

RESORT RULES AND REGULATIONS

For your safety and enjoyment, please observe all rules and regulations below

REGISTRATION: Check-in 12:00 PM / Check-out 11:00 AM.

QUIET HOURS: 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM

1. Site registration is for ONE RV and ONE VEHICLE. EXTRA vehicles, boats, and trailers will be charged an additional amount and must be parked in overflow parking. No parking in unoccupied sites or on the grass. ATVs are not permitted in the park.
2. No clotheslines. Do not hang towels or clothes from RV. Do not attach rope to trees. No hammocks.
3. Please keep your site clean.
4. RV or car washing is NOT permitted.
5. Any damage to water, sewer, or electrical hookup is a minimum \$50.00 fee.
6. You cannot be plugged into multiple power outlets, only one per site.
7. Visitors of registered guests MUST obtain a day pass from the office, pay a fee and get a temporary parking permit and park in overflow parking.
8. Absolutely no parking in RV sites or on grass.
9. Campfires - Only propane fire pits are allowed. No wood or charcoal.

CONDUCT: Persons violating any local, state, or federal laws OR engaging in loud, disruptive or disorderly conduct or vandalism will be asked to leave the resort. Guests are responsible for losses, damage, or injury to persons or property caused by their own negligence.

SOLICITATION: Absolutely no solicitation or sales of goods/services on resort premises without prior management approval.

FIREARMS/FIREWORKS: Are strictly prohibited on resort property.

RESTROOMS/SHOWERS: We ask your cooperation in keeping the restrooms and showers clean; please pick up after yourself. No washing dishes or pets in the restroom/shower facilities.

ADDITIONAL RULES: Please adhere to all signs posted throughout the resort and please abide by any additional rules and regulations that are distributed at time of registration.

Anyone found to be in violation of the rules and regulations may be asked to leave the resort.

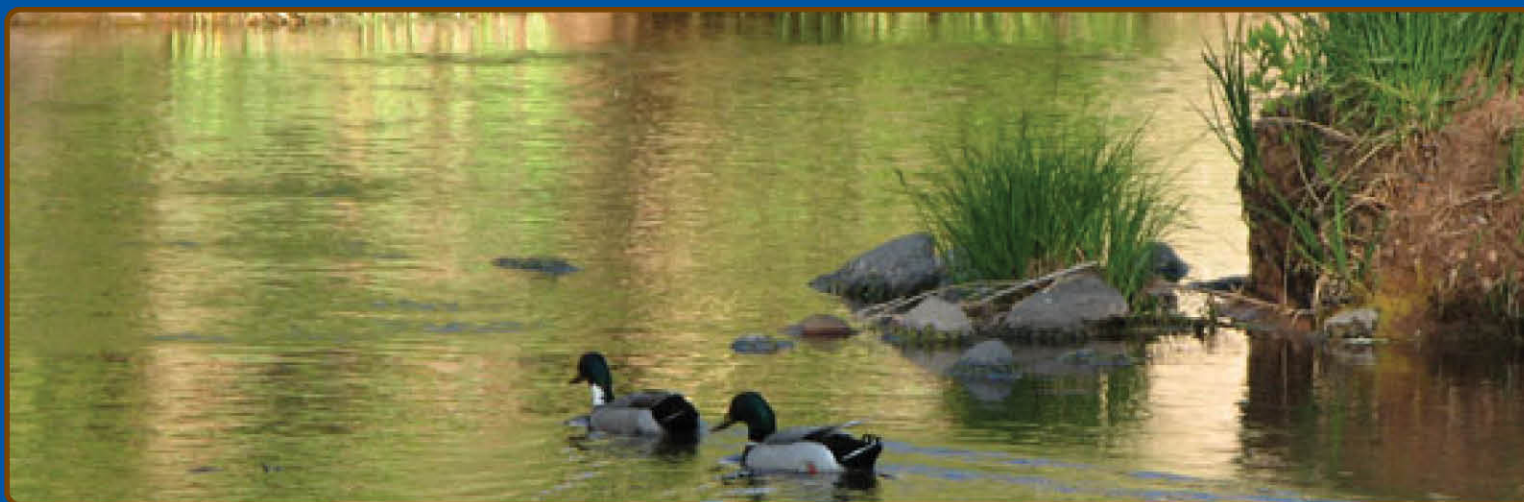
PET POLICY


