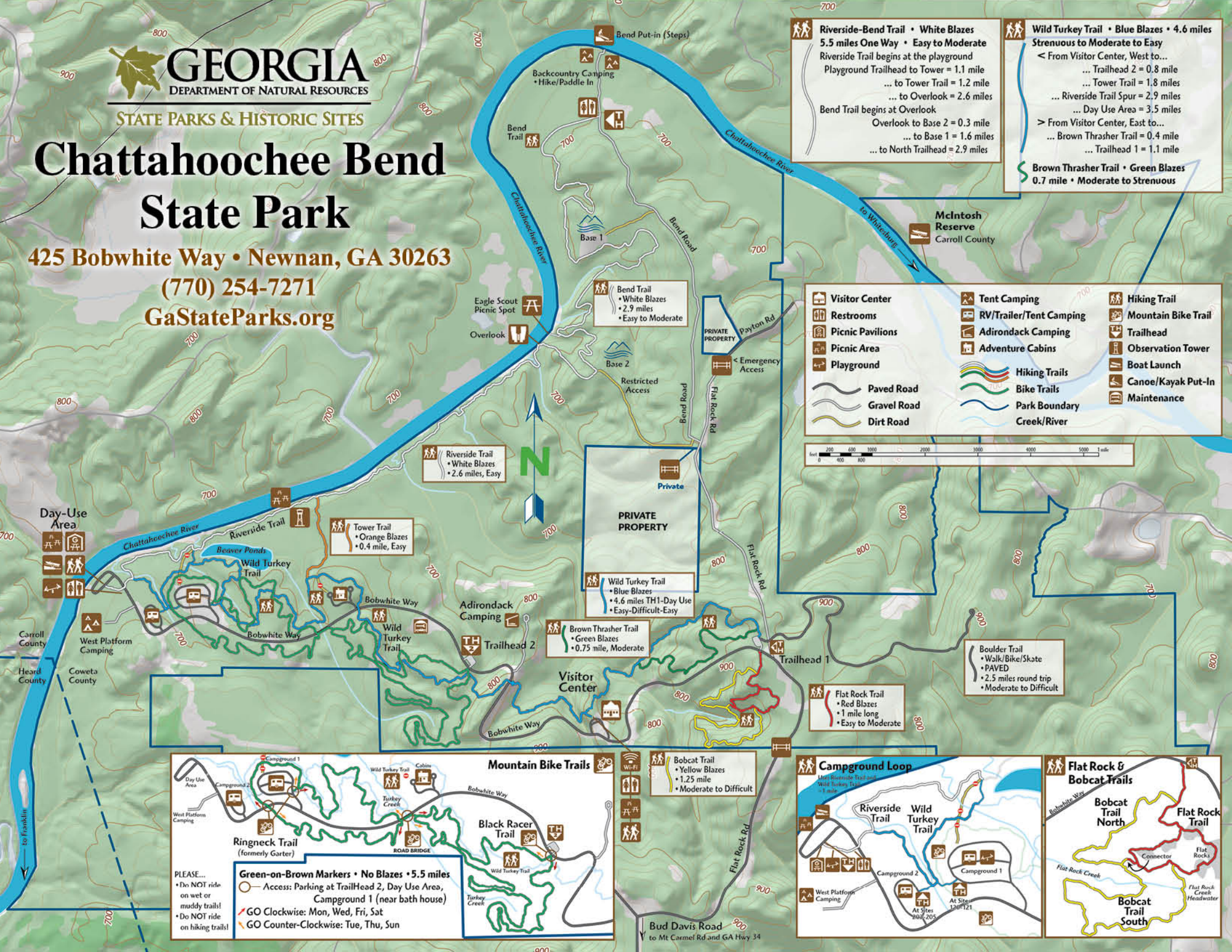

Riverside-Bend Trail • White Blazes
5.5 miles One Way • Easy to Moderate
Riverside Trail begins at the playground
Playground Trailhead to Tower = 1.1 mile
... to Tower Trail = 1.2 mile
... to Overlook = 2.6 miles
Bend Trail begins at Overlook
Overlook to Base 2 = 0.3 mile
... to Base 1 = 1.6 miles
... to North Trailhead = 2.9 miles

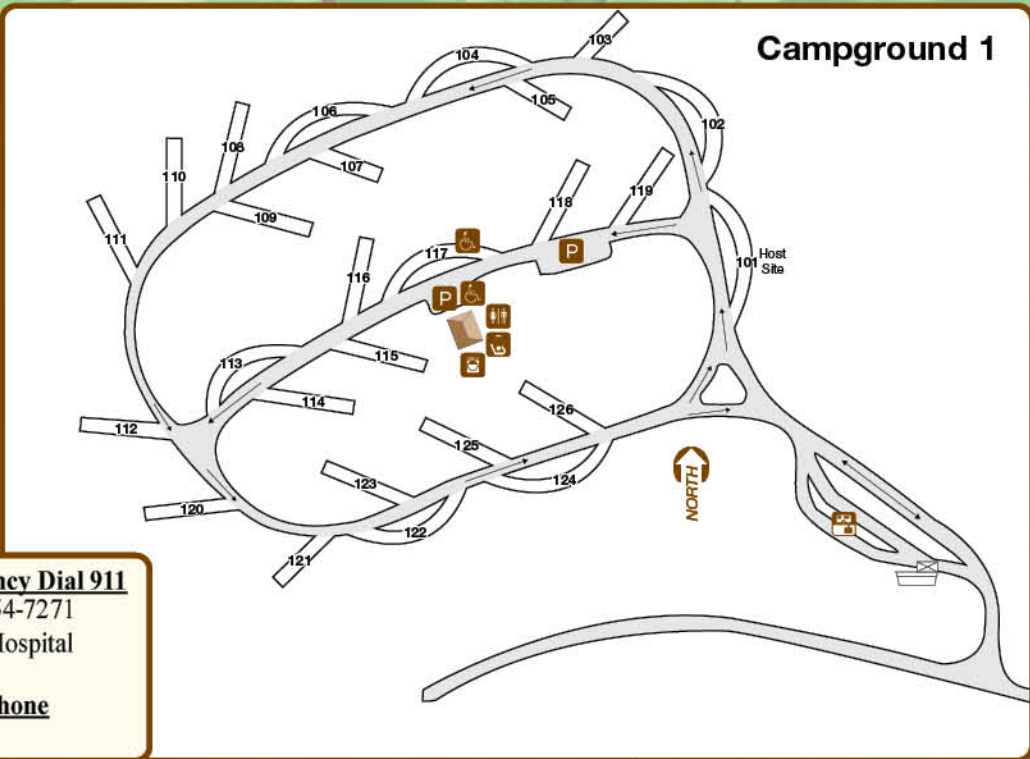
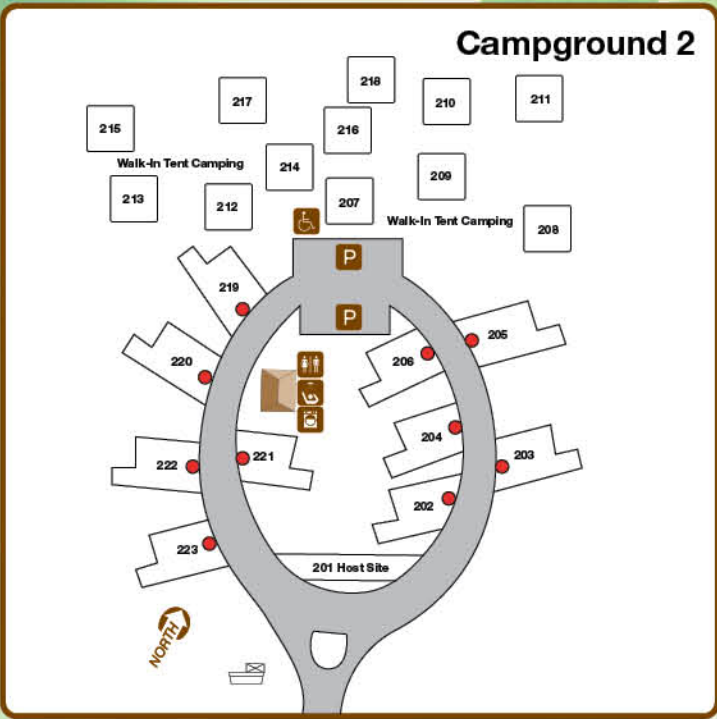

Campground Information and Park Rules

- Pets must be leashed at all times.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in day-use areas / picnic shelters.
- Hikers should be off trails before dark.
- ATVs and drones are not permitted in the park.
- Visitors must leave by 10 p.m.
- Children ages 15 and younger must wear bicycle helmets.
- Quiet time is 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. Please keep noise-making devices low at all times.
- Gray water must be dumped in areas provided.
- Campground sites are for registered campers only. Picnickers may use day-use areas.
- Campfires must be kept inside fire rings.
- No showers available at Adirondack Camping.

- Check-out time is 12 p.m.
 - Check-in time is 1 p.m.
- Cottages**
- Check-out time is 11 a.m.
 - Check-in time is 4 p.m.
- Backcountry Camping**
- 5.5 mile backpack hike in only, no car access. No electricity. No water. No shower.
 - **EVERYONE IN YOUR PARTY MUST CHECK-IN BY 1 P.M.** or forfeit stay/reschedule to other site based on availability.

ParkPass - A parking fee is required and is valid for all parks visited that day. Proceeds go towards park maintenance. Frequent visitors can save money by purchasing an Annual ParkPass or membership in *Friends of Georgia State Parks*.
