

Welcome!

Please remember to observe the following rules...

- **Permission to use the Recreation Area or Campground:** Permission to use this recreation area is conditioned upon compliance with all applicable Federal, State and Local laws and these regulations. A person who violates any of these may be asked to leave the premises upon order of a staff member or a certified law enforcement officer.
- **Payment of Fees:** No person shall enter or use this recreation area without paying the required fees. Failure to pay required fees subjects violators to eviction.
- **Hours of Operation:** Day use hours are from 7:00 am until sunset. Only registered campers may be present between 10:00 pm and 7:00 am.
- **Reserved Sites:** Certain areas and campsites within the recreation area are designated as "reserved". Reserved sites not claimed or occupied within 24 hours of date of reservation will be forfeited.
- **Litter and Trash:** All trash, garbage, and human or animal waste must be discarded in designated facilities.
- **Use of Motorized Vehicles:** The use of licensed motorized vehicles is restricted only to roads with posted speed limits.
- **Vandalism and Property Damage:** It is unlawful in any way to vandalize, deface, mar, destroy or remove public resources.
- **Parking of Vehicles:** Vehicles must be parked only in designated areas. Illegally parked or abandoned vehicles may be removed at the owner's expense.
- **Firewood Gathering:** Only dead and downed wood may be gathered from the recreation area without a permit. Firewood is available for purchase from the Campground Host.
- **Camping:** Camping is permitted only in designated campsites, and is subject to the following conditions:
 - Campers may not exceed the stay limit of 14 days within a 30-day period, unless off-season rules are in effect.
 - Campsites are only for recreational use, and may not be used as a residence or place of social or economic refuge.
 - Campsites must be occupied beginning the first night of registration, and personal property may not be left unattended for longer than 24 hours.
 - Site capacity is limited to 8 persons, one camp unit, plus one passenger vehicle, space permitting.
 - Camping is not permitted in parking areas or day use areas.
- **Alcoholic Beverages** are permitted only in campsites. No alcoholic beverages are permitted at the swimming area, shoreline or picnic area.
- **Campfires:** Campfires or cook fires are permitted only in campsites or day-use areas. Visitors must confine all fires to a designated grill, fire ring, or other such facility provided. Campfires must be attended at all times and completely extinguished before departing. Fires must be kept to a reasonable and safe size. Personal outdoor grills are permitted.
- **Fireworks and Firearms:** No discharge of fireworks or any other explosive device is permitted, including firearms.
- **Boats** are not permitted in the swimming area. Only electric trolling motors may be used; no gasoline engines permitted.
- **Pets:** Dogs, cats and other pets must be attended at all times, and kept under physical restraint. Leashes may not exceed 6 feet in length. Pets that behave aggressively or are noisy may be ordered removed.
- **Loud and Disorderly Conduct:** Persons shall not disturb the peace and tranquility of an area, make unreasonably loud noises, violate the posted quiet hours, engage in threatening or violent behavior, use provocative language or gestures toward others, or play amplified music.
- **Public Indecency:** Persons may not appear in a state of nudity, or commit the crime of public indecency in the recreation area.
- **Black Water or Gray Water** tanks may not be drained on the ground or other undesignated areas.
- **Glass Containers** or ceramic food or beverage containers may not be used in an area designated as a public beach, swimming area, or other areas as posted.
- **Refunds** are not issued for weather-related issues (i.e. major weather events, emergency evacuations, etc.).


