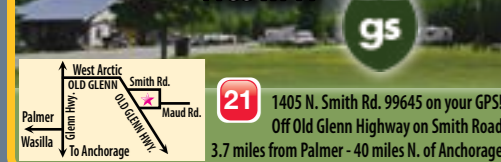

# TOK RV VILLAGE RULES

- **PARKING** – Please do not change assigned spaces without approval of the office. Open spaces may be reserved or the occupant may have left temporarily.
  - **SPEED LIMIT** – 3 miles per hour.
  - **CHECK-OUT TIME** – 11:00 am. Cabins - 10:00 am.
  - **QUIET HOURS** – 10:00 pm to 7:00 am.
  - **STATE LAW REQUIRES:**  
Pets must be on a leash (please clean up).  
No pets allowed in buildings.  
No open fires except in grills.  
No drainage of sink (grey) water in camping area.  
No dumping of waste oil.  
No open alcoholic beverages in buildings.  
No smoking in buildings.  
No washing dishes in restrooms.
  - **VEHICLE WASHING** – in sites is prohibited.
  - **CHILDREN** under 6 years old must be accompanied by an adult in restrooms.
  - **OIL DRAINAGE/DUMPING** – prohibited, \$200 FINE!
  - **GARBAGE** – to be discarded in refuse containers.
  - **NOT RESPONSIBLE** for fire, theft, wind or tree damage.
  - **LAUNDRY & RESTROOMS** – Please help us keep them clean!
  - **PARK EQUIPMENT** must be left intact and in good condition. Please report damage.
  - **ELECTRIC** – Only one outlet to be used per unit.
  - **NO CLOTHESLINES** or laundry hanging in site.
  - **NO RV OR AUTO REPAIRS** in site.

## IT'S ALL IN THE FAMILY!



When driving the Alaska Highway, the first Alaskan RV park you encounter is the Tok RV Village & Cabins (Mile 1313.4), built and run by the Jernigan's, a longtime Alaska family.

The campground opened in 1986, with 50 sites, and was developed the previous year while Jerry Jernigan worked on the Alaska pipeline (the reason he and his family moved from Portland, in 1975) and his wife, Rose, and son, Michael, were employed by a construction company in Anchorage. Over the following six summers, Jerry, Rose, and Michael commuted from Anchorage to Tok each weekend, as they oversaw management of the park, added amenities, increased the number of sites (now 142), and improved services. Their hard work paid off, in July 2007 when the Good Sam RV Club gave Tok RV Village & Cabins its highest rating of any park in Alaska: 9.5 out of 10.

Jerry, Rose and Michael ran the park with the help of Michael's son, Chad, and daughter, Ashley (both born and raised in the RV park). Rose was responsible for guest registrations, reservations, and operations of the gift store, while Jerry and Michael handle ongoing maintenance and improvements. The Jernigan's pride themselves

on the cleanliness of the RV park. "Clean is an understatement," Jerry says.

The park is big-rig friendly, with over 142 pull-throughs, with ample space and greenery between sites, Cabins, Tent sites and Glamping tents.

When asked what he appreciates most about the park, Michael says, "Everything works. You want 50amps? You get it. The breakers aren't popping off, lots of hot water, washers and dryers work, and the Wi-Fi Internet and cable TV are always up and running."

Michael runs the park with help from his wife Cindy and daughter Ashley. Tok Junction was chosen for the park for its location as a jumping-off point for all highway traffic entering and departing Alaska. It's roughly a day's drive from several major cities (Whitehorse is 400 miles to the east and Fairbanks is 212 miles away) and serves as an excellent place for a rest break, restocking supplies, and reviewing travel plans. The Jernigan's are always eager to answer travel questions and assist with plans for visiting the "Last Frontier." Jerry and Rose retired in 2016 and now live in Idaho Falls, Idaho.

"We really enjoy meeting all the people," says Jerry, with a smile. "That's what makes this such a nice business."
