

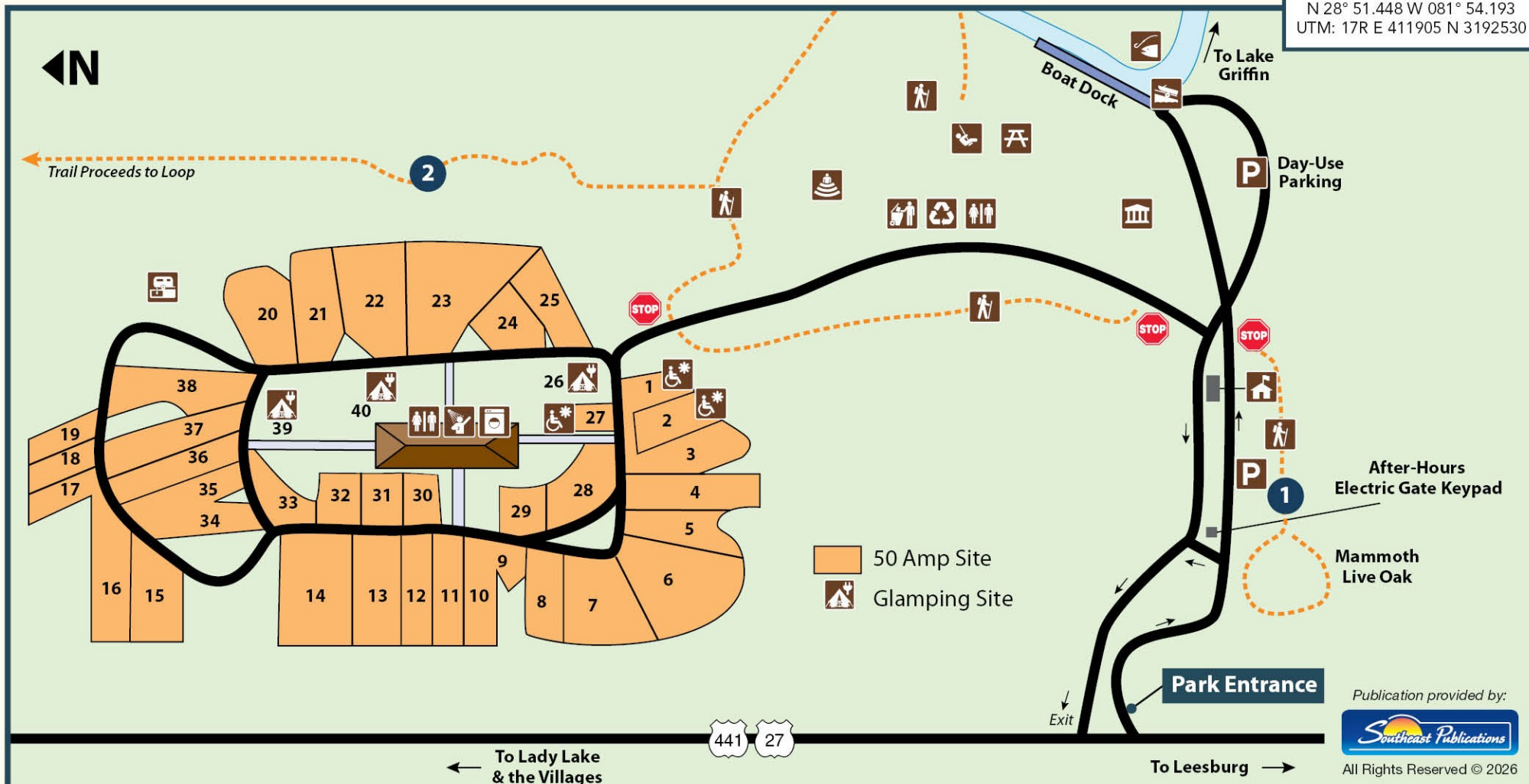

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Park Rules

1. The park is open 8 a.m. until sunset daily.
2. Check-in is 3 p.m. Check out is 1 p.m.
Quiet time is 11 p.m. to 7 a.m.
3. If you are looking to extend your stay, please contact the ranger station before 10 a.m. on or before your departure date.
4. When the park is closed, please use the keypad to re-enter the park. The code is on the hang-tag you were given upon check-in. Code is also needed for access to the restrooms. Do not give out code or allow others entry into the park or restrooms.
5. Only eight persons and one RV/camping rig and two passenger vehicles are permitted on each campsite. All equipment must fit on the site and not encroach onto vegetation, roadway or neighboring sites. Extra passenger vehicles may be parked at the day-use parking lot adjacent to the boat ramp. When parking cars in the day use parking lot, please leave camper hang-tag visible in the windshield.
6. No maintenance (washing, mechanical repairs, oil changes, painting, etc.) of vehicles or camping rigs allowed.
7. Boats are not to be left in the water overnight.
8. Appliances that are kept outside the camping rig or require a separate hook-up are not permitted.
9. A trash dumpster is located on the camp drive as you exit the campground. A recycling bin for aluminum cans is located next to the trash dumpster.
10. Collection of downed wood is prohibited. This includes tree branches, twigs and leaves.
11. Only firewood produced in Florida and within a 50-mile radius of the park may enter the park. Oak firewood is available for purchase at the ranger station. Please do not burn anything other than firewood in your fire ring.
12. Coin operated washers/dryers are located on the south end of the bathhouse. Change is available at the ranger station.
13. Please help keep our trees healthy by not hanging, tying, taping or attaching anything on vegetation. Metal lantern posts are present in each site. Any type of digging is prohibited.
14. Pets are welcome in our campground. Pets must be well behaved and under your physical control at all times. Leashes may not exceed six feet in length. Leaving your pet unattended in camping rig or tethered outside your rig longer than 30 minutes is prohibited. Please pick up after your pet.
15. Pets are not allowed in any building.
16. Do not feed or harass wildlife.
17. Bicyclists under 16 years of age are required to wear a helmet.
18. Display or open consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
19. Electric or motorized toys are prohibited.
20. Swimming, wading and splash pools are not permitted.
