CAMPGROUND COURTESIES

The following rules have been designed to ensure that all visitors to the Estes Park Campgrounds will have a safe and enjoyable visit. Please read and respect these guidelines. Violators of our campground rules will be asked to leave the campground without a refund.

GENERAL

- Check-out time is 11:00 a.m. and check-in time is 2:00 p.m.
- **There are no refunds for early departures.**
- The speed limit in the campground is 5 mph at all times.
- Quiet time is 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Excessive noise will not be tolerated.
- No generators or amplified music at any time.
- Playground closed during quiet time.
- Public intoxication and disorderly conduct are not tolerated and may lead to eviction. No kegs.
- Restrooms and showers are cleaned between the hours of 12:30 p.m. and 3:30 p.m.
- Limit of 6 people per camp site. Limit of 10 people in double sites. Strictly enforced.
- Tent-only sites allow up to 2 tents as long as they both fit on the designated tent pad. Tents are not allowed off the pad.
- Only one RV/Trailer with one vehicle are permitted in RV-only water & electric and no hookup sites. Tents are not allowed in RV-only sites.
- Only one dining canopy allowed per site. Two dining canopies allowed only in double sites.
- Hammocks are allowed as long as trees are not damaged and they are within the designated campsite.
- Vehicles and camping units must be parked in designated parking spots. No vehicle washing. One vehicle per site strictly enforced. Extra vehicles must display a valid parking permit and must be parked in a designated overflow space. Two cars allowed only in double sites.
- ATVs, unlicensed dirt bikes, and UTVs are not allowed to be ridden in the campground.
- Firearm carry and use in accordance with federal, state, and local law. Fireworks are prohibited.
- Cutting tree branches, damaging bark, gathering firewood, or driving nails into trees is strictly prohibited.
- No personal porta potties or showers. Please use provided facilities.
- Do NOT dispose of grey or black water on the ground. Use the dump station.
- Possession and use of marijuana is strictly prohibited.
- No swimming or boating in the East Portal Reservoir due to dangerous undertow.
- No drones over campground, reservoir, or adjacent BOR property.

CAMPFIRES

- Fires are allowed only in fire rings and must never be left unattended. Do not move fire rings.
- Fires are allowed as long as there are no fire restrictions in place by the local authority.
- Please put your fire out completely with water before retiring.
- Please purchase firewood locally and do not transport to other areas. This prevents the spread of tree-killing organisms such as the mountain pine beetle.

FOOD STORAGE

- Proper food storage is required. There are black bears in the area.
- All food items must be stored in a locked vehicle or bear-proof food locker where provided. This includes coolers empty or full.
- Food, grills, coolers, and garbage are not to be left out in an unattended camp site.
- Bird feeders are not permitted.

GARBAGE

- Please use the designated dumpsters for your trash. Do not store trash in food lockers. Do not burn trash in fire rings.
- Do not deposit used fuel canisters in the trash dumpsters! Please take them with you as we are unable to dispose of them.

PETS

- Pets must be kept under control and on a leash no longer than 10 feet.
- Pets are not allowed in any of the buildings or playground area.
- Please clean up your pet's waste. Doggy bags are provided throughout the campground.
- Pets cannot be left unattended in your camp site. Please ask your campground staff for information on local pet daycare facilities if you need to make accommodations.

EMERGENCY: In case of emergency, call 911; for other issues, contact a camp host.
