

General Rules

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT: Check-in time after 1 PM. Check-out time before 12 PM. Early arrival and late check-out may be possible based on availability. Fee is \$25.

VISITORS: All visitors must register with office. Visitors staying overnight are subject to a \$5 fee per person per night. All visitors (Adult or Child) must be accompanied by paying guest at all times. All guest vehicles must display a parking pass.

PARKING: RVs must be backed into site as far as possible and as close to the patio as possible without parking on patio (subject to approval by office). All passenger vehicles must be parked in site or designated area. Parking in empty sites, street, or on concrete patios is prohibited without prior approval. Extra fees may apply for extra vehicles. All illegally parked vehicles are subject to tow. No washing, repairing or warming up of vehicles allowed.

PETS (Cats & Dogs): No Aggressive Breeds. Must be on a maximum 6-foot leash at all times. No pets are allowed in other sites, Rec Room, Bathrooms, Laundry, Fitness Room, or in Pool/Spa area. Dogs must be controlled at all times. Aggressive or constant loud barking dogs will not be tolerated. Dogs are not to be left tied outside unattended, and their tether must not reach the street, wrap around the RV, or allow the dog to reach outside of their site in any way. We have a large dog walk area across the creek. Bridge located between sites 41 and 42. Pet droppings must be picked up immediately. Doggie bag stations are located throughout the park (please see map for details).

SWIMMING POOL/SPA: Please accompany ALL guests. Please check with office prior to bringing guests; extra fee may apply. No glass or food on pool or spa decks. No cut-off jeans. Per California law, children under 14 must be supervised at all times by an adult.

REC AREA/FITNESS ROOM: All amenities in Park are open from 7 AM until 9 PM. Game equipment may be found in the indoor Rec Room. Please return any equipment when finished. Please report any missing or damaged equipment. Fitness room requires a code which can be obtained in the office.

LAUNDRY: Open 7 AM to 9 PM. Please do not start loads after 8 PM.

RESTROOMS: Restrooms require a key card for entry. A \$5 cash deposit is required to obtain a key card.

WI-FI: Up to 1 week of free WI-FI per stay for short term guests. Higher speed WI-FI and additional days may be purchased. See office for information.

SPEED LIMIT: 9 1/2 MPH. Please drive slowly and safely.

FIRES: No wood burning fires are allowed in the park. Propane fire pits and grills are allowed. Pellets or charcoal are allowed for use in barbecue grills.

QUIET HOURS: 10 PM to 8 AM. No disturbing noise at any time.

CHILDREN: under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult in all areas of the park. Please understand that riding bicycles, scooters, rollerblades, or skateboards throughout the park can be very dangerous as the park has many blind corners and steep hills. No riding by laundry, pool, bathrooms, rec area or office.

A complete list of Park Rules & Regulations is available in the Park office.

Notice: Pursuant to California Civil Code Section 799.20, et seq. - A recreational vehicle may be removed from the premises without judicial hearing, after the 72-hour notice, if the occupant who has been in the Park for 30 days or less, has either,

1. Failed to pay for his/her occupancy in the Park.
2. Failed to comply with the Park's rules and regulations.
