GUIDELINES FOR YOUR COMFORT AND PROTECTION

The customer is responsible for reading and abiding by park rules.

- **Check-Out:** 11:00 AM.
*Please come to office by 10:00 AM to request extended days or late check-out. Due to incoming reservations, it may not be possible to honor these requests.
- **Visitors:** All visitors must register at the office and use the overflow parking area. Registered campers are responsible for their guests' behavior at all times. **Visitors must depart by 9:00 PM.**
- **Site Occupancy:** Fire code states occupancy standards must be followed. Contact the office if you are unsure about the site occupancy, about the additional person fee and to ensure all people are accounted for on your site.
- **Parking:** 2 car maximum per site. Additional cars must park in the overflow parking and may incur additional fees.
- **No Fireworks, firearms or explosives permitted to be discharged on the property.**
- **Pool:** For registered guests only. Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult. No lifeguard. No glass allowed. Follow all posted rules.
- **River Access:** Use river access points found on the map, not through the other people's tent sites. Swim at your own risk.
- **Playground:** Follow all posted rules. Play at your own risk. Playground closes at dusk or by quiet hours, whichever comes first.
- **Bikes:** Biking is allowed on campground roads. Please keep bikes off sidewalks and do not ride through others sites. Check with the office or online resources for access to numerous area biking trails of all skill and terrain levels.
- **Campground Store:** The store is available during posted hours to purchase ice, firewood, snacks, beverages, RV supplies, souvenirs and many camp necessities you may have forgotten to pack. If we don't have something in stock, staff are happy to let you know which local stores may have the items you need.
- **Internet/Wi-Fi:** Due to our remote location, internet strength is minimal and should be limited to occasional browsing and email. Consider using your own mobile hotspot for streaming. For stronger internet needs, contact the office about other options in town.
- **PETS:** Pets must be on a leash and are not to be left unattended at any time. Please pick up after your pet and dispose of the waste in the provided bins. Fines will be assessed for any pet waste found at your site. Per local health code, NO Pets in Pool Area or buildings. Kamp K-9 is available for off leash fun.
- **Parents/Children:** Parents are responsible for their children's supervision and safety at all times. Please remind them to not cut through other people's sites. Minors must be on their site or accompanied by an adult after dark.
- **Fires:** Firewood is available for sale at the store. Please follow any current county fire bans. Moving firepits and any damage due improper use of pits will incur fines. Fire pits must be attended at all times. KOA employees will extinguish unattended fires.

- **Quiet Hours:** 10:00 PM-7 AM (City of Winthrop Ordinance) Turn off outside TVs, movies, generators and keep voices down as those items can echo throughout the campground. Noise complaints should be directed to the after-hours number. Please note that our facility has sites that can be located in close proximity to each other and being respectful of your neighbor is an important part of camping.
- **Wildlife and Insects:** The Methow Valley is home to a variety of insects and wildlife. On some days you may see an eagle or a turkey wander through the campground. For these reasons, secure your food and place trash in the provided dumpsters. Do not chase, feed, or touch the wildlife. If the wildlife or insects are causing a major disturbance, please contact the office immediately.
- **Alcohol:** Alcohol must be confined to your campsite and only consumed by people of legal US drinking age of 21 and older. Per state liquor laws, open containers are not allowed in the buildings.
- **Restrooms:** We intend to keep our restrooms clean. Your help in this area would be sincerely appreciated. Assist us by not letting water run unnecessarily. **Only flush provided toilet paper down the toilets and use trash cans for paper towels and other garbage.** Please be considerate of others and keep your time in bathroom to a minimum. Contact the office immediately if any of the bathrooms need attention.
- **Black and Gray Water:** Dumping gray and black water are only to be done through provided sewer pipes and dump station. Dumping in/on anything other than a sewer pipe is illegal and will incur fines from the campground and local authorities. See campground map for the location of the sewer dump. Dumping in the sewer dump is included with the price of your site.
- **Smoking/Candles:** No smoking or candles permitted in buildings or cabins.
- **After Hours Emergency:** Fire, Medical, and Police emergencies dial 911. Campground related emergencies call or text (360) 826-0464. Include site number and matter it is concerning.

Management reserves the right to modify or change any of the rules as needed.
