GUIDELINES

Lake Pines is a family oriented campground. Inappropriate language or behavior will result in the loss of camping privileges. No alcohol or illegal substances are allowed on park property. No one under 21 years of age may register or go unattended in the park. Parents are responsible for their children's safety and behavior and are liable for their actions.

Speed Limit: 4.6 MPH. Please watch out for our children! No ATVs or motorcycles are to be used in the park for recreational purposes.

Quiet Hours: 8:00 p.m. - 8:00 a.m. Be considerate of your neighbors. No outside TVs or music.

Visitors: Visitors are permitted between 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. and must register at the office. Limit 6 visitors at campsite or 3 visitors at pool. A registered guest must accompany visitors at all times.

Campsites: Please keep your campsite litter free (including cigarette butts!). No clotheslines allowed. No firearms or fireworks permitted at any time. Protect our established grass by keeping BBQ grills, door mats and vehicles on the gravel.

Campfires: Campfires are allowed in existing fire rings only. Do not build campfires in grass. Do not dump charcoal on the ground. Extinguish all hot coals before leaving.

Pets: Quiet pets, under control and on a **hand-held** leash when outdoors, are welcome. Please pick up behind your pet. No pet pens allowed. No pets allowed in any buildings or pool area.

Pool: **NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY.** All children must be accompanied by an adult. For your safety, read and obey all posted rules. An emergency phone is located on the patio of the building adjacent to the pool (911 calls only).

FACILITIES

Office: 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Mon.-Sat. Closed on Sundays. Please use self-registration system if office is unattended. Emergency numbers are posted at office.

Laundry: Open 24 hours.

Propane: Notify management if you need a motorhome filled. *Bottles:* Label empty bottle with your name and site number.

Place bottle at propane station. Your account will be billed using credit card on file. Bottles are filled periodically throughout the day.

Swimming Pool: Open Memorial Day through Labor Day from 10:00 a.m. until dark. See **GUIDELINES** above.

Bathhouse: Please help keep the bathhouse clean. Notify office if the bathhouse needs attention. Children must be accompanied by an adult. No dishwashing please.

Trash Dumpster: Located next to propane station.

Dump Station: Located across the driveway from office.

The Pinecone Lodge Rally Meeting Room: Available for rally groups.

Wi-Fi Hot Spot: Located at the office.
