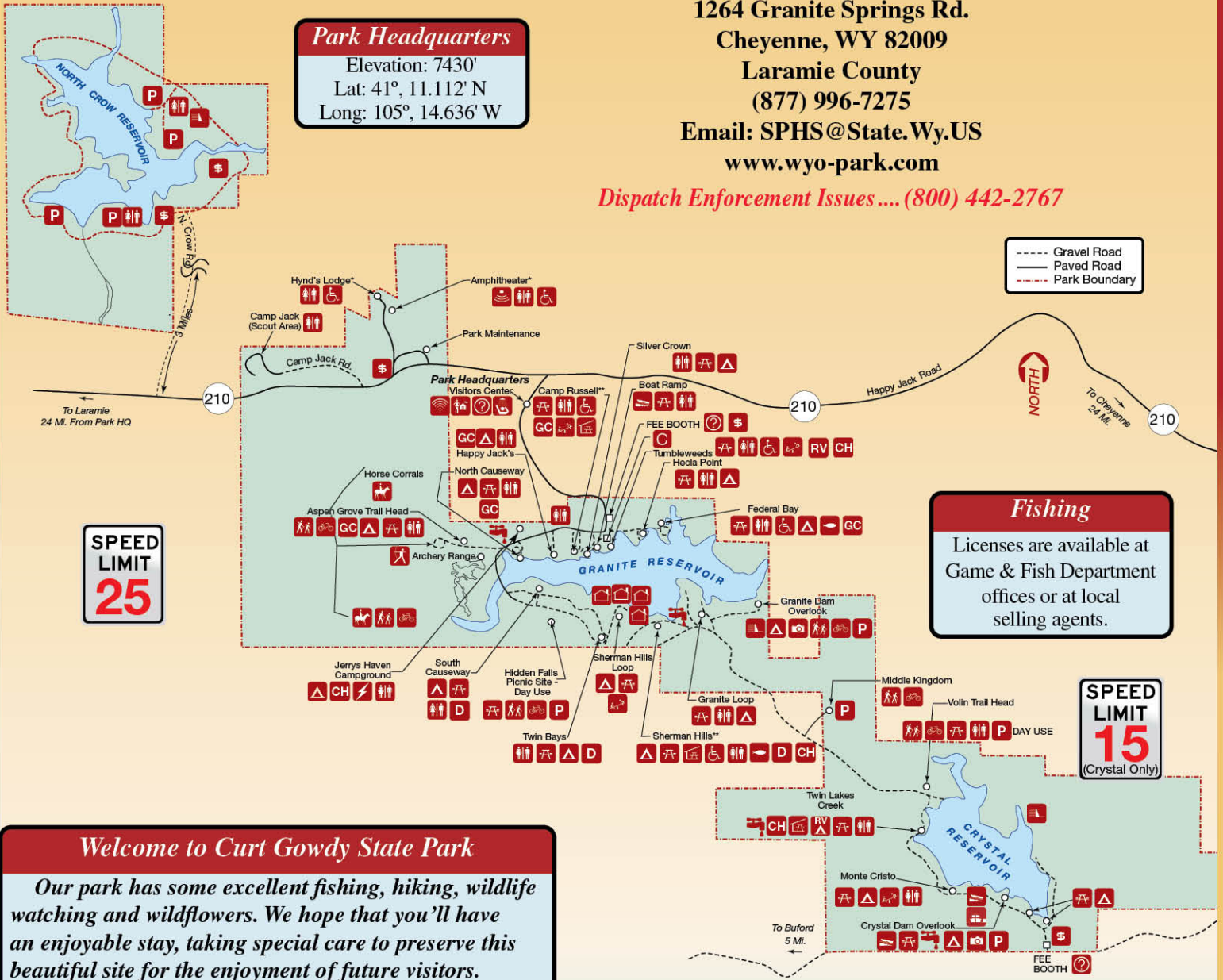

History of Curt Gowdy State Park

Curt Gowdy State Park, named after the well-known sportscaster, was established in 1971 through a lease agreement with the City of Cheyenne.

Important Park Rules

- Motorized vehicles shall be operated only on roads or areas designated for such use. A valid operator's license is required.
- All visitors must abide by posted speed limits. (25 MPH) except Crystal (15 MPH)
- Campsites are intended for recreational use only. Camping units on park lands must be occupied on a nightly basis.
- Camping is permitted for a maximum of 14 consecutive days during any 30-day period. No camping in a designated "day-use only" site.
- Check-out time is 11:00 AM.
- Quiet shall be maintained in all areas used for camping between the hours of 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM. No generators left running after 10:00 PM.
- Pets must be kept on a leash. No dogs in water. Please pickup after your pets.
- All trash shall be deposited in containers designated for that purpose. In areas without containers you are required to pack out your own trash.
- Fires are permitted only in factory-made grills as provided and must be completely extinguished before leaving.
- The discharge of firearms, fireworks or other projectiles is prohibited.
- Fishing and boating are permitted subject to regulations prescribed by the Wyoming Game & Fish Commission.
- No swimming in any reservoir.
- No jet skis or water skiing on Crystal Reservoir (signed as such). 15 HP limit on boats.
- No parking or camping on the beach. (Granite and Crystal Reservoirs are part of Cheyenne's Municipal Water Supply, under Board of Public Utilities. These rules are part of our lease agreement with the City of Cheyenne.)
- No possession of glass beverage containers outside of a camping unit.
- No camping outside a designated campsite.
- No reserving a campsite for another person.
- Failing to occupy a campsite overnight is prohibited.
- No minors in possession of alcohol.
