

Campground Regulations

- All tents must be pitched on designated gravel pads, maximum **two (2) tents per site. Maximum 6 people per campsite, 2 vehicles per campsite.**
- Pets must be well behaved, attended at all times, and kept on a leash no longer than six (6) feet. Owners must clean up after their pets.
- Quiet hours begin at 10:00 p.m. Eastern Time. Please be courteous of other campers at all times throughout the day.**
- Cutting or damaging trees or other vegetation is strictly prohibited. Law protects all wildlife.
- Campfires must remain in designated fire rings. **NEVER leave a fire unattended.**
- Do not allow wastewater to drain onto the ground. A dump station and gray water pits are provided.
- All vehicles must display a valid Georgia ParkPass.
- Campground speed limit: 10 mph. Obey stop signs.
- Bicycle riders must observe all traffic laws. Helmets must be worn by children 15 years old and younger.
- A complete list of park regulations and conservation laws is posted at the Park Office.
- Organized groups are not permitted in the regular campground but may reserve the pioneer campground.**
