****This property is privately owned. We reserve the right to refuse service to and also to remove anyone at anytime that does not comply with the campground rules, or for any reason deemed a safety concern to themselves or other guests. We are not responsible for accidents or injury to our guest, or for lost or stolen personal property.**

****ALL VISITORS MUST CHECK IN AT THE OFFICE, OBTAIN A PASS, and PAY VISITOR FEE****NO EXCEPTIONS******

****Cutting down of trees within the campground is absolutely prohibited and grounds for immediate removal from the campground! **Anyone creating a public disturbance will be removed from the campground.**

- **Speed Limit is 5mph.** Zero tolerance for speeding!
- **Quiet Hours** are 10 pm-7 am ****NO GENERATORS.**
- **Check-out** time is 11 am.
- **Recycling** - For bottles and cans only, container is located by dumpster.
- **Dumpster** - Please dispose of all bags of trash in the dumpster across from the office-not in the bathrooms!
- **Pool** - Pool hours are 8am-dark. All children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Swim at your own risk as we have **NO** lifeguard on duty, **NO DIVING OR JUMPING** is allowed. No smoking, alcohol, food or glass containers in the pool area.
- **Playground** - Children 12 and under must have adult supervision and **ALL** play is at **YOUR OWN RISK.**
- **Pets** - Pets are welcome! They must be leashed at all times, attended and cleaned up after. They **CAN NOT** be left in tents or cabins unattended.
- **Bathrooms** - Please clean up after yourself! **DO NOT** flush any baby wipes or feminine hygiene products. We like to keep our bathrooms clean for all of our guests. If bathrooms need attention please call 207-447-8485.

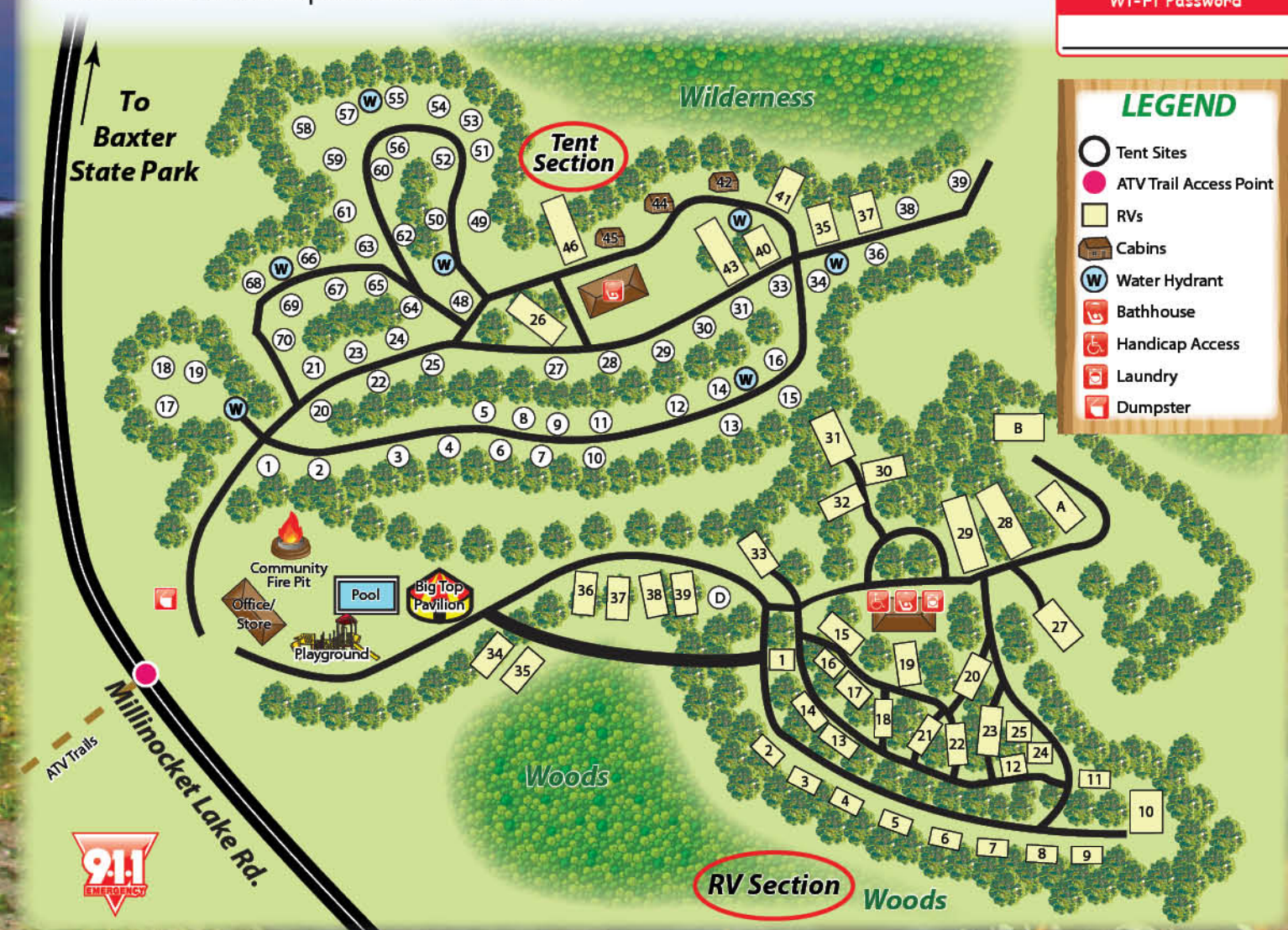
- **Bicycles** - For your safety, please do not ride bicycles in the campground after dark. Helmets must be worn at all times for safety.
- **ATVs** - ATVs are welcome to be operated within the campground but must not exceed 5mph and must adhere to all campground rules which will be strictly enforced. Helmets must be worn for ages 16 and younger. There is zero tolerance for reckless operation. **NO DIRT BIKES.** Must be 16 to operate in the campground.
- **Fireworks** - Fireworks are strictly prohibited in the campground.
- **Fires** - Campfires must be contained to the ring (**firewood must fit inside the ring and be no longer than 24"**) and be attended at all times. **DO NOT** burn cans, bottles or plastic—Paper and Wood **ONLY.**
