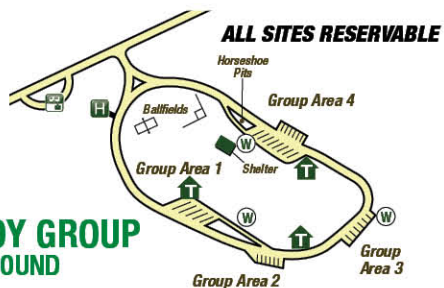

"Good Neighbor" Policy and National Forest Service Campground Rules

The following rules are actively enforced by the National Forest Service, Lake County Sheriff's Department, and ExplorUS team to ensure your health, safety and well-being. Help us make your experience a safe and memorable one by adhering to these campground rules and by reporting any violations to your campground host.

SITE BASICS:

- **Check-in:** 2:00pm / **Check-out:** 12:00pm
- Maximum of 8 people per site.
- Maximum of 3 tents or 1 RV OR 1 vehicle used for sleeping and 2 tents per site.

NOISE:

- **Quiet Hours: 10:00pm-8:00am** (includes generators). If campers make excessive noise after 10:00pm that requires the Host to intervene, they will be evicted. Please respect fellow campers and dark sky policy with limited exterior lighting at all times.
- **Daytime Hours:** All campers are expected to be respectful and considerate of those camping around them. Music, children, dogs, etc. must maintain a reasonable noise level at all times.

VEHICLE SPEED:

- **10 MPH:** Please observe the campground speed limit at all times. There are adults and children walking and playing on the campground roads.

PARKING:

- **Vehicles of any type may only park on designated spurs.** All wheeled units count as a vehicle. Only 2 vehicles allowed per site without additional fee. Fee charged for each additional vehicle per night.

DOGS:

- **Leash Law:** All dogs (including service dogs) must ALWAYS be on a leash that is no longer than six feet. Violations will result in a \$500 fine or dismissal from the campground. Dogs may NOT be tied to trees at campsites or left alone.
- **Barking:** All campers are expected to keep their dogs calm and quiet. Campers will be asked to leave if their dogs barks persistently regardless of the time of day.
- **Waste:** Please bag your dog's waste and dispose of it in the dumpster. Do not leave in campsites, public areas, or vault toilets.

TREES:

- **DO NOT DAMAGE STANDING TREES:** Cutting, nailing, screwing, chopping and hanging items from branches, are ALL PROHIBITED.

- **Hammocks/Swings:** Ropes are prohibited from being tied on trees, only flat straps.

FOOD:

- **This is Bear Country: NO HUMAN OR PET FOOD SHOULD BE LEFT OUTSIDE UNATTENDED AT ANY TIME.** ALL food, coolers, and trash MUST be fully enclosed inside a hard-shelled car, RV, or dumpster at night or any time your site is unoccupied. **This includes NO food waste in fire rings.**

- **Bird Feeders/Hummingbird Feeders:** All wildlife feeders are prohibited.

FIRES:

- **Attended:** Fires must NEVER be left unattended in the National Forest. Campers must have one gallon of water onsite, near fire, to ensure fire is kept under control.
Please fully extinguish fire before leaving your campsite. **EXTINGUISH WITH WATER ONLY!**

- **Firewood:** Firewood is sold at the Host site. Any wood brought into the campground from elsewhere must not exceed 24 inches in length. No sawing or cutting wood on site or in campground at any time.

- **Location:** Fires may only be made in designated fire rings in the campsites or day use areas.

FIREWORKS:

- **Prohibited:** Possession, and discharge of fireworks and all other explosive devices, is prohibited at all times.

WEAPONS:

- **Prohibited:** Discharging Firearms, Paintballs, BB Guns, Crossbows, Bows and Arrows, or any other type of weapon is PROHIBITED in the campground and surrounding areas.

DRUG USE:

- **Prohibited:** National Forests are on Federal Land and therefore Federal Laws apply. Per Federal law, all drug use including Marijuana is PROHIBITED.

The National Forest Service, Lake County Sheriff's Department, and ExplorUS take your safety and well-being seriously - which also means we take violations of the campground rules seriously.
