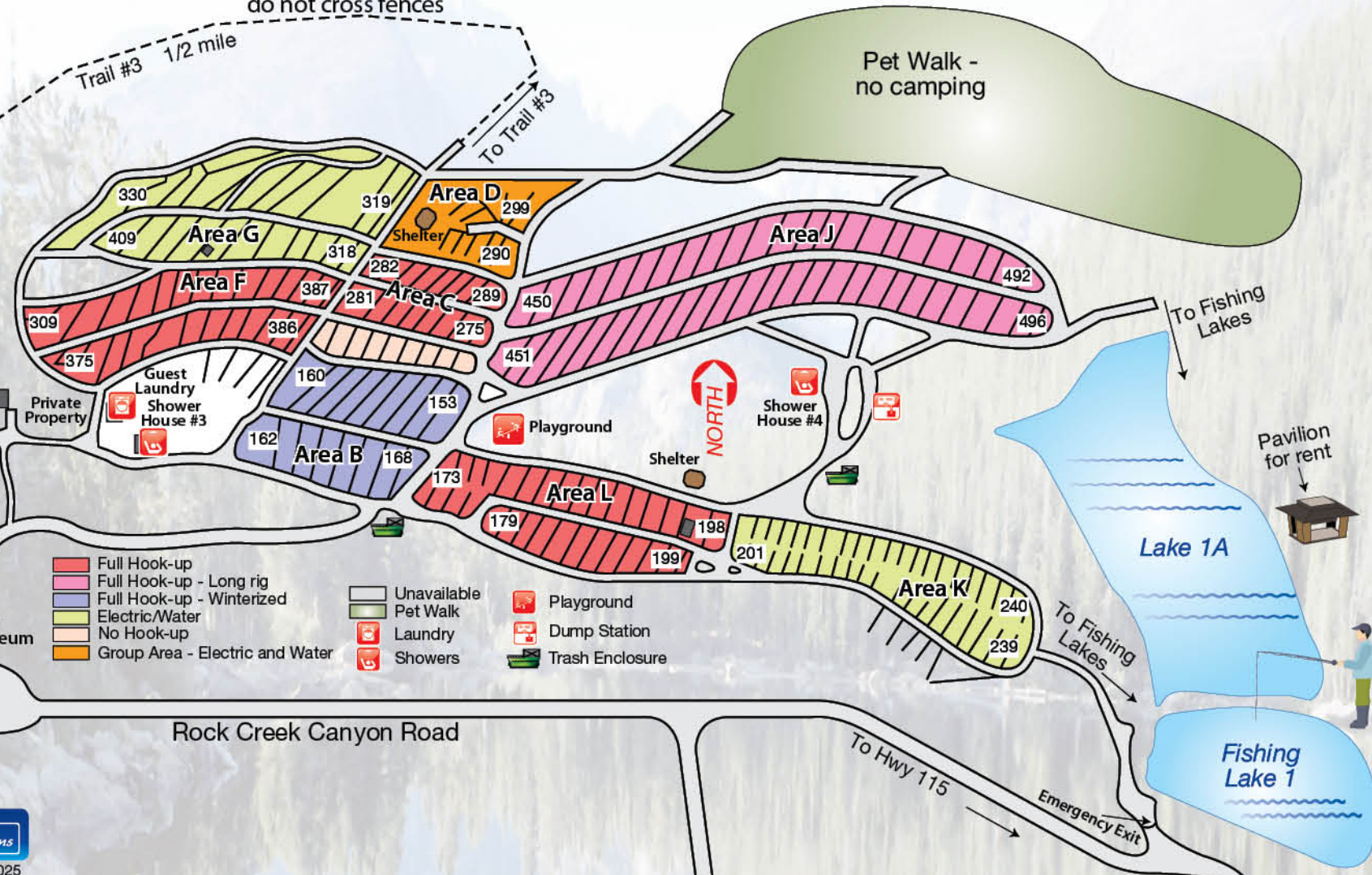

CAMPGROUND POLICIES

VISITORS: Those visiting our campers are welcome, and must register all vehicles at office before entry – \$1 per visitor fee for visits longer than one hour. Speed limit is 10mph throughout campground. Public drunkenness/ other drug use is unlawful, and not tolerated on our property. **No marijuana!**

LAKES, FISHING: Trout stocked – no state license required, just our private fee/permit, for registered campers only. Sorry, visitors may not fish. LIMIT 3 fish/ permit per day. Bait is permitted but NO LIVE MINNOWS. Our lakes are a domestic water supply, so no dogs allowed at/in lakes. **No swimming!**

CAMPsites: You must pay in advance for your site. No clotheslines allowed – we have a great Laundromat. If you move tables for group camping, please put them back afterward. Limited year round Full Hook-up sites for stays of 30 days or more.

ELECTRIC, WATER: Spigots provided. Please conserve water. No vehicle washing. We have some shared electrical poles – 50A can't be guaranteed (first-come, first-served). If you need to borrow extension cords, adapters, hoses, etc., we're happy to lend – fully-refunded deposit required.

GREY WATER & SEPTIC: DO NOT run tank waste water on ground – we have a dump station. We sell waste-line extensions at the office. Nothing other than toilet paper in toilets – this includes TAMPONS and WET-WIPES, even supposedly dissolving ones!

FIRES: In official fire-rings only. Leave fire only when dead/out; we can get high winds during the day or night. We have wood for sale at our office. No wood gathering or outside wood/lumber (pine beetle, etc.) allowed. Check with office for fire-ban information. **No fireworks! No tiki torches!**

CHILDREN: Well-behaved children are always welcome. We like to see kids having fun, but only under the watchful eye of a caring parent or guardian. Young children may not use shower houses unattended.

PETS: We welcome well-behaved, non-aggressive pets if their owners use a leash and common sense. **On leash and accompanied by owner at all times.** Clean up pet waste. 3-dog limit. Pets are not allowed to harass wildlife. No pets in lakes, showerhouses, laundry building and pavilions. Use pet walk area to exercise dogs. Keep pets quiet - IF YOUR PET ANNOYS OTHER CAMPERS OR WILDLIFE YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE OUR CAMPGROUND.

GOLDEN EAGLE CAMPGROUND is a wildlife preserve. Please treat our wildlife and native plants with respect. Leave plants, rocks, and trees where nature placed them. No motorized vehicles on any hiking trails. **No hunting/ targeting/rock-throwing.**

EQUIPMENT AND VEHICLES: No use of generators, chainsaws, blowers, dirt-bikes, ATVs, motorized scooters or kids cars. Aerial drones only with written permission from management. High winds are possible – retract awnings when not in use. No repairs/maintenance of vehicles in the campground.

FIREARMS: Display or discharge of firearms leads to immediate expulsion from our campground. No bb-guns, slingshots, air-soft guns, paintguns, bows/arrows, crossbows, etc.

SHOWER HOUSES/LAUNDRY: Please let us know of untidiness or disrepair. No smoking or dishwashing.

TRASH: Only place trash in dumpsters - crush boxes & plastic. Keep campsite clean! **Bears love garbage!**

CHECK-OUT TIME: 1:00pm – note that the next guest expects to pull in at this time. Extensions may not be possible.

QUIET HOURS: 10:00pm to 8:00am - noise disturbs our other guests!

AFTER-HOURS CONTACTS: See Camp Hosts, or call 719-900-8203 - Emergencies 911.

Failure to abide by any of the above may result in ejection from our campground.
