IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- *Guests must be 21 years of age to rent a site at the campground.*
- *Check-out is 11AM. If you need to stay longer, check in at the office.*
- *Parking for car or tow vehicles is at your site only. Please check at the office if additional space is needed.*
- *Quiet hours are 10 PM-8 AM. No generators allowed ever and no loud music.*
- *Please maintain a 5 MPH speed limit throughout the park.*
- *No smoking or pets allowed in cabins, restrooms or office.*
- *Tents are to be placed to the right side of picnic tables in the sites (only 1 large or 2 small tents per site).*
- *No pools, hot tubs, clotheslines, large outdoor mats on the grass or washing of vehicles allowed.*
- *All visitors must check in at the office for a parking pass.*
- *Please be aware of the creek as there is no lifeguard on duty. All boating and swimming is at your own risk.*
- *Enclosed tents are not allowed in RV sites, canopy tents only.*

GENERAL GUEST RESPONSIBILITIES:

- **AT ALL TIMES**, parents are responsible for their children's safety and welfare, and minors must be under direct supervision of an adult.
- If you lose your cabin key, a fee of \$10.00 will be assessed to replace the key.
- The paying registered guest is responsible for any damages incurred to the campground facilities or grounds by themselves, their pets, or any member of their party.
- The campground will not be held liable for accidents, injuries or loss by fire, theft or any act of nature. Please notify us if any hazardous conditions are found.
- Please put trash in bags and deposit in the trash receptacles provided. Do not burn trash in the fire pits.
- Please do not leave pets unattended outside at anytime.

FIRES & CAMPFIRES:

- Fires are permitted inside the fire rings only. Please do not move the fire rings. Wood is sold at the camp store. **PLEASE DO NOT GATHER WOOD** from the mountainside!
- No wood-burning campfires in RV spots. Please use the provided campfire rings close by or your own propane campfire rings.
- No fuel-burning appliances (lanterns, heaters, stoves, etc.) may be used inside or on the decks of the cabins.
- Fires in the fire rings should only be knee high. **NO BONFIRES!**
- **DO NOT LEAVE FIRES UNATTENDED AT ANY TIME!** You are responsible for any fire that you start and any damage that results thereof. **PLEASE USE EXTREME CAUTION.**
- All fires should be extinguished **COMPLETELY** before retiring.
