

OUR LOCATION

Klondike RV Park is one of the newest and cleanest on the Kenai Peninsula. Enjoy our relaxed, friendly atmosphere. Located in Soldotna, Alaska, one block off the famous Kenai River, minutes from downtown Soldotna and 12 miles from the Kenai Airport.

Public bank fishing is just a short walk away or we can hook you up with a Kenai River guide. The Kenai River is best known for the world record King Salmon (97lbs. 4ozs.) caught by Les Anderson on May 17, 1985. Each year we have a tremendous run of salmon up the river. May, June, July and August are the best months for Kings, Sockeye, Pinks, and Coho. Our location puts you right in the middle of great fishing.

RULES OF THE PARK

We recommend that you use a water pressure regulator and a surge protector. Water pressure is 70 lbs. and there are sometimes power surges because of electrical use by other campers. We cannot be responsible for damage.

- RVs should be parked tight to the utilities and all the way back into the site. You may need an extension cord. RVs and tow vehicles cannot stick out in the roadway.
- All guests must register in the office and park in the site they are visiting.
- NO TENTS** on sites and no carpets on grass.
- Pets must be leashed (6 ft. leash) or in a kennel at all times when outside your RV. In an effort to keep the park clean for everyone, please make sure your pets use the pet walk area, through the gate at the back of the park. Be sure to pick up and dispose of your pets' waste in the dumpster. Barking, aggressive or nuisance pets are not allowed. Doggy bags are available at the back fence.
- Thank you for cleaning all fish or clams where you catch them, not in the park.
- Washing or rinsing off vehicles in the park is not allowed. Car repairs/service cannot be done in the park, except in emergency and with the manager's permission.
- Make sure all external connections between your RV and our utilities do not leak.
- Quiet time is 10 PM to 7 AM. No loud parties, music, or running of generators are allowed.
- The laundry/shower room is locked. Please obtain combination from the office.
- Please observe the **5 MPH** posted speed limit inside the RV Park.
- Please use the dumpster that is provided by the park. Leaving garbage outside your RV is not allowed. No fish or clam waste in garbage.
- Outdoor cooking is allowed in approved barbecues or hibachis only.
- No Campfires** of any kind or burning of wood.

We reserve the right to ask those disrupting the operation of the park to leave the premises. We assume no responsibility for accidents, injuries, or for the loss or damage of property.
