

GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY & ENJOYMENT

Observe the 5 MPH Speed Limit throughout the Campground at all times.
Space Rental is to be paid in advance. Rates apply to one RV and one vehicle. There will be an extra charge for additional vehicles and campers. \$25 fee for tents on RV sites with RV. **RV surge protector required, RV owner assumes all risk of loss, property owner not responsible for damages.**
Visitors are allowed with a fee. They must obtain a car tag at the Office upon arrival and park in the guest or outback parking areas.
Trash Valet Place your bagged trash by the street *before* 11am. Do not leave it out after 11am or out overnight.
Check-Out Time is 11am. Anyone wanting a late check-out must pre-arrange payment with the Office, or you will be charged a full additional day.
Late Check-Out Fee \$25 until 2pm, after 2pm is one full day.
Early Check-in Fee \$25 after 9am. Both subject to availability.
Quiet hours are from 10pm to 8am. Abusive language, drunkenness, and/or possession or use of drugs will not be tolerated at any time. **No generators allowed during quiet hours!**
Campfires: Please do not leave campfires unattended. PLEASE DO NOT PUT TRASH OR GARBAGE IN THE FIREPITS - **WOOD ONLY.** Douse your campfire when not in use.
WE OPERATE UNDER INNKEEPER/GUEST SERVICES LAW.

Pets: We're fond of pets and we hate to see them lost or hurt. Please keep pets on a leash and **do not leave them unattended.** Other folks will appreciate your efforts to clean up after them. Please refer to the site map for the designated dog area. Pets are not allowed in buildings, pool or on playground due to health codes (except for service animals). **No Vicious Dogs Allowed.**
Your site is your responsibility; trash and debris will not be permitted. Outside clotheslines are prohibited. Smokers, please dispose of cigarette butts in one of our ashtrays or trash cans.
Please park on gravel pads. Do not park on the grass or crosswise in a site. Check with the Office for additional parking available in the Outback Area.
Littering Fine \$25 Charged to your site without notice. Firepits are not trash cans or butt cans! Check before departure.
Outside Firewood is prohibited. We sell it in the store.
Please read posted Pool Hours and Rules prior to entering the water.
NO FIREARMS ALLOWED.
NO SWIMMING, NO FLOATING, NO TUBING AND NO RAFTING FROM ELLENSBURG KOA BOAT LAUNCH. RIVER IS EXTREMELY DANGEROUS.

AREA ATTRACTIONS

Our Campground, set on the Yakima River, is the perfect base camp for your adventures. We feature wooded sites, some right on the river. Visit the local attractions, including museums, lakes and hiking trails. Whatever you choose, you'll be glad you came.

History of Ellensburg - Ellensburg, named for Mary Ellen Shoudy, wife of John Shoudy, began as a center for the cattle industry. When the railroad came through in 1886, the city grew and was set to become the state capitol, but the town was devastated by fire in 1889. The citizens quickly rebuilt and started Ellensburg on the path to being the great city it is today.

Walkabout - Get a sense of Ellensburg's early years with a walking tour of its historic downtown. Pick up a map at the Kittitas County Historical Museum and get walking! All but one of the buildings on the tour were built after the 1889 fire and nearly all were built out of brick. The tour runs from 3rd to 6th Avenue and from Main to Pine Street.

Kittitas County Historical Society & Museum - Learn all about Kittitas County at this museum housed in the historic Caldwell Building. View the collections of antique dolls, Native American baskets, rodeo artifacts, early business machines, old automobiles and military items. Open Monday-Saturday, 10am-4pm; til 7pm on the first Friday of the month. Free admission. Located in downtown Ellensburg.

Outdoor Recreation - Enjoy the Yakima River by rafting, fly fishing or picnicking on the shore. Go on the 4.4-mile hike from Lost Lake up to Manastash Lake. Olmstead Place State Park has a log cabin and barns from the late 1800s, as well as walking trails and picnic areas. Scenic Red Top is great for rockhounds; look for agates, crystals and geodes.

First Friday Art Walk - On the first Friday of each month, enjoy a self-guided walking tour of museums and galleries. See paintings, sculptures, photography and more! Venues are open from 5pm-7pm. Free admission.

Ellensburg National Art Show & Auction - On the third weekend in May, over 70 artists display their paintings, sculptures, jewelry, photography and more. Meet

the artists, observe demonstrations, bid in the live and silent auctions. Located at the Kittitas Valley Event Center.

Ellensburg Rodeo & Kittitas County Fair - Don't miss one of America's Top 25 Professional Rodeos! See the best riders, ropers, broncos, rodeo clowns and specialty acts in the business. Alongside the rodeo is the County Fair. It's all about agriculture, livestock, entertainment, food, rides and carnival games. Admission is charged.

Ginkgo Petrified Forest State Park - This 7,470-acre park features petrified wood at the beautiful shoreline on Wanapum Reservoir. Enjoy hiking, picnicking, boating, fishing and the wildlife. Open 6:30am - dusk in the summer and 8am - dusk in the winter; weekends and holidays only. November 6 - March 23. There are some fees. Located 30 miles east of Ellensburg.

Jazz in the Valley - Listen to some of the best jazz in the country! Music lovers come from around the world for three days of jazz, blues and gospel each July. Enjoy over 20 different acts in venues all over Ellensburg. Admission is charged.

Kittitas County Farmers Market - Locally grown fruits and vegetables, flowers, baked goods, hand-crafted items, art and the sounds of local musicians. Open Saturdays, 9am-1pm from May through October. Located in downtown Ellensburg.

Iron Horse State Park - This 1,612-acre park was once part of the path of the Chicago-Pacific Railroad, and still has remnants of the old railroad, including tunnels and trestles. Hike, bike or horseback ride over the 100 miles of trails. Enjoy fishing, bird watching, wildlife viewing, rock climbing and much more. Open daily, 6:30am-9pm in the summer and daily 8am-5pm in the winter. There are some fees.

Irene Rinehart Riverfront Park (People's Pond) - Public park with primitive boat launch, swimming area, picnic area and shelter with surrounding trails and restrooms.
