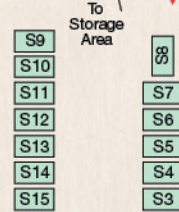

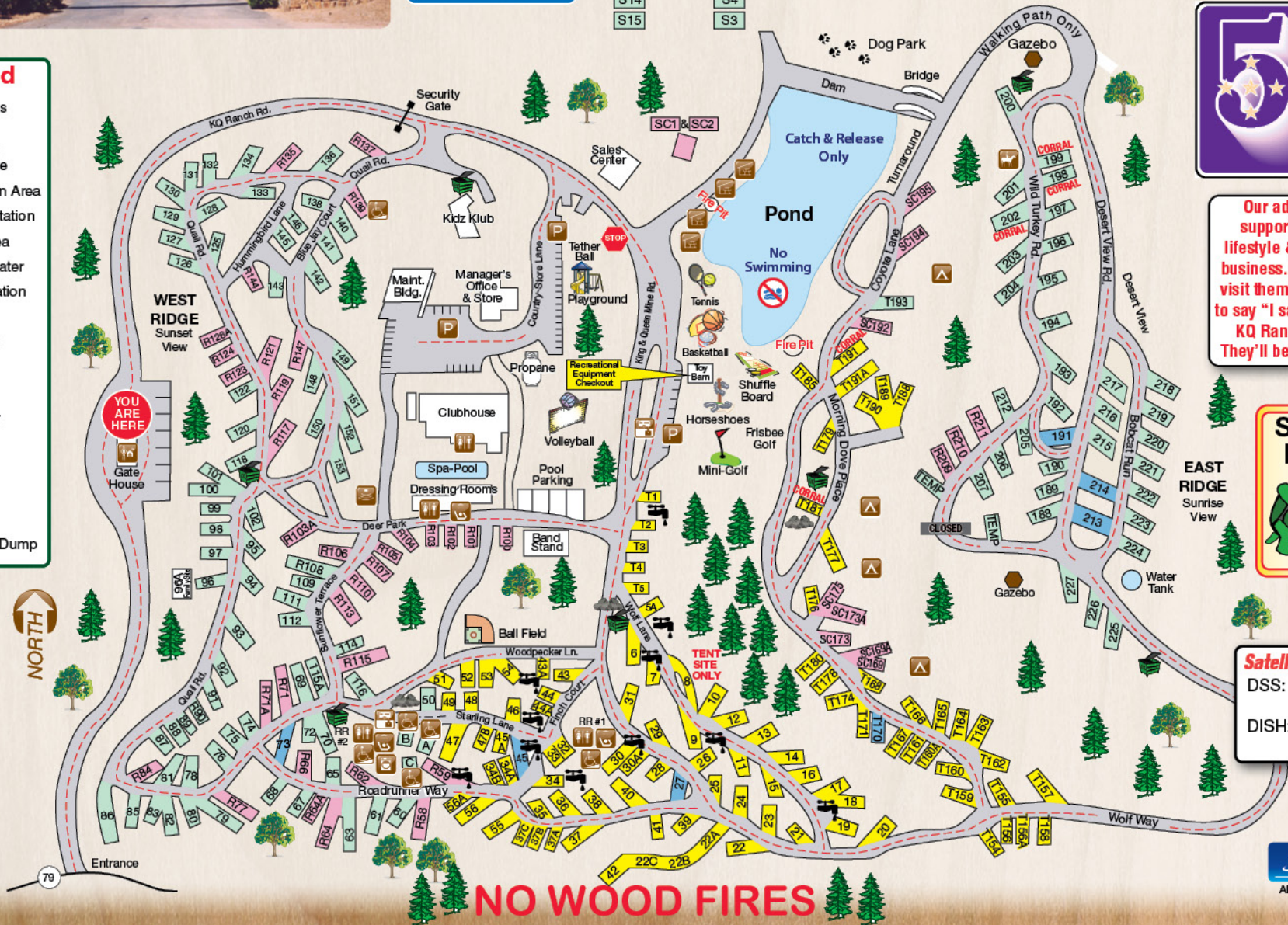

HISTORY OF JULIAN & K.Q. RANCH

Named for the King and Queen Mines-rich gold strikes discovered in 1888, K.Q. Ranch holds claim to part of the colorful history of the Julian District. Joseph Hamilton, R.G. Melrose, and F.E. Feeler made the first gold finds in the K.Q. Ranch area, tapping a vein that breathed life back into Julian mining ventures.

Although the Spanish had noted gold washing down from the mountains as early as 1602, the discovery of placer gold in Julian by A.E. (Fred) Coleman in 1869 sparked San Diego County's real gold rush. That same year the Bailey brothers and their cousins, the Julians, arrived from Georgia to seek



their fortune. Estimates of the total value of gold taken from the Julian District range from five to thirteen million dollars.

No less an attraction to Julian than gold, apple trees, first planted in the 1870s, draw visitors to enjoy the produce of area farmers. An active community, Julian area residents and businesses work hard to make this a great place to enjoy country living any time of the year. To learn more about the fascinating history and geology of Julian and the Cuyamacas, visit the museums of the Julian Historical Society and Cuyamaca Rancho State Park.

K.Q. DO'S AND DON'TS

For complete K.Q. Ranch guidelines and resort rules, please obtain a copy of RESORT INFORMATION at the Country Store. We would like to briefly emphasize the following:

- Limit speed to 10 MPH.
- Back into campsites per fire code.
- Make sure children in your party are supervised.
- Keep noise to a reasonable level at all times.
Quiet time from 10 PM to 8 AM.
- Always leash pets and pick up after them.
- **Wood fires are not permitted.** Propane fire pits accepted.
- Advance reservations for members and guests are required.
Remember: Members are always responsible for their guests and must stay in the park during their guests' stay.
- Maximum occupancy per site is one RV with one tent or two tents without RV. Maximum of 10 people in a member's site, six in a member's guest site.
- Only two (2) motorized vehicles per campsite.
- Don't park extra vehicles in unoccupied campsites!
Use designated parking areas.
- Don't let dogs bark excessively or leave them unattended.
- Don't attach clotheslines, tents or awnings to our trees.
Lights are okay.
- No smoking and no pets (service pets excluded) in any public resort buildings, i.e. Store, Clubhouse, Pool Area, etc.

K.Q. RANCH RESORT AMENITIES

- Open year round only to members and their guests.
- Large clubhouse with fireplace, TV, pool table and meals.
- Swimming pool and Jacuzzi open year round. Children under 14 not permitted in Jacuzzi.
- Over 200 sites, mostly full hook-up.
- Miniature golf, children's playgrounds, horseshoe pits, baseball, volleyball, tetherball, frisbee golf, shuffleboard and tennis courts.
- Pine trees, oaks and clean air at over 4,600 feet elevation.
- Security gate.
- Country store for your shopping needs.
- Kitchen planned meals.
- Laundry facilities.
- Barbecues and picnic tables.
- Secluded from the highway but only four miles to Lake Cuyamaca and four miles to the beautiful and historic little town of Julian.
- RV storage upon availability.
- Cottage, Cabin & Trailer, and Studio Cabin rentals for members.
- Horse corrals available for members.
- Kidz Klub crafts and fun for everyone.
- Toy Barn for equipment check out.
- 30 Amp park
