GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY & ENJOYMENT

- Billiards/Pool Tables:** If you want to play billiards/pool in the game room, **you must be 18 years of age, or have a parent or legal guardian with you.** Billiards/Pool is \$5.00 per hour, must have driver's license for collateral.
- Laundry Open 24 Hours.**
- Speed Limit:** 7 7/8 MPH.
- Trash:** Seal bags and leave in your campsite driveway before 10:00 AM for daily pick-up.
- Sites: One RV and one tow(ed) vehicle per site.**
- Fire Rings:** Firewood is available at the KOA store. **No cutting down trees to burn or you will be ejected from park.** Please do not put trash or food in the rings. Litter attracts unwelcome yellowjackets and other nasty visitors.
- Guests: Guests are welcome. All guests must register at the office and pay a fee. No visitors after 10:00 PM.**
- Children:** Kids under 14 must be accompanied by parent or guardian while in the pool area and after sunset.
- Kids under 14 must be accompanied by an adult to store/office, laundry & game room.**
- All children must be on their sites after dark.
- No toys under 3" diameter allowed in pool area.**
- No swim diapers of any kind, any age, children or adult.** Must be 18 to go in the hot tub.
- No scooters, E-Bikes or bike riding after dusk.**
- Quiet Hours:** 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM. **Violators will be asked to leave with no refund.**
- Restrooms:** Closed for cleaning from 11:00 AM to 12:30 PM daily.
- Firearms or Fireworks:** Not permitted in the park.
- Washing Vehicles: Not allowed in the park.**
- Cooking/Smoking:** not allowed in the Cabins or on Cabin porches.
- No cooking, smoking, vaping, or drug use of any kind permitted in cabin premises. If any lingering orders of any kind will result in a clean-up fee being assessed determined on severity.**
- Cabins:** A clean-up fee will be assessed if the smell of food cooked in the cabin is detected, or is lingering. **DO NOT** leave leftovers of eaten food in trash cans inside the cabin when you check out. The clean-up fee also applies if the cabin is left trashed. You can ask for additional trash bags in office.
- Churches:** A list of local churches is posted on the board at the entrance of the KOA office.
- Pets: Pets are welcome when leashed (6ft. maximum) and quiet. Do not leave them unattended or take them into the playground, buildings or pool area. Use the pet walk area and clean up after them. NO MORE THAN 3 DOGS PER SITE. It's the pet owner's responsibility to clean up after your pet. If you leave your campsite dirty, or we have to clean up pet waste from your campsite, a clean-up fee will be assessed.**
- Check-In Time: Check-in time is 1:00 PM.** Early check-in grace period Noon - 1pm. Check-in before Noon will incur a \$20 fee.
- Check-Out Time:** Check-out time is 11:00 AM. Please reregister by 10:00 AM.
- Late Check-Out:** If you would like to stay late and your site is not rented, then there is a \$20.00 charge for staying until 3:00 PM. Anything after 3:00 PM is another day stay.
- You may only plug **one Power Cord into the Power Box**, for both the Water and Electric sites and Full Hook-up sites.
- No outdoor movie/video projection systems allowed.**

AREA INFORMATION

Carlton is the county seat and a fast growing city of 1,000. It's the recreational gateway to Jay Cooke State Park, the Willard Munger Bike Trail, the National Kayak Center, whitewater rafting and the "Carlton Rocks" area where wild blueberries and raspberries abound. There are delightful shops to browse downtown.

Cloquet began as several little settlements built around three sawmills. The frontier site was platted in 1883 and a year later was incorporated into the village of Cloquet. The village became a city in 1904. Today Cloquet is Carlton County's commerce, medical and population center with 11,000 residents.

Duluth is the busiest American port on the Great Lakes, sharing the harbor with Superior, Wisconsin. The completion of the St. Lawrence Seaway in 1959 opened the harbor to direct overseas commerce. Facilities include grain elevators, ore loaders, bunker terminals for oil and coal, refrigerated docks and a container dock.

Duluth was named for Daniel Greysolon, Sieur du Lhut, a French explorer who reached Lake Superior in 1679. The first permanent settlement was made in 1853.
