Poverty Point Reservoir State Park is located just 3 miles north of Delhi in Richland Parish. The 2,700-acre man-made lake, the centerpiece for Poverty Point Reservoir State Park, offers visitors an outlet for a variety of watersport activities and a scenic backdrop for waterfowl migration each spring and fall. The reservoir was created in 2001 as a water resource for the area and outdoor outlet. Also on site are the *Marsden Mound Trails*, a group of five earthen, Neo-Indian mounds, dating from the Tchefuncte through the Coles Creek civilizations, and possibly later.

Black Bear NOTICE: Special attention should be given to any Louisiana black bear sightings on or near the reservoir. The eastern edge of the park, along the Bayou Macon, contains attractive bear habitat and visitors are cautioned to keep all areas cleared of accessible food products and refuse. Please do not feed bears and maintain a safe distance from any bears encountered. Bear-proof containers are provided for waste disposal throughout the park.

PARK INFORMATION & RULES

The person whose name the cabin/lodge has been reserved under shall be responsible for making sure that all visitors adhere to the rules and regulations.

- HOURS:**
Entrance Station Hours: 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Sun-Thu
8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Fri-Sat
Entrance Gate Hours: 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. daily.
Marina Store Hours: 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily.
Marina Complex Hours: 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- PARK GATES:** Park gates are here for the visitor's safety and park security. Please make sure to give the combination to everyone in your party. Gate opening times: 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. daily.
- SPEED LIMIT** is 15 mph throughout the park. Please observe posted speed limit and traffic signs.
- TRASH:** All trash must be taken to the trash containers throughout the campground. Please make sure to close the lids to keep wildlife out.
- FIRES:** Campfires are permitted at each campsite, within the fire rings provided.
- FIREWOOD COLLECTION** is limited to fallen, dead timber. No chainsaws allowed.
- PETS:** Pets must be kept on a 5 foot or shorter leash or crated and may not be left unattended in the park. Dogs are allowed in pet-friendly designated cabins.
- QUIET HOURS:** 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- LENGTH OF STAY** is limited to 14 nights per visit.
- CHECK-IN** time is 3:00 p.m. for cabins, lodges, and group camp. **CHECK-IN** time is 2:00 p.m. for campsites.
- CHECK-OUT** time is 11:00 a.m. for cabins, lodges, and group camp. **CHECK-OUT** time is 1:00 p.m. for campsites.
- NO SMOKING** is allowed in any State Park facility.
- Due to limited space, each cabin/lodge is allowed two parking spaces. Overflow parking is available for extra vehicles.
- Please keep your cabin pass visible at all times, and when re-entering the park you must show your pass to the gate attendant.
- The **MAXIMUM** overnight occupancy is (10) persons per lodge, (8) per cabin.
- Misconduct** and/or **disturbances** are not allowed.
- Alcohol** is allowed, however, you must observe all Park and alcohol related rules.
- Adults** must accompany all children under the age of **12** to the **beach, water playground area, and boat slip area.**
- NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** are allowed in the beach area. No glass containers allowed on beach & swimming is allowed sunrise to sunset ONLY.
- Boat slips** across from the lodges are for **occupants only.**
- Linens** must be **stripped from the beds** and **left on the floor** at the foot of the beds.
- Please **DO NOT** rearrange the furniture inside, and all outside furniture should remain outside. If additional seating is needed please notify the entrance station.
- Checking out,** please wash all the dishes and take all the trash. Please make sure all the trash bags are tied before placing them in the trash bin.
- Please make every effort to keep the **AIR CONDITIONING** setting between 68 to 70 degrees; lower setting may cause the unit to freeze, resulting in the loss of air conditioning service. **Upon entering the park, you must show your vehicle permit to fee attendant to ensure park security.**
