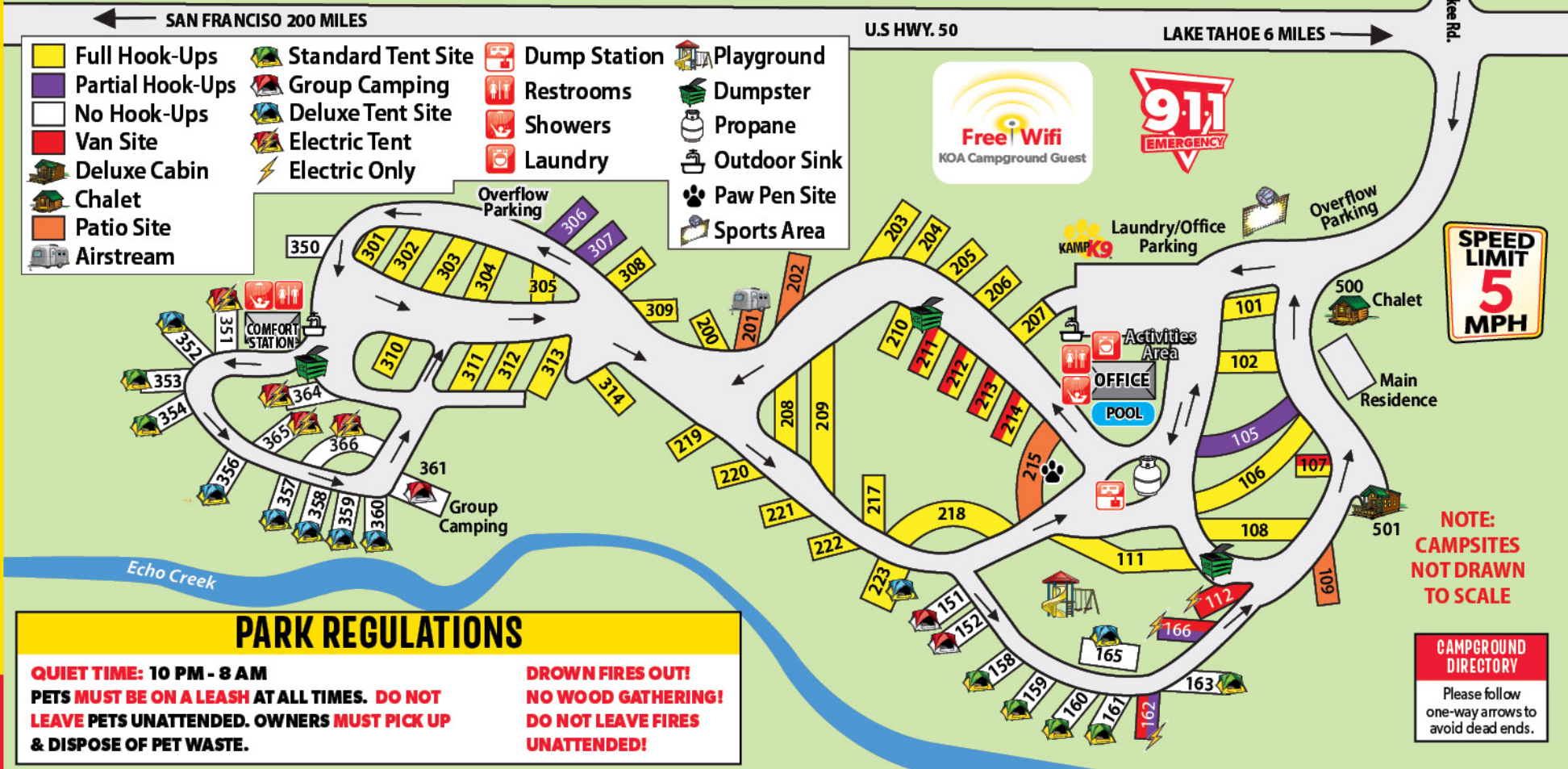

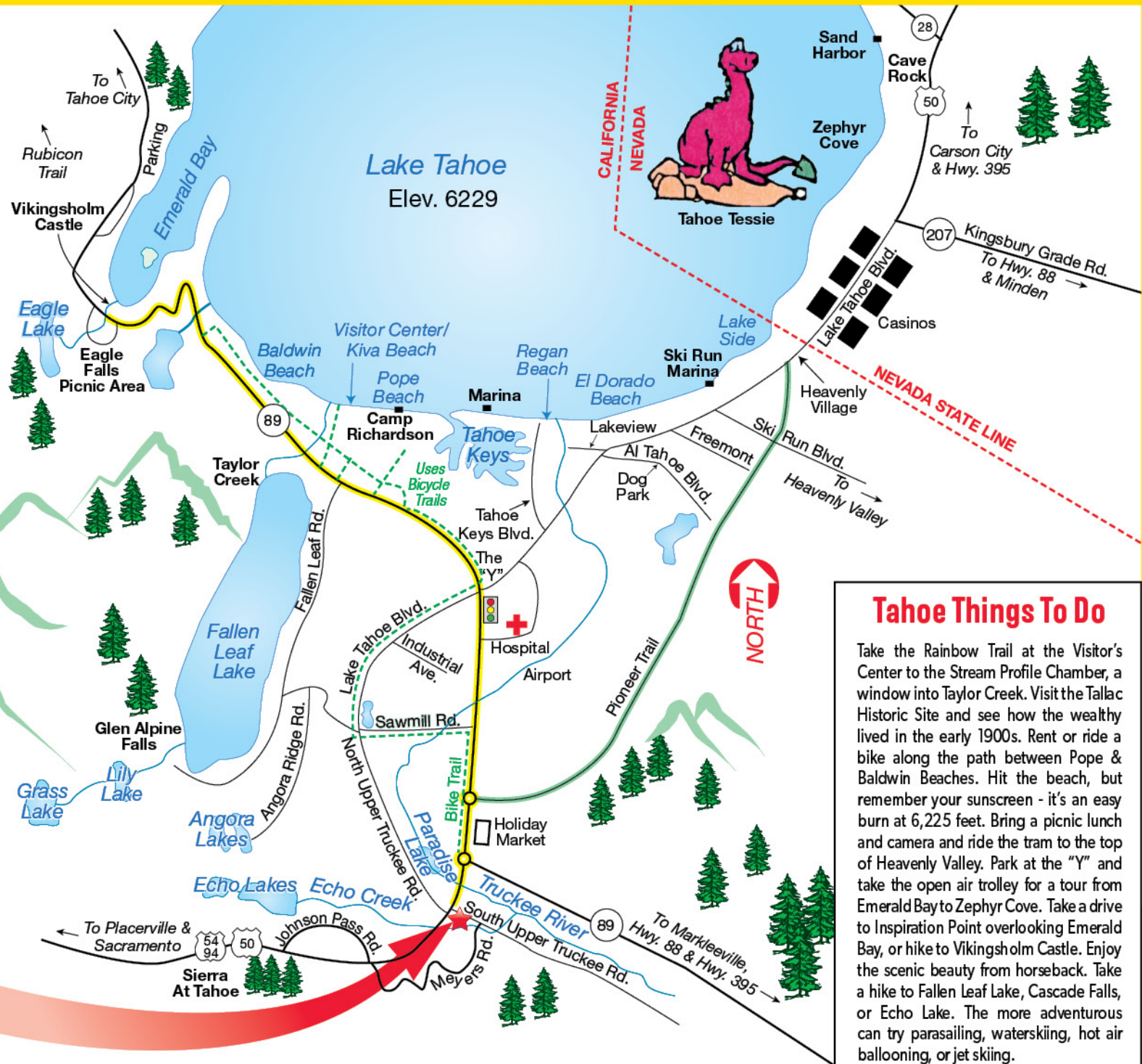

## Tahoe Things To Do

Take the Rainbow Trail at the Visitor's Center to the Stream Profile Chamber, a window into Taylor Creek. Visit the Tallac Historic Site and see how the wealthy lived in the early 1900s. Rent or ride a bike along the path between Pope & Baldwin Beaches. Hit the beach, but remember your sunscreen - it's an easy burn at 6,225 feet. Bring a picnic lunch and camera and ride the tram to the top of Heavenly Valley. Park at the "Y" and take the open air trolley for a tour from Emerald Bay to Zephyr Cove. Take a drive to Inspiration Point overlooking Emerald Bay, or hike to Vikingsholm Castle. Enjoy the scenic beauty from horseback. Take a hike to Fallen Leaf Lake, Cascade Falls, or Echo Lake. The more adventurous can try parasailing, waterskiing, hot air ballooning, or jet skiing.
