



Guidelines for Everyone's Safety & Enjoyment

- Check-out** time is 12 noon. Please notify the Office by 10 AM if you wish to extend your stay. Your site may be reserved for another camper. Notify the Office to make arrangements for **LATE DEPARTURE**. (FEE)
- Speed Limits:** Posted speed limits are for the protection of all our campers and pets. Please observe the 7½ mph maximum limit and one-way counter-clockwise traffic pattern.
- Fires:** Fires at RV sites must be in grills or hibachis with sufficient legs to prevent damage to grounds. Always practice fire safety and completely extinguish fires before retiring or leaving. Firewood piles are not permitted. Please purchase wood as you use it to prevent wood bugs/termites etc. We have raised fire pits and firewood available for a fee.
- Vehicles:** Maximum one RV and two registered vehicles per site. Extra vehicles/trailers must be stored (fee may apply) or removed from the property. **No 4-wheelers allowed.** Golf carts may be used for transportation in the campground, and must be driven by a licensed driver. You must have your tow vehicle onsite - no camper drop off's permitted.
- Trash:** Please keep your site clean and orderly. Place tied plastic bags beside the road by **10 AM for pickup** or you may put them in the dumpster provided. **DO NOT** leave trash out at night. (We have critters!) No bulk items accepted.
- Pets:** Pets love camping, and we love pets! Please keep them leashed and quiet at all times. **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR PET TIED OUTSIDE UNATTENDED.** Always clean up after your pet. **\$25 cleaning fee will be charged for any pet waste not removed from your site.** We provide a fenced pet exercise area so your pet can run off some of that energy. Only a small 6'x9' dog enclosure is allowed, pets MUST always be supervised.
- Quiet Hours:** Radios, etc. must be confined to your site and must not disturb other campers. Quiet hours are 10 PM - 8 AM. Noise or conduct that disturbs or annoys others will not be tolerated. No generators.
- Children & Guests:** You are responsible for the actions and behavior of children and guests. Young children should always be accompanied by an adult. All children must be on their campsite after sunset.
- Swimming Pool:** Parents, Please Note: There is **NOLIFEGUARD** on duty. **Children under the age of 14 may not swim without an adult in attendance.** Proper attire required - no swimming in street clothes or cutoffs. Babies who wear diapers **MUST** wear swim diapers in the pool. Pool hours and rules are posted in the pool area.
- Restrooms & Laundry:** Open 24 Hours. Laundry machines accept quarters or pay by phone app. Restrooms are closed daily for cleaning.
- Think Environmental:** Please conserve water and make sure faucets are turned completely off. Do not chop, nail, or otherwise damage trees. For everyone's safety, clotheslines are not allowed.
- RV/Vehicle Washing/Maintenance:** **Do not wash your RV or vehicle at your campsite.** No vehicle maintenance allowed.
- Visitors:** All visitors must register at the Office (fee may apply).
- Smokers:** Please dispose of cigarettes properly - do not toss them on the ground.
- Alcohol:** Keep alcoholic beverage use low-key and on your site. Excessive drinking will not be tolerated.
- Fireworks** are not allowed; **FIREARMS** may not be used within the campground.
- Sites with no patios are allowed one (1) breathable rug. If you have a patio site, NO rugs are allowed on the grass.

All major attractions and theme parks are within easy driving distance.

- The Fine Print:** We will ask anyone to leave the campground, **WITHOUT REFUND**, who does not abide by these rules or who we feel is disturbing the camping experience of others. Management assumes no responsibility for accidents, injuries, or loss of property. Orange Blossom KOA is a privately owned enterprise, and as such reserves the right to refuse service to anyone.
- No refunds for early departures.**
- No tent camping permitted.

VISITOR POLICY

Please tell us if you are expecting guests so that we may know who should be in the Park and who shouldn't be. Thank You!

- Guests must stop at the Office, OR Camper may tell us they are coming.
- Charge will apply for visitors spending the night and/or using facilities (pool, etc.).
- No more than 3 vehicles on a site (RV+ 2 vehicles). Extra vehicles must park in the visitor parking.
- NOTE: We do not have a limit on number of visitors/site, but we will exercise our judgement if we determine that there are too many people on site.

Our current RV pedestals offering 30-or 50-amp service across the KOA system do not meet the requirements for charging EV vehicles. Even with an adapter, campers should not plug into these pedestals as it can cause permanent damage to our electrical infrastructure and the guest's electric vehicle.
