Lisbon Beach & Campground Etiquette

Be Considerate of Other Campers

1. All campers agree to obey the rules and regulations of the Campground Director, who is in charge of the campground, including picnic areas, boat docks, pavilion, and beach.
2. Quiet hours: 10 pm - 8 am. All guests visiting campsites must depart by 11 pm. Only registered campers will be allowed to enter the campground. Campers are responsible for their guests. The gate is closed at 10 pm. If you are coming or going after 10 pm please close the gate behind you. Do not push gate open with a vehicle. Campers and guests may be expelled for any unwarranted actions. Each campsite is limited to immediate family (parents/guardians and unmarried children) or a total of 5 persons. There is a limit of 2 vehicles parked at each site.
3. No discharge of water/waste from campers onto the ground or into the river for any reason.
4. All pets must be restrained at all times and cannot run free. All pets must have proper vaccination records when arriving. Owners are responsible for damage/injuries sustained from their pets. Owners are required to pick up after their pets and utilize the pet area.
5. The new dump station shall be used during the posted hours only. No dumping is allowed between the hours of 10 pm and 6 am.
6. All garbage is to be bagged and disposed of in the provided dumpster. Dumpsters are for camper trash only, no furniture or other items. Do not bring trash from home and put in dumpster.
7. Water faucets are provided for general use. No permanent hose hook-ups are allowed.
8. Bathhouse showers are for campers only.
9. All individuals must be at least 21 years of age to register for a campsite and must remain on the campsite during the hours of 10 pm and 8 am. The Campground Director may require proof of age.
10. One picnic table is allowed per site, unless special permission is granted for a specific need.
11. Check-out time is 11 am. If you are still on your rented site after 11 am you will be charged for another night.
12. Only persons 21 years of age and older will be allowed to consume alcoholic beverages. All persons are responsible for their actions while using these products. Anyone who does not abide by these rules will be asked to leave. There will be no alcoholic beverages or glass bottles on the beach. Alcohol may only be consumed at your site. When at the pavilion, alcohol must be consumed at the pavilion.
13. All campers are expected to keep their campsite neat and in clean condition. Wood must be stacked in an orderly fashion near the camper's fire pit.
14. All campers must have UL extension molded plugs.
15. All campers must be 10 feet apart, parked between the posts and at an angle. No post-to-post parking. Campers will park correctly or be asked to leave.
16. Only wood is to be burned in the fire pits, no trash or garbage. Fires must be attended to and put out prior to leaving. Do not burn pallets or wood other than firewood. Do not operate a chainsaw.
17. Obey the Speed Limits.
18. Organized parties are not allowed on sites. Campfires among friends are permitted as long as they are quiet. Respect other campers and their right to privacy and peaceful camping.
19. All season passes must be stuck on the outside, driver side, of vehicle windows and not passed around between vehicles.
20. We reserve the right to place campers when reserving sites.
21. One small tent is allowed on an electric site in addition to a camper, with permission from the Campground Director. A full size tent needs to be placed on a tent site, with permission from the Campground Director.
22. No Fireworks.
23. If you are using an additional refrigerator you will be charged an extra \$2 per day.
24. No ATVs or motorized vehicles with gas powered engines are allowed on the grounds besides cars, trucks and vans. Anyone driving a vehicle/golf cart is required to have a valid NYS driver's license. Adults with valid driver's license may operate a golf cart, safely, while all occupants are seated. No alcohol consumed while operating golf carts.
25. Please do not bring items that use excessive running water such as pools, slides, sprinklers, blow-up water toys, or anything that requires running water to operate properly.
26. Children are not allowed to operate battery powered scooters, 4 wheelers, etc.
