



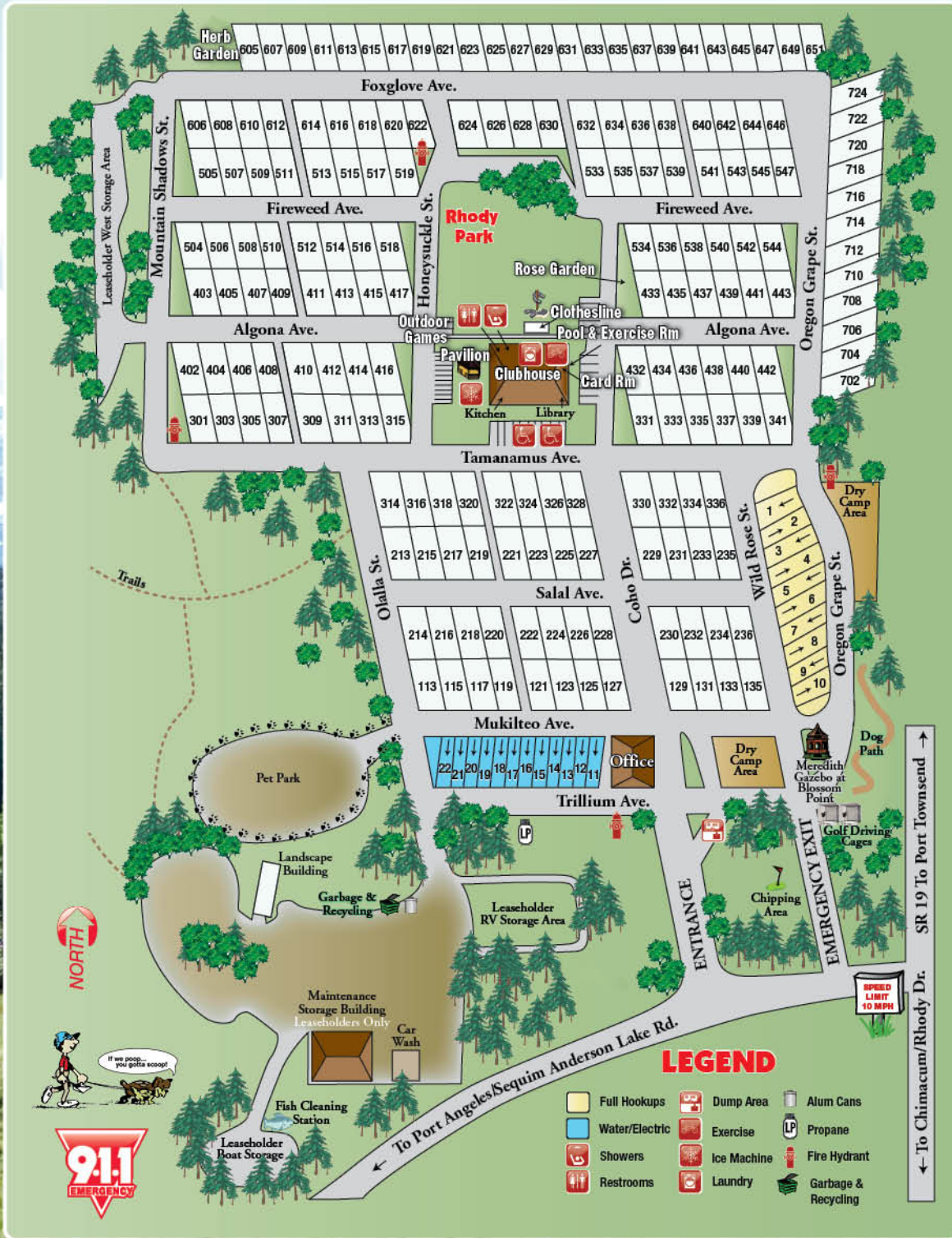

Rules for an Enjoyable Stay for SKP Members and Visitors

We're glad you've come to visit us and hope your stay is great. We'll try to make you feel at home right here in Chimacum. Here is a partial list of our Park rules, see our handout for the complete list of rules.

- Our local law requires that our septic system be accessed by 4-inch screw fittings. Our Park Office can assist you in acquiring one if you don't have one.
- Quiet hours are from 10 PM to 8 AM. We do allow battery charging by generator from 8 AM to 8 PM.
- We encourage recycling. A special container is provided for your aluminum cans, and a box is provided for your cardboard near the dumpsters.
- Our buildings are smoke-free. In order to smoke outside you must be 25' away from all doors and windows.
- You must sign up for using the laundry. You'll find it wonderful to know that you can wash when you wish, and the number of tubs you need will be available. (Quarters are available at the Park Office. Note that the laundry is closed at certain times for cleaning.)

Park Information

Mail: All visitors' mail **MUST** be sent in care of General Delivery, Chimacum, WA 98325. Outgoing mail is picked up at the Park Office.

TV is located in the Clubhouse.

Park Activities: Check the bulletin board in the Clubhouse for various scheduled activities. Enjoy the library, cards and games, exercise equipment, two pool tables, and a warm fire!

Lending Library: We are proud of our Library located in the Clubhouse. All books are categorized and alphabetized by author. There is one section for exchange books – they are well marked. Happy Reading! You will also find a collection of DVDs available to borrow.

Park Wide Wi-Fi: Strong wi-fi signal available in the clubhouse 24 hours per day.

Some Special Places to Visit

Olympic National Park

Visitor's Center and access to Hurricane Ridge at Port Angeles; trail maps also at Ranger Stations.

Rothschild House

Built in 1868, now a Washington State Parks Historical Site, in Port Townsend, on Franklin and Taylor Streets.

Museum of Jefferson County Historical Society

Encompasses four floors of Port Townsend's historic City Hall, some of which is still used for city offices; 210 Madison St.

Port Townsend Aero Museum

Rediscover the excitement of Aircraft & Civic aeronautics.

Jefferson County Court House

The landmark building of Port Townsend from land and sea.

Victorian Homes

Many can be seen by driving Port Townsend Streets, some give tours, many are Bed and Breakfast Inns. Walk along Water Street and see many fine buildings on the National Register of Historic Places.

Chezemoka City Park

In Port Townsend at the end of Blaine Street overlooking Admiralty Inlet, flower gardens, playgrounds, picnic areas and beach access.

Fort Worden State Park

North tip of Quimper Peninsula in Port Townsend; was used to guard Puget Sound, and is now enjoyed for hiking, camping, conferences, concerts, beachcombing, boating and fishing.

Old Fort Townsend State Park

Woody setting on the bay, east side of Quimper Peninsula for camping, beach, etc.

H.J. Carroll Multipurpose Park & Athletic Center

Disc golf, walking trail & native plant garden.

Anderson Lake State Park

One mile west of our Park, a tranquil day-use area for easy hiking around the lake.

Lion's Park

Indian Island, near the bridge, on the channel between Oak Bay and Port Townsend Bay.

Mystery Bay State Park

On Marrowstone Island; boating, camping, pier and dock, fishing and clamming.

East Beach County Park

A day-use park on Marrowstone Island to picnic and watch the oceangoing ships in Puget Sound.

Fort Flagler State Park

Situated on the north tip of Marrowstone Island, originally one of the protective forts of Puget Sound. Explore the bunkers, beaches, trails, camp, picnic and boat.

Oak Bay County Park

Forest and beach setting for picnicking, camping, clamming, boating and fishing.

Mats Mats Beach

North of Port Ludlow off Oak Bay Rd; salt water boat launch.

Larry Scott Trail

Hike and bike from nearby Four Corners Trailhead to Port Townsend Waterfront.

Olympic Discovery Trail

Washington State's premier destination for non-motorized touring. Visit olympicdiscoverytrail.org for map & info.
