## WELCOME

### Overview

Your National Forests offer a diversity of outdoor opportunities. These lands are yours - to visit, to care for, but most of all, to enjoy. What are you waiting for? Pack up your family and friends and head for adventure in America's Great Outdoors. The San Bernardino National Forest offers a variety of recreational opportunities...hiking & backpacking, trail riding by horse, bicycle, off-highway vehicles, camping and picnicking, and fishing, and don't forget winter activities such as snowshoeing, cross-country and alpine skiing.

Recreation passes and permits, like the Adventure Pass, are required for use of certain recreation sites and areas in the forest, and for certain facilities and services.

### Rules & Regulations

For everyone's enjoyment and safety, please adhere to the rules and regulations.

- Speed limit is **10 miles per hour** in campground! (Children at play, people walking and riding bikes).
- Park all 4 tires on pavement.
- **Back into your site.** This is a safety precaution in case of an evacuation.
- Fires must be kept small and in the fire ring. Firewood only! (Except during the fire restrictions, then no fires are allowed).
- No chainsaws!
- Quiet hours are from **10 p.m. to 6 a.m.** (Voices travel at night. Keep it down to a whisper at your campfire after 10 p.m.)
- **Dogs must be restrained at all times.** Dogs must be on a leash (no longer than 6 feet) and attached to a person, or in a kennel.
- Please clean up after your pet.
- Do not wash your dishes or bathe in the hydrants; this will clog the drains and attract wild animals.
- Do not leave food out; we are in Bear Country!
- Please do not walk through occupied camp sites.
- Check out is at **NOON**; sites need to be cleaned for the next campers.

**No projectiles of any kind in campground. (Guns, bows, sling shots).**  
**No more than 8 people in a single site and 16 in a double site. This is strongly enforced.**

### Getting There:

Travel east on I-10 (Highway 330) to Running Springs. Turn onto Highway 18 and continue to Big Bear Lake Dam but do not cross the Dam. Highway 18 becomes Highway 38. Continue to the Fawnskin Fire Station and turn left onto Rim of the World Drive (Forest Route 3N14) and drive 2.5 miles to the campground. More than a mile of the road is rough, dirt terrain that may be impassable for large RVs or trailers.
