 years of age will be allowed to camp without a mature, responsible adult present.
6. A camping rig or tent is required for family campsite occupancy. All camping equipment must be contained within the boundary of the site and must not encroach on buffer areas or the roadway.
7. Stays in camping areas shall be limited to 14 days.
8. Well-mannered pets are permitted in the campground. Pets must be confined or leashed and under the physical control of a person at all times. Owners are responsible for clean-up.
9. Rule 62-D of the Florida Statutes is applicable.
10. Reservations for campsites can be made up to 11 months in advance. For reservations, please call Reserve America at 1-800-326-3521, or reserve online at Reserve.FloridaStateParks.org
11. Collection of downed wood or any plant material is prohibited. Fires are permitted in fire rings only and must be attended at all times. Firewood is available at the Ranger Station.
12. Dumping of grey water at campsites is prohibited. A dump station is located near the campground entrance for all campers who do not have sewer connections.
13. Do not attach anything to trees, standpipes or electrical boxes. Clotheslines are provided at some campsites.

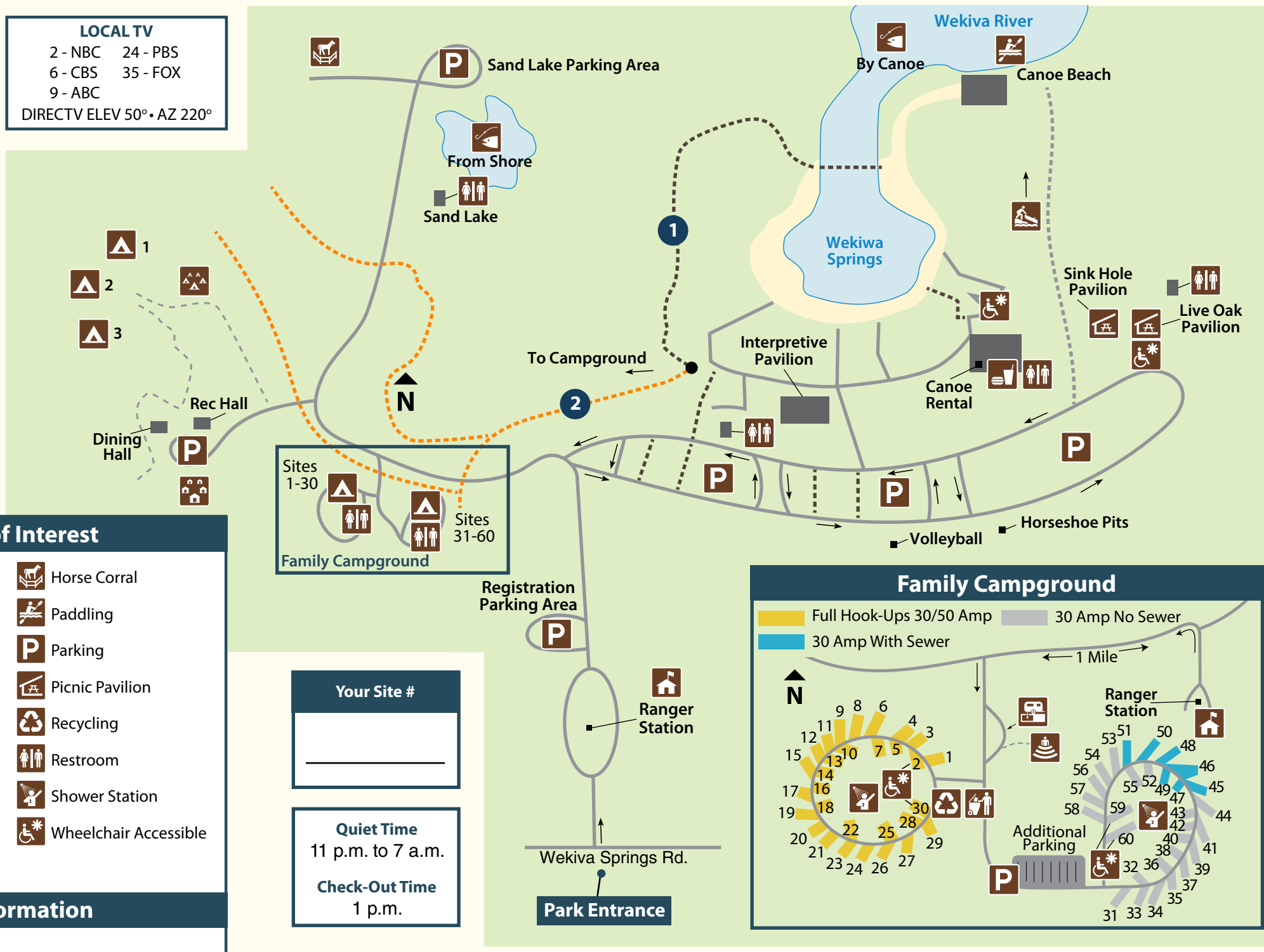
