

Oak Plantation Campground (OPC) Rules & Regulations

Notice: OPC is a privately owned camping resort. We reserve the right to refuse/evict anyone. Management reserves the right to add, subtract, delete or alter these rules and regulations, as circumstances dictate and that may be necessary to maintain order. **No Refunds.**

Speed Limit: Speed limit is 10 mph and **STRICTLY** enforced.

Registration: All guests, visitors and vehicles (including golf carts) must be registered at the office. Registration fees may apply. Registration requires contact information, vehicle identification and proof of liability insurance for golf carts. A vehicle pass is provided. Any vehicle without the required pass may be towed at the owner's expense.

Visitors: All visitors must be registered as stated above and the registration fee paid if using facilities or spending the night. Guests are responsible for fees and registration of visitors. Guests with unregistered visitors are in violation of campground policy and subject to immediate loss of campground privileges without refund. All visitors not registered to spend the night must exit the park by 10 p.m. Registered guests are responsible for their visitor's actions.

Site Capacity: Camping rate is for 2 adults and 2 children under 16 years. There is an additional charge for each additional person. The number of people per site, including visitors, shall not exceed 8 people.

Campfires: Campfires are only permitted in an off-ground fireplace or fire bowl. Fire bowls are available for rent at the office.

Vehicle & Parking: No more than 1 RV and 2 vehicles per site. Boats and utility trailers are considered vehicles. Vehicles may not be parked in such a manner as to obstruct the road. All other vehicles must be parked in the designated overflow parking area.

Personal Golf Carts: Proof of liability insurance must be provided in order to register a personal golf cart. The pass issued at registration of the golf cart must be displayed on the driver's side windshield at all times. Only battery-powered golf carts are allowed. Golf carts, mopeds, motorcycles and motorized scooters are only to be driven by licensed drivers. Must be a licensed driver on golf carts at all times.

Quiet Time: Quiet hours are 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. Children under the age of 15 must be on their sites by 10 p.m. unless accompanied by a responsible adult 21 years or older. **Parents** are responsible for the safety and actions of their children.

Pets: Pets must be leashed at all times. Pets may not be tied outside or left unattended for any reason. Pet waste must be picked up and placed in the trash bins. Pets are not allowed in the bathhouse or pool area. Proof of current rabies vaccination is required for pets of bi-weekly guests.

Clotheslines etc.: Clotheslines, leashes, lights, etc., may not be attached to trees and/or shrubs. No outside refrigerators, freezers, porches or decks. **NO** 100 lb. LP cylinders. No tarps.

ATVs: No ATVs are allowed in the park.

Pool: There is no lifeguard at the swimming pool. **Swim at your own risk.** No jumping, diving or running from pool deck. Children 15 and under must be accompanied by a parent or adult 21 years or older at all times. Pool rules are posted; please comply, as they are for your own protection.

Fishing: Fishing is allowed from dawn until dusk. You may keep what you catch. No license is required.

Posted Signs: All posted signs throughout the park must be obeyed.

Photographs: Entrance onto the property constitutes permission for OPC to photograph the guest while on the premises and to use any resulting pictures for any lawful purpose without payment to guest or visitor.

Check-In/Check-out: Check-in is 12 noon, check-out is 11 a.m.

Early Departure: OPC is not responsible for early departures necessitated by weather, illness, work schedules, personal emergencies or other situations affecting our guests. Fees are not refunded for early departure.

Liability: Camping has inherent risks associated with outside activities. OPC is not responsible for injuries or damages occurring as part of the inherent risks of any camping environment.

HISTORICAL FACTS ABOUT CHARLESTON

- Though it was first settled in 1670, Charleston officially became a city in 1783.
- The first decisive victory in the Revolutionary War was fought here at the Battle of Fort Sullivan.
- The Ordinance of Secession was signed here to begin the unrest that led to the Civil War.
- The official beginning of the Civil War happened here at Fort Sumter in 1860.

FUN FACTS ABOUT CHARLESTON

- The Arthur J. Ravenel Jr. Bridge is North America's longest cable-stayed bridge at 2½ miles.
- Population of the tri-county area is approximately 870,000 residents.
- More than eight million tons of cargo pass through the Port of Charleston every year. It is the largest cargo port on the Southeast Atlantic coast.

FUN FACTS ABOUT OAK PLANTATION CAMPGROUND

- Opened in early 1960s on an honor system.
- Currently has 221 sites and sits on approximately 45 acres.
- There are wild alligators in our pond. Please use caution.
- Spanish moss is not a true moss. It is an epiphytic plant, which grows on another plant, but does not rely on the host plant for nutrients. The plants have very tiny seeds that are dispersed by wind and birds. You may use it for decoration, but microwave it first to kill any "red bugs" that may be on it.
