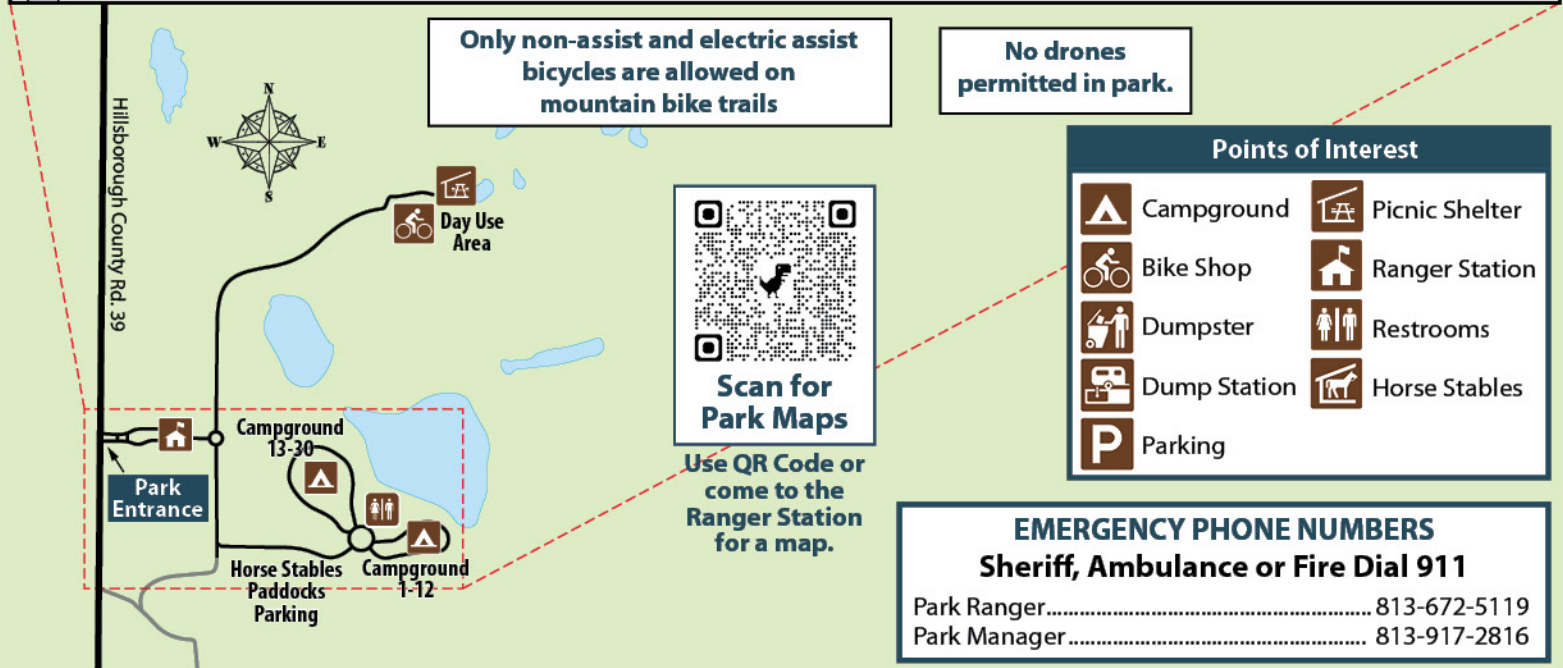
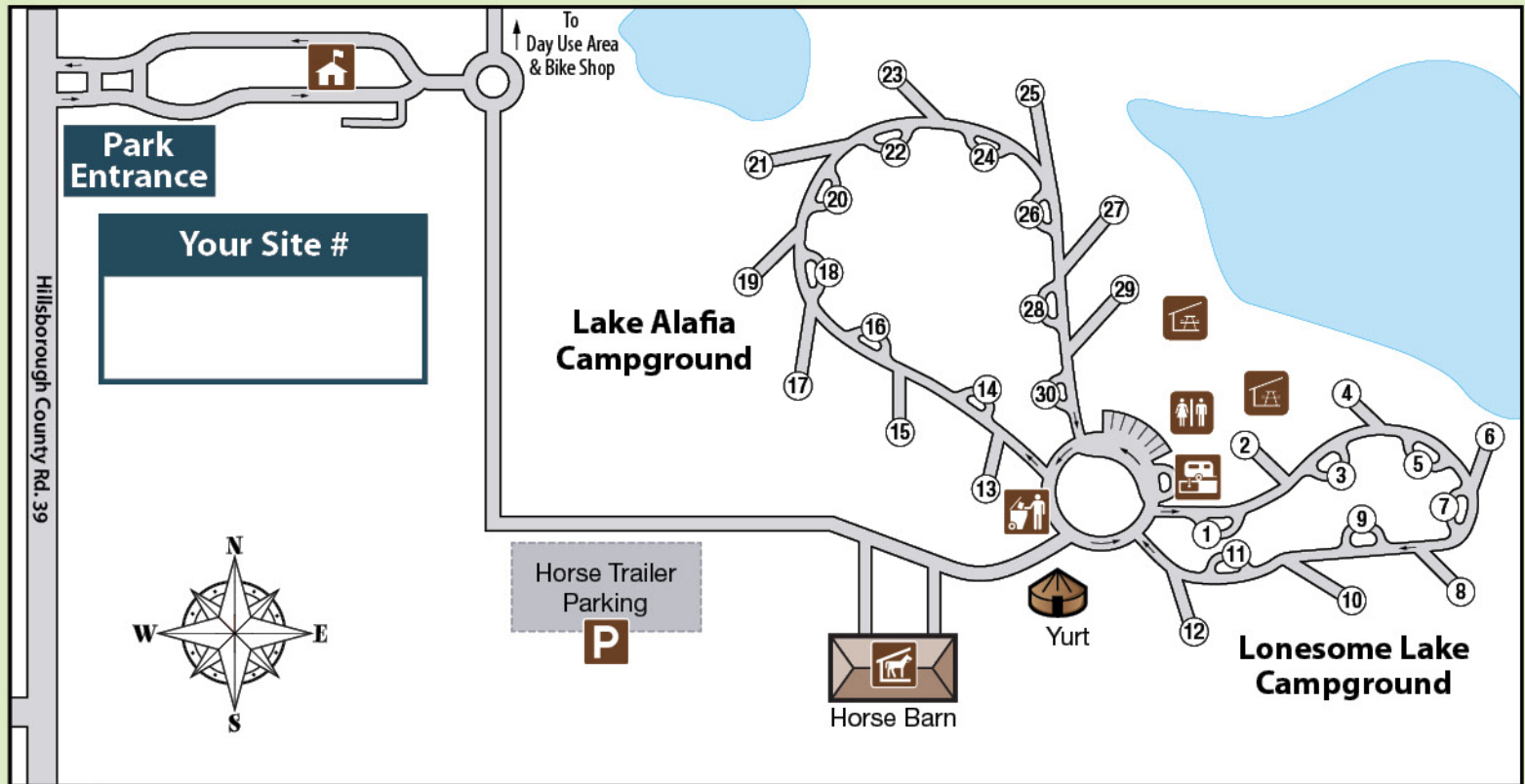


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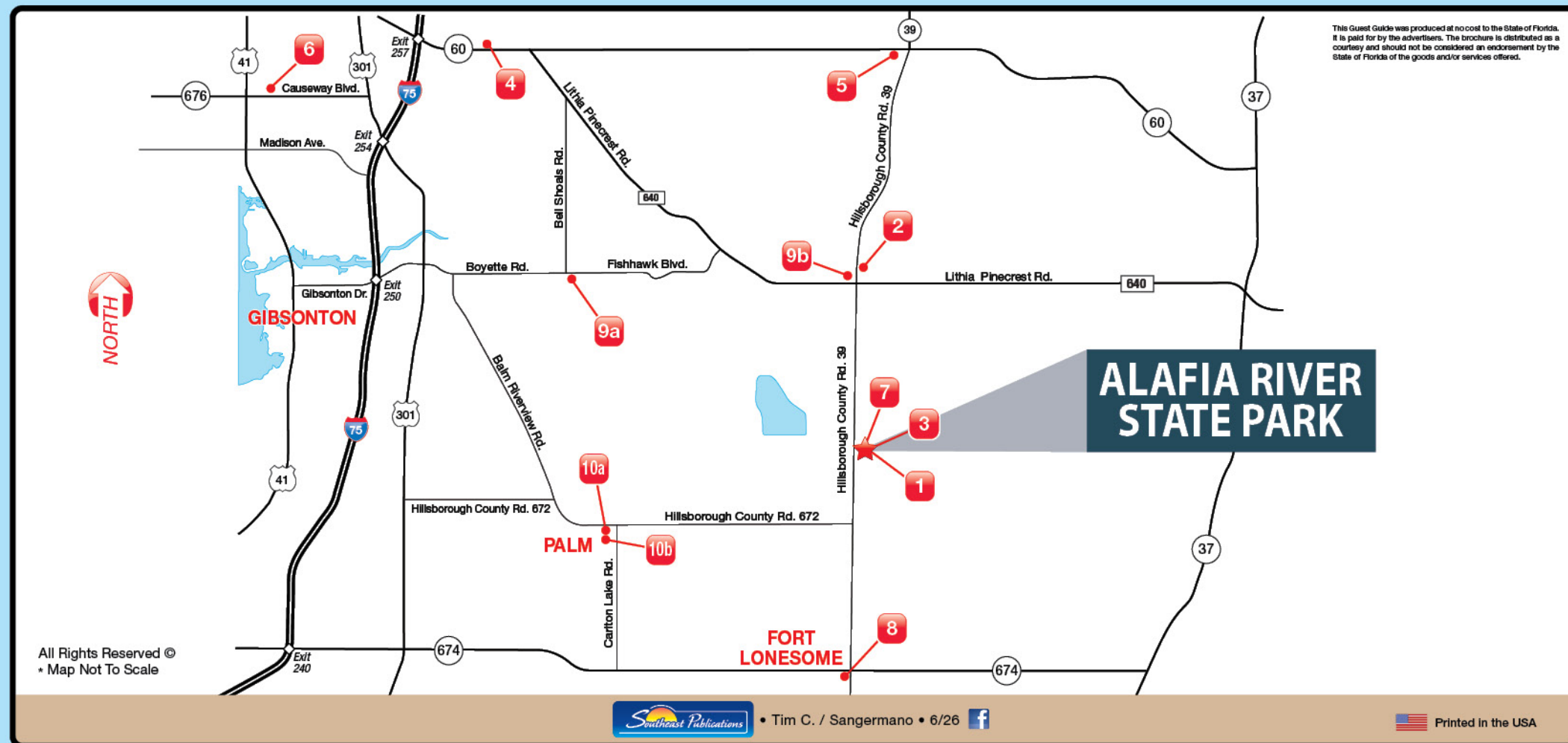
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Campground Rules

To ensure safety, convenience, and a quality outdoor experience for all campers, please observe the following regulations:

PARK HOURS: The park opens at 8:00 a.m. and closes daily at sunset. For after hours access a gate combination will be provided at the time of registration.

CHECKOUT TIME: All campers must vacate their campsite by 1:00 p.m. Please feel free to enjoy the rest of the park until closing time.

QUIET TIME is 11:00 p.m. - 8:00 a.m. Generators are not to be used.

MINORS: Persons under 18 years of age must be chaperoned by an adult. A minor out of camp after dark without a leader or chaperone is PROHIBITED.

PETS: Pets must be confined, leashed, or otherwise under the physical control of a person at all times. Pets are not to be left unattended in a campsite for more than 30 minutes. Owners will pick up after pets and properly dispose of all pet droppings.

FIREWORKS are PROHIBITED.

CAMPFIRES must be contained within the confines of ground grills.

FIREWOOD: Gathering wood within the park is PROHIBITED.

GRAY WATER: Gray water is treated as sewage and must be properly disposed of. The dump station is located near the restroom facilities.

HAMMOCKS: When connecting equipment to a tree you must use flat web straps a minimum of 1 inch wide where it comes in contact with the tree. Only connect to trees that are a minimum of 12 inches in diameter at chest height. Ropes, cords, nails, bolts or other attachment methods are prohibited.

BUFFER ZONES: In order to maintain the integrity of the campsites, please do not set up camping equipment, park vehicles, etc., in buffer zones between or behind campsites. If you are unsure whether or not your camping equipment is in breach, please seek assistance from a Park Ranger.

CAMPSITES will be limited to 8 people, 2 camping units and 2 passenger vehicles per site. All vehicles and camping rigs are to be located on asphalt pads and off grass. Only one rig which requires hookup to electricity or water will be allowed per site.

EXTRA CARS: Extra car/cars must check in at the Ranger Station. Extra vehicles that go over 2 vehicle limit can park in front of the bathhouse or by the horse trailer parking.

FEEDING OF WILDLIFE: For your safety and the health of the park animals, feeding the wildlife is PROHIBITED.

WATER USAGE: Activities that require excessive water use or that would cause drainage, flooding or erosion issues are not permitted. Examples of prohibited activities are use of pools or hot tubs, slip n slides and washing of campers or vehicles.

Park Rules

- Fireworks and hunting are prohibited inside the park.
- Alligators are abundant. Do not approach, tease, frighten or feed them. It is dangerous and causes them to lose their fear of people, requiring their destruction.
- The park is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- ATVs and dirt bikes are prohibited from use inside the park.
- No swimming inside the park.
- Florida Law requires all children under the age of 16 to wear a bicycle helmet. Helmets are recommended for all riders.
- Please obey posted speed limits.
- Golf carts on paved roads only.
- Trails close at sundown.

Pet Rules

- Florida law requires that pets be vaccinated against rabies.
- Pets must be kept on a six-foot, handheld leash and well-behaved at all times.
- Pets are not permitted on bike trails.
- Pets must not be left unattended or taken into restroom facilities or onto playground equipment.
- Due to the presence of alligators in all waters of the park, pet owners are urged to use caution.
- Service animals are welcome in all areas and buildings of the park, as required by law.
- Pet owners are required to pick up after their pets and properly dispose of all pet droppings in trash receptacles.
- Any pet that is noisy, dangerous, intimidating or destructive will not be allowed to remain in the park.
- Non-furbearing pets, such as reptiles, birds or fish, must be confined or under the physical control of the owner. Some animals may be prohibited on park property.
- In camping areas, do not leave tethered pets unattended for more than 30 minutes.
- No bathing pets in campground restrooms.
- Failure to abide by these rules may result in the camper being asked to board the pet outside the park or to leave the campground.
