## GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY & ENJOYMENT

To ensure you have a pleasant and enjoyable stay with us, we ask that you follow these guidelines:

- Quiet Hours** are 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. Please remember that children, as well as many adults, may be sleeping. Keep music, laughter and other noises at a minimum.
- Speed Limit** in the campground is **5 mph** or less. Watch for children at all times. Please observe road signs and follow one-way roads.
- Restrooms and Showers** are for YOUR use. We strive to keep them as clean as possible for you. Your help and consideration for the next user will be appreciated. For your safety, codes are for KOA guests only.
- Swimming Pool** is for your enjoyment. However, there is no lifeguard on duty. Children under 14 must be supervised by a parent or other adult at all times. Running, diving or rough play is not allowed in the pool area. Swim at your own risk. No earrings to be worn in pool. No GLASS OR PETS allowed at the pool.
- Dogs** must be kept on a short leash (8 feet maximum) and under constant control at all times. Your pet should never be left unattended. You are expected to walk your dog in the dog walk area and **clean up after it.**
- To stay another night**, re-register by 10:00 a.m. **Check-Out time is 12:00 noon. Check-In time is 1:00 p.m.** Please leave your site clean and ready for the next RVer. **Cabin Check-out 11:00 a.m. - Check-in 2:00 p.m.**
- No skateboards**, minibikes, hoverboards or razor scooters to be ridden in the park.
- No flying drones** allowed.
- NO SLEEPING IN VEHICLES.**
- Bicycle riding** permitted on asphalt only. NO RIDING AFTER DARK. Motorcycles are welcome but must be quiet.
- No smoking** or vaping in or near any building.
- Flags & Banners:** American flags only, flown no higher than RV.


