

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

- A campsite may be occupied by one family or group, maximum of eight people.
- Minors must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Only two vehicles are permitted per campsite. For example, one truck and one camper are considered two vehicles. Tent campers may have up to two tents.
- Any campsite modifications (i.e. changing sites) requested by guests will incur a \$10 fee.
- No washing of vehicles, RVs and/or boats.
- No swimming pools or sprinklers.
- Pets are allowed in designated areas. Pets are not permitted in buildings, on boardwalks or in the playground. Pets must be on a 6-foot, hand-held leash and well behaved. Pets must not be left unattended for more than 30 minutes. Please pick up pet waste and dispose in trash receptables.
- Bicyclists are to observe all traffic laws. Florida law requires all cyclists under the age of 16 to wear a helmet.
- Skateboards, roller skates and bikes not permitted on restroom sidewalks.
- All plants and animals are protected. Feeding animals is prohibited.
- Firewood collection is prohibited.
- Fires must be confined to provided grills.
- Tie nothing to trees, shrubs, or utilities. Hammocks are the only exception, but a minimum of 1 inch straps must be used when hanging to trees.
- Never remove, deface or cut trees, dead or alive.
- Registered campers ONLY in campground.
- Use your holding tanks. A dump station is provided. No discharge of any liquids on the ground.
- No spraying of any chemicals on the ground or on vegetation.
- Place all trash in dumpsters. The dumpsters are locked at night to prevent unwanted wildlife activity.
- Do not give out the gate code.
- Use of drones is prohibited.
- Bear Safety Reminder: Secure your food/coolers in vehicle or camper and dispose of any trash when unattended.
- Cleaning of fish is prohibited in dishwashing sinks.

## RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES



**ACCESSIBLE FACILITIES:** Please call or visit the ranger station to request accommodations.



**BICYCLING:** A 3.5-mile off-road bicycle trail winds through pine flatwoods and oak hammocks.



**BOATING:** A boat basin/marina with a ramp is provided. The Blackwater River, which flows through the park, allows access to the Ten Thousand Islands and the Gulf of America. Please file a float plan with the ranger station before departing. Idle speed on the river within the park.



**CAMPING:** Two campgrounds are available, one with 19 sites in a wooded area is popular with tent campers. The other features 85 sites in a more open area, which is suitable for RVs or tents.



**GROUP AND PRIMITIVE CAMPING:** A group camp is available for non-profit groups, 20 people maximum. A primitive site is also available along the 6.5-mile hiking trail for overnight excursions. Paddlers can also enjoy a primitive campsite through the mangrove wilderness area, along the 13.5-mile canoe and kayak trail. Please call or visit the ranger station for all group and primitive camping reservations.



**FISHING:** The water is brackish. A fishing license may be required (either freshwater or saltwater, depending upon the species). Mangrove snapper, redfish and snook are caught seasonally.



**HIKING:** A 6.5-mile hiking trail winds through pine flatwoods and cypress swamps. This trail is difficult to traverse and requires following trail markings to stay on the correct path. To use this trail, please call or visit the ranger station for more information.



**PADDLING:** Paddlers enjoy the 13.5 mile canoe and kayak trail through the mangrove wilderness area. Kayak and paddleboard rentals are available. Please call or visit the ranger station for further information.



**INTERPRETIVE CENTER Open Daily 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM:** Guided Canoe Trips, Sungazing and Stargazing, and other various interpretive programs are offered seasonally.



**PICNIC PAVILIONS:** Picnic pavilions with picnic tables and charcoal grills are available at the boat basin/marina on a first-come, first-served basis.
