

## QUAIL RIDGE PARK RULES

- No loud sounds. If your neighbor can hear it, it's too loud! Quiet time is 9 p.m. - 7 a.m.
- Keep your sewer hoses off the ground. This is a city regulation.
- There is a speed limit of 10 MPH. This is for everyone's safety. Driving through sites is not allowed. All ATV/Motorcycles/Vehicles must be licensed and insured per the state of Arizona.
- If you own a dog or cat, the following rules apply to you:
  - All pets must be accompanied by its owner on a leash, fenced or tied up. Do not leave your pet alone outside. Leashes must not exceed Arizona State Leash Law of 6 ft.
  - All pet owners must immediately clean up any stool left by their pet anywhere in the resort.
  - All pets must be friendly to other pets and people to use the common areas.

**KARTCHNER CAVERNS** – One of the most beautiful caverns in the world, only 10 minutes from the park.

**SIERRA VISTA** – A clean modern town offering shopping centers, over 30 restaurants and lots of recreational opportunities.

**FORT HUACHUCA** – The museum of the Old Post is a registered National Historic Landmark and Site. Established in 1877 in response to the indian wars of the 1870s and 1880s. An active Army Post still in use today.

**BISBEE** – Once known as “Queen of the Mining Camps” has one of the largest open pit copper mines in the world. Scenic, historic buildings built on the hillsides of the Mule Mountains.

**MILE HI/RAMSEY CANYON PRESERVE** – Includes 280 acres in a wooded sheltered gorge located in the Huachuca Mountains. At least 14 species of hummingbirds have been seen at Mile Hi, more than at any other place in the United States. A nature walk and bird feeding places let you observe the various hummingbirds.

**TOMBSTONE** – Authentic 1880s wild west town, complete with original buildings and artifacts. Home to Boothill Cemetery and the famous O.K. Corral.

**NOGALES, MEXICO** – Nice area - clean - good shopping

**PATAGONIA** – Bird watching - fishing - water skiing

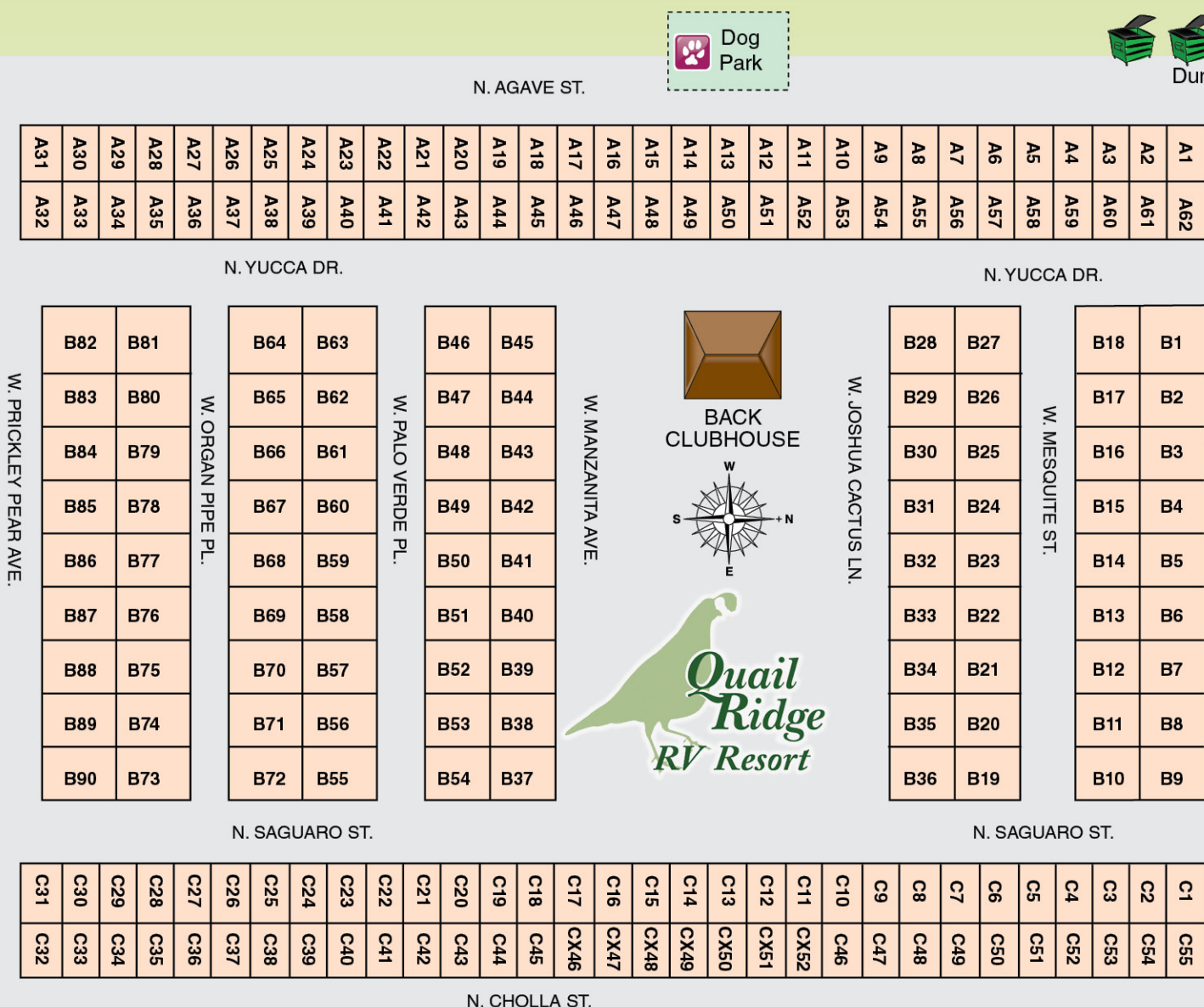
