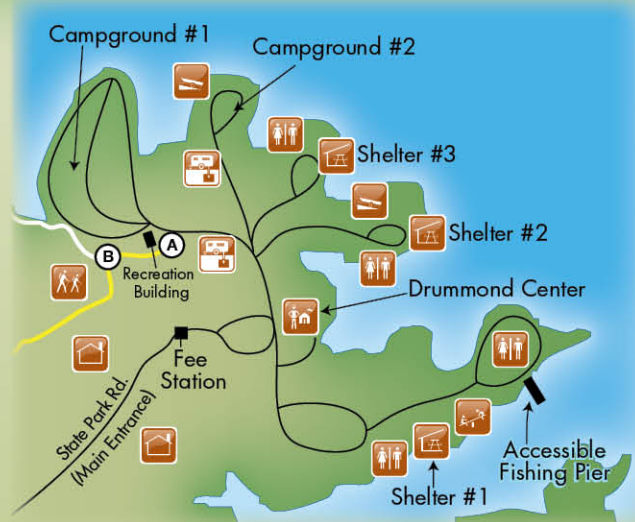
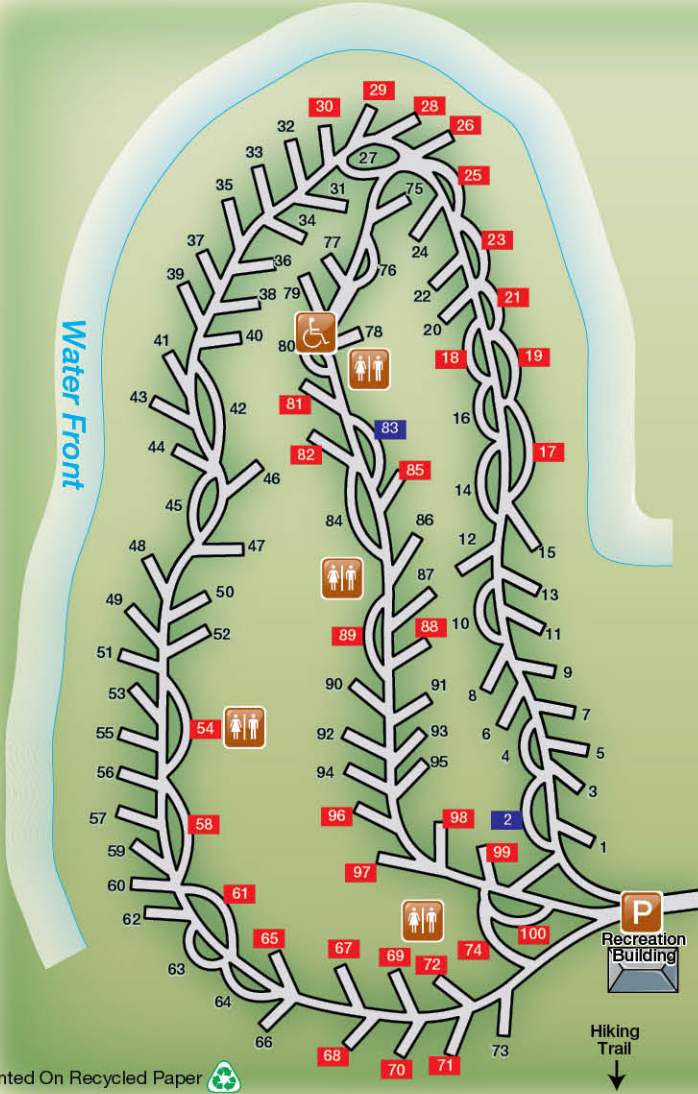

Campground Rules and Regulations

APRIL 1ST THRU AUGUST 31ST: 14-DAY STAY LIMIT, THEN MUST VACATE FOR AT LEAST 7 CONSECUTIVE DAYS.

- Campers are allowed a maximum of one trailer/RV and one tent OR two tents per site. No more than six (6) persons (or one family) may occupy the same site.
- Visitors not registered for an overnight stay are required to pay park admission.
- Two sites designated for use by disabled persons are available at each park.
- **Camping check-in time is 2 p.m.** If you arrive earlier than 2 p.m. you may have to wait until your site is vacated and cleaned. **Check-out time is 12 noon.**
- **Quiet hours are 10 p.m. - 7 a.m.**
- Maximum length of stay on a particular site during periods of high demand is 14 nights. Longer stays are allowed during periods of less demand.
- **Alcoholic beverages are Strictly prohibited.**
- **Pets must be on a leash** (not longer than six feet) or under physically restrictive control at all times. Owners will be asked to remove noisy or dangerous pets or pets that threaten or harass wildlife. Please pick up your pet's waste.
- It is unlawful to dispose of any waste (including gray water) in places or receptacles other than those specifically designed for that purpose.
- All fires must be supervised and confined to designated fire rings.
- It is unlawful to cut, damage, or remove plants, shrubs, or trees.
- It is unlawful to possess or discharge fireworks or other explosives.
- Only licensed vehicles may be operated in a state park and must remain in areas specifically intended for vehicular traffic. Golf carts must display a valid permit at all times.
- Cancellations and changes are subject to fees based on the notice given. Early departures are subject to cancellation policies.
- Registered campers may not change sites without permission from park staff.
- SC residents age 65 or older, 100% disabled or Active SC National Guard members may register for a campsite at a discounted rate. Only one discount allowed per household and the qualifying individual must be present and occupy the site for the duration of stay.
- A Maximum of two (2) vehicles are allowed on each campsite. Any additional vehicles must be parked in an additional parking lot. Parking on an unoccupied campsite is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.

IMPORTANT

ALL SITES ARE RESERVABLE. PLEASE CHECK IN AT OFFICE BEFORE SETTING UP ON SITE.

USE OF GOLF CARTS:

PERSONAL GOLF CART USE INCURS A \$5 PER NIGHT CHARGE BASED ON THE LENGTH OF YOUR STAY. GOLF CARTS MUST HAVE APPROPRIATE PARK DECAL AND DMV LICENSE DECAL SECURELY FASTENED TO THE CART. GOLF CARTS MAY ONLY BE OPERATED ON PARK ROADS DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS. OPERATOR MUST HAVE A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE. OPERATOR SHALL ADHERE TO LAWS CONCERNING THE USE OF ANY VEHICLE ON ROADS.

To ensure that your State Park experience is enjoyable, please be aware of the dynamic characteristics of the natural environment. There are some areas that may be potentially hazardous. All visitors should exercise caution when visiting any state park. Anyone who is unsure about possible hazards should contact a Park Ranger.
