Guidelines for Everyone's Safety & Enjoyment

1. **Who do we call in case of emergency?**
Emergency numbers are posted at the night registration desk at guest services; or call 911.
2. **Where should we go in case of severe weather?**
The City of Rock Island will sound a siren in the event of severe winds, thunderstorms, or tornado warnings. No building is 100% safe, but you may use the pool bathhouse and/or the Community room for shelter.
3. **What are the hours of operation for Guest Services, General Store, Swimming Pool, Snack Shack and Community Room?**
Hours change with the seasons and are posted at each location.
4. **When is check-out and check-in time?**
Check-out is 11:00 a.m. If you plan to stay another day, re-registration must be done by 11:00 a.m. Check-in time is 2:00 p.m. The only exception is cabin check-in time, which is 3:00 p.m.
5. **May we have guests or visitors?**
Visitors are welcome but must register and pay a day use fee and obtain a hang-tag at the Campground office upon entering the Campground.
6. **Is there an indoor activity space?**
Yes, the Community Room has a TV, books, board games and other activities.
7. **Are pets allowed?**
Pets are welcome but must be kept under control by their owners at all times and must be on a leash when out of doors. Pet walks are located in front of Camelot Towers, west of West Bathhouse, and in the Pet Playground next to the Maintenance Building. Pet waste stations are provided so guests may clean up after pets.
8. **Are campfires and firewood allowed in the park?**
Campfires are permitted in approved fire rings. Because of pests and disease, only USDA-certified firewood may be brought into the park or it may be purchased at the Camp Store.
9. **Where should we place our trash?**
Please leave bagged trash at front of site during daylight hours and our staff will pick it up.
10. **Where should vehicles park?**
Please park all primary and secondary vehicles on site pads or in designated parking lots. Please do not park on the grass.
11. **When are quiet hours observed?**
Campers must observe quiet hours between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
12. **May we place carpets or rugs on the grass at our site?**
We ask that you do not use rugs or carpets as they quickly kill the grass and leave behind a mud hole for the next guest.
13. **Are mini-bikes allowed?**
No motorbikes, mini-bikes, mopeds or similar vehicles may be used in the park, unless licensed for road use.
14. **What are the requirements for use of the lakes?**
Fishing in the lakes will be in accordance with the applicable state regulations. Sport fishing only; no nets, trotlines, or jug fishing. Only boats manually or electrically powered are allowed on lakes (no gasoline engines). No wading or swimming is allowed in either lake.
15. **Do we need to display our vehicle hang-tag?**
Yes, all vehicles on the premises must have a valid hang-tag displayed. Vehicles without valid hang-tags will be towed at the owner's expense.
16. **Is smoking allowed in the campground?**
Illinois law prohibits smoking in or near all buildings, including cabins. The Hot Tub area is a smoking area, but all other areas in and around the Pool are smoke free.
17. **Is cable available?**
Yes, a 36 channel system is available at most RV sites.
18. **Why is there an extra vehicle fee?**
We provide for parking of one vehicle only at a site and the fee is used to discourage multiple vehicles.
19. **Must we use the automatic gates to exit?**
No, you may ask staff to manually open a gate during normal office hours if you have a concern with the function of the automatic gates.
20. **Should motorcycles, bicycles, pedestrians and golf carts pass through the gates?**
No, the gates are designed to work with full-size vehicles and others should pass around the gates.
21. **No washing of vehicles.**
22. **Camelot Guarantee:** A full refund will be cheerfully given within the first hour of check-in if our park does not meet your expectations. Sorry, no refunds given after the first hour.
23. **Please do not take anything live from the park.**
We proudly spend a great deal of time and money in labor and on plants to enhance the beauty of the park. Some guests have asked if they may pick, harvest or take plants from the park. Please do not take anything live from the park.
24. **What's that on the ground?**
Please forgive our wild animals, primarily geese, for leaving excrement on the ground. As the animals are protected we cannot remove them nor can we clean up after them. A rake is available at the office if you care to rake your site.
25. **What is there to see around the Quad Cities?**
Numerous attractions and activities are available in the Quad Cities area. Tourist Center information and brochures are free in the office. If you need any assistance or directions, please ask.

SWIMMING POOL RULES

Open Mid-May to Mid-September

Pool hours are posted at pool. Rules are posted at the pool and WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

NO Lifeguards on Duty and all swimming is "AT YOUR OWN RISK."

- Children under 16 and all non-swimmers must be accompanied by a parent. Swim diapers required on all babies.
- **No food, snacks, gum, candy or glass in pool area.**
- **No running or diving allowed.**
- No pets permitted in the swimming area.
- All guests must towel dry before entering the bathhouse from the pool area.
- Showers are not a play area. Children found using showers inappropriately will be sent back to campsite.
- Occasional private parties may cause pool to be closed; posting at guest services.
- Hot tub use for adults only - 16 yrs. or older.
