The Flint River flows 346 miles through Georgia from north of the Atlanta Airport to the southeast corner of the state where it joins the Chattahoochee River at Lake Seminole to form the Apalachicola River, which crosses the Florida panhandle to the Gulf of Mexico.

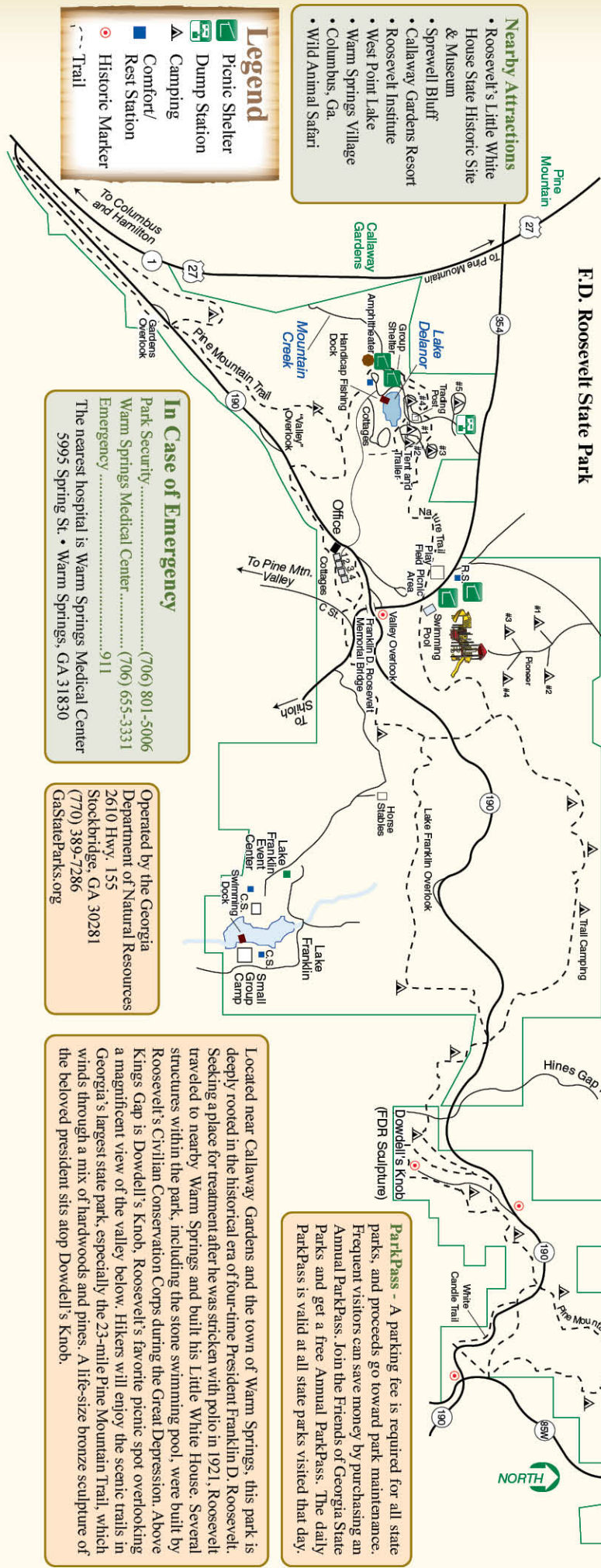

F.D. Roosevelt State Park Camping Rules & Regulations

Please read the following rules and ensure that everyone in your group understands them. As the person registering for the campsite or cottage, you will be responsible for your group. For a complete list of rules and regulations, contact the park office. Please report violations to park staff any time of day or night. It is our goal to ensure you have an enjoyable experience.

Camping check-out time is 12:00 p.m. Cottage check-out time is 11:00 a.m.

Campsite - Campers/tenants are restricted to prepared campsites and may not camp off pads. No more than 6 people per site. Sites may have **ONE** of the following:

- 1 RV, 2 additional vehicles & 1 tent.
- 1 vehicle with pop-up, 1 other vehicle & 1 tent.
- 1 pickup truck with mounted camper, 1 additional vehicle & 1 tent.
- 2 tents & 2 automobiles.

Quiet Hours - Noise must be kept to a bare minimum between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Bright lights must be lowered or turned off so as not to shine on neighboring campers.

Vehicles - A maximum of two vehicles is allowed on each site. Additional vehicles must be parked in parking lots. Each vehicle and golf cart **MUST** have a \$5 ParkPass.

Pets - Pets are welcome in the park and campground as long as they are quiet and kept on a six-foot leash. Pets must be attended at all times. Dogs are only allowed in cottages #6, #17, #18 and #19 with reservation and pet fee.

Visitors - Visitors must purchase a \$5 ParkPass before entering the campground. Vehicles must park at a parking lot if they exceed the campsite limit. Visitors must vacate the park before 10:00 p.m. Day-use picnickers are not permitted in the campground.

Intoxicants - Consumption of alcoholic beverages or intoxicants is unlawful in any public use place. Alcoholic beverages must be confined to camping units and cottages.

Off-Road Vehicles - Off-road vehicles are not allowed in Georgia State Parks. This includes ATVs, UTVs, non-roadworthy golf carts, go-carts and electric scooters. Golf carts **MUST** purchase a \$5 ParkPass. Golf carts and scooters are permitted if they meet state standards listed at the park or are used for a disability.

Garbage - Place garbage in dumpsters only. There is no trash pick-up at individual sites.

Smoking - Smoking is prohibited in all state buildings, including campground comfort stations.

RV Waste - Gray water can be dumped in provided areas or at dump station. Dispose of wastewater (black) in the dump station.

Swimming - Liberty Bell Pool is open during summer months. Swimming is not allowed in the lake.

Fishing - Bank fishing is allowed from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. A fishing license is required.

Boating - Canoes, kayaks, jon boats and aquacycles can be rented at the Park Office between 8:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. No boat ramp. Electric motors only.

Hiking - Hikers can explore more than 40 miles of trails. Maps are available at the Park Office.

Horseback Riding - Stables offer guided rides on 28 miles of trails.

Biking - Biking allowed on paved roads only. Georgia State Law requires the use of helmets for children 15 and younger.
