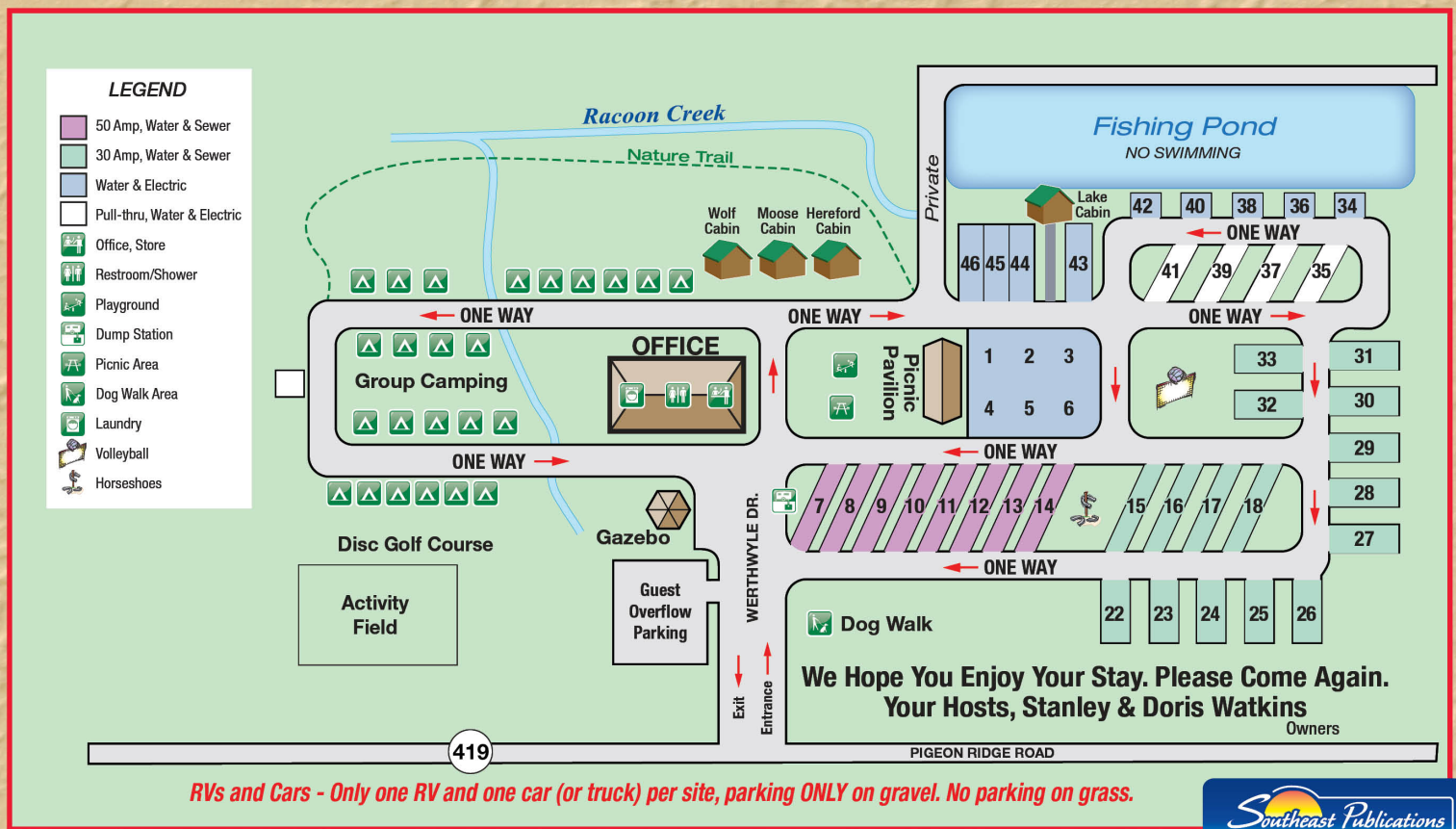

For Safety and Enjoyment for Everyone, Observe the Following:

1. **CHECK-IN IS 12:00 NOON AND CHECK-OUT TIME IS 11:00 AM.** Please re-register for additional days by 10:00 am.
2. **QUIET HOURS** - Between 10:00 pm and 7:00 am. Children should be at their campsite and/or supervised by 10:00 pm.
3. **GENERATORS** - Not permitted except during campground power failures.
4. **VISITORS** - A reasonable number of visitors are welcome. All visitors must register at the office upon arrival and pay a visitor fee of \$5.00 per person. All day visitors must leave the campground by 10:00 pm.
5. **PETS** - Welcome but must be kept on a leash at all times. Pets are not to be left unattended. No pets allowed in camp store, restrooms, playground, or log cabins. All pets staying at Ballyhoo have their own restroom located at the pet walk area. Please clean-up after them and use our doggy dumpster. Limit two pets per site, no aggressive breeds. No pet fences.
6. **CAMPFIRES** - A small campfire may be built in the fire ring provided. Chopping or cutting wood is not permitted. **DO NOT MOVE THE FIRE RING FOR ANY REASON. FIREWOOD** - Firewood may be purchased at the camp store. Do not remove bark from standing trees.
7. **NO CAMPING RUGS ON GRASS.**
8. **SMOKING** - Not permitted in any campground buildings, including cabins. Please dispose of cigarette butts in proper containers.
9. **DO NOT** spill grey water on the ground (Tennessee Law). No washing vehicles. No repair work allowed.
10. **FIREWORKS and FIREARMS** - Strictly forbidden for the safety of everyone.
11. **RADIOS and TVs** - Loud radios or televisions are not permitted. If your neighbor can hear it, it's too loud.
12. **GARBAGE** - Bag and tie garbage and place in containers.
13. **ATVs - ORVs** and unlicensed motorcycles are not to be operated anywhere on campground property. Handicap access only.
14. **CATCH and RELEASE FISHING** - Our pond is for fishing only. NO SWIMMING. No fishing dusk to dawn.
15. **PLEASE** - Respect other campers and use designated roads, crosswalks and paths.
16. **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** - Permitted at campsites only.
17. **WE RESERVE THE RIGHT** to enforce our rules to NOT register undesirable guests. We also reserve the right to evict anyone from premises for detrimental conduct and/or violating any of the above rules without refund.
