

South Toledo Bend State Park is pleasantly located on several small bluffs that extend over and into the Toledo Bend Reservoir and offers a scenic, waterfront view from many vantage points. While the reservoir is nationally recognized as a destination for bass fishing tournaments, visitors to the park can also enjoy other outdoor recreational activities such as hiking, cycling, birding, camping and enjoying the many forms of wildlife in the area. The area also is a common nesting ground for the bald eagle, which feeds from the plentiful supply of freshwater fish including largemouth bass, catfish, bream and white perch found in the Reservoir. The avid fisher can set out onto the reservoir at the two-lane boat ramp area to also enjoy a freshly-caught dinner. An open-air breezeway leads out to the observation deck and a majestic view of the reservoir lake and nearby islands. A 3,000-foot surfaced nature trail provides an opportunity for all visitors to explore the area around the Visitor Center and the RV camping areas. Also nestled among the trees near the Visitor Center are several picnic tables, so visitors can enjoy a lunch or snack while enjoying their day at South Toledo Bend State Park.

PARK INFORMATION & RULES

OFFICE HOURS: Sunday-Thursday: 8 am-5 pm. Friday, Saturday, and the day before a holiday: 8 am-8 pm.

PARK GATES: Sunday – Thursday: 6 am to 10 pm. Friday, Saturday, and the day before all holidays: 6 am to 10 pm.

SPEED LIMIT: 15 MPH.

TRASH: All trash must be placed in receptacles provided throughout the campground and park.

FIRES: Campfires are permitted within provided fire rings, except during burn bans.

FIREWOOD: Collection is limited to fallen dead timber.

GREY WATER: Must be disposed at the dump station.

PETS: Must be kept on a leash no longer than six feet in length, or crated; pets may be not left unattended. Pets are not allowed inside any park structures including porches. No pets on beach.

QUIET HOURS: Observed between 10 pm and 6 am.


CAMPERS UNDER 21 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.


LENGTH OF STAY: Limited to 14 nights unless approved by park manager.


CAMPSITES: **CHECK-IN** is at 2 pm. **CHECK-OUT** is at 1 pm.


CABINS: **CHECK-IN** is at 3 pm. **CHECK-OUT** is at 11 am.


ATV's AND GOLF CARTS: **NO ATV's OR SIDE-BY-SIDES ALLOWED ON ROAD IN MAIN PARK, GOLF CARTS ALLOWED, MUST BE INSURED.**


 **Boating** - One boat launch.


 **Camping** - 42 improved campsites and 13 premium campsites, all with water and electrical hookups. 5 primitive campsites overlook the reservoir.


 **Cabins** - 19 cabins; 2 are ADA compliant; each sleeps up to 8 people with 1 queen bed, 2 bunk beds and 1 queen sofa sleeper. Basic cookware, cooking utensils, dinnerware, silverware, towels and linens are provided. Bring your own food and personal supplies.


 **Fishing** - Located on several small bluffs that extend over and into the southern end of the Toledo Bend Reservoir, South Toledo Bend State Park offers a nationally-recognized destination for bass fishing.

 **Hiking/Nature Trails** - Lakeview Nature Trail is 1/2 mile, Hippie Point Trail is 1-1/2 miles, and the Bald Eagle Hike is 3/4 mile long.

 **Picnicking** - Picnic tables and barbecue grills are available in the day-use area.

 **Swimming** - A designated beach area is available in the campground. Lifeguard supervision is not provided; park visitors swim at their own risk.

 **Meeting Room** - The park's meeting room is available for rent. Seating is available for up to 60 people. The facility contains a warming kitchen.

 **ATV Trail** - The trail system, open year-round, offers 9 loops for a total 9.2 miles. Riders are subject to all state laws regarding off-road vehicles. Must be trailered to ATV Park.
