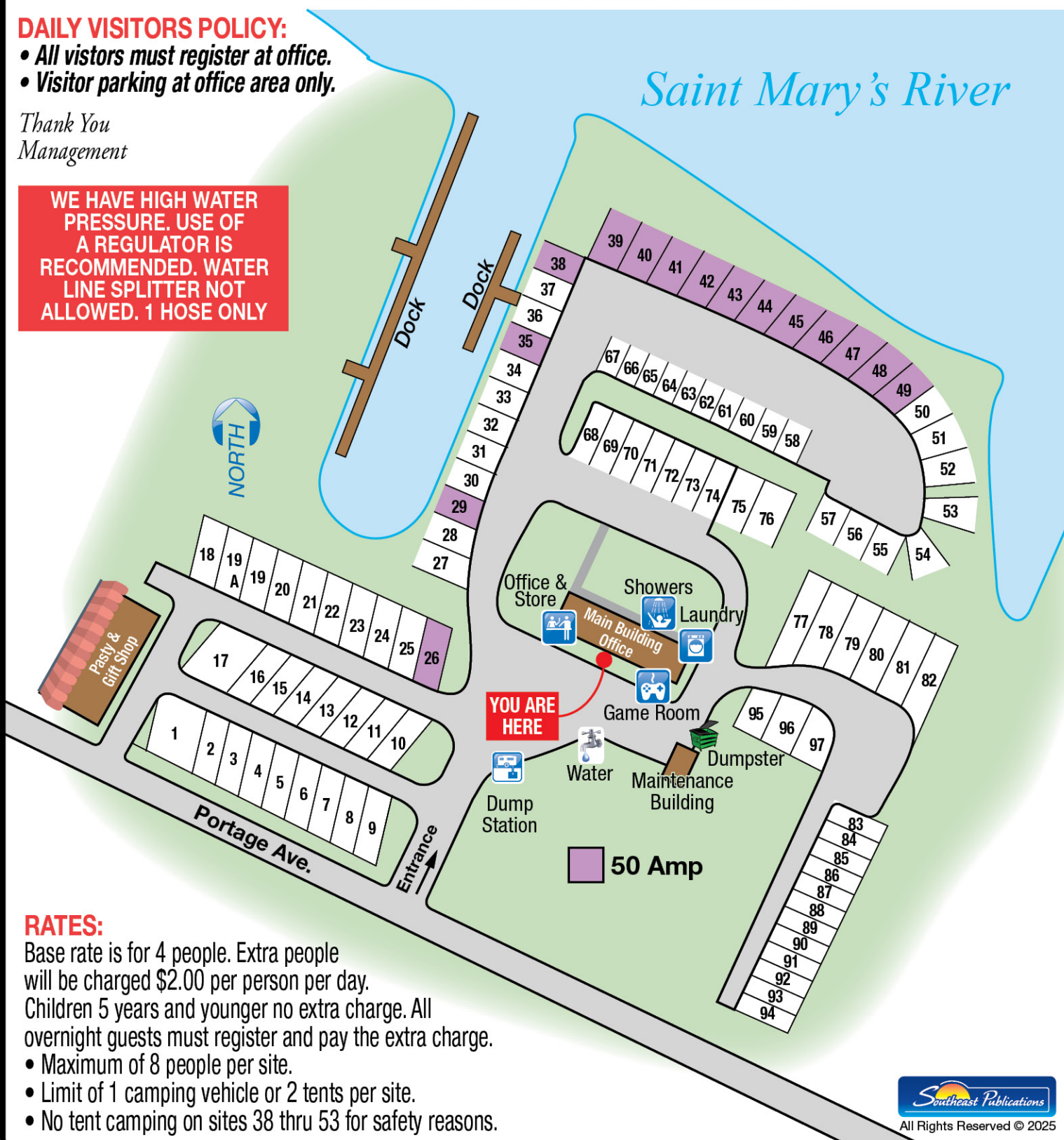

WE HAVE HIGH WATER PRESSURE. USE OF A REGULATOR IS RECOMMENDED. WATER LINE SPLITTER NOT ALLOWED. 1 HOSE ONLY



RATES:

Base rate is for 4 people. Extra people will be charged \$2.00 per person per day. Children 5 years and younger no extra charge. All overnight guests must register and pay the extra charge.

- Maximum of 8 people per site.
- Limit of 1 camping vehicle or 2 tents per site.
- No tent camping on sites 38 thru 53 for safety reasons.

PLEASE READ ALL RULES

DO REMEMBER TO FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES

- DO** re-register by 10:00am or check out by 12:00pm. Please be prompt - we take reservations for specific sites and if you are late leaving, you will be charged another day.
- DO** put all rubbish in plastic bags and leave in garbage containers.
- DO** accompany your children whenever they are at the dock or river.
- DO** accompany and stay with children under 6 using the restrooms.
- DO** observe our speed limit of 10 m.p.h.
- DO** leave any mail in the mailbox located in the office.
- DO** check our message board located in the office for your messages. Emergency messages will be delivered.
- DO** put gray water in sealed bucket and dump in dump station - State Law.
- DO NOT** come into the office building barefoot or wearing roller blades.
- DO NOT** put up clotheslines
- DO NOT** let children play on the rocks in the campground.

Please remember to check our bulletin board for daily activities and special events

PETS: We feel that your pet is a part of your family and is welcomed as such. You must pick up your dog droppings on your site and when walking your pet. Please place waste in dumpsters. **(State law requires you to keep your pet on a leash when walking or outside)** Pets not allowed in office, game room, bathrooms, showers or laundry. For those of you who do not wish to oblige, please leave your pet at home. Do not leave your pet tied outside or inside your camper, tent, etc. when you are not there.

ALL CANCELLED RESERVATIONS:
No refund for the first night stay and reservation fee.
Leave early. Forfeit one day's rent

NO EXCEPTIONS! NO CASH REFUNDS!
No transfers of deposits
Any refunds will be sent by mail

DO NOT FEED ANY BIRDS, WATERFOWL OR ANY STRAY ANIMAL: Wild or domestic. There is a city law which prohibits the feeding of geese, seagulls and ducks. Punishable by a \$500 Fine or 90 Days in Jail.

CURFEW: All children 16 years of age and younger must be at their campsite by 10:00 p.m. (Campground request and city ordinance) All children, especially little ones, must be supervised at all times. There can be a lot of traffic in and out of the campground. Small children can be difficult to see. Please remind children to play safely around the campground and buildings. Rocks and stairs are not to be played on. You are responsible for your camping family and visitors. Remember your neighbor for noise in the late hours.

SMOKING: Smoking will not be allowed in any part of office building, this includes store area, coffee room, game room, restrooms, shower rooms, and laundry room. There are butt buckets on each side of the building. - State Law

NO WASHING OF VEHICLES: No such washing is permitted. No water buckets or hoses. Damp sponges or towels may be used to clean windshields or lights only! **(if you don't comply to this rule you will be asked to leave)**

FIRE PITS: Fire pits are provided for the safe burning of your campfire. Do not use to burn garbage or other unburnable products. Keep your campfire safe!

BOAT DOCKS: Docks may be used at no extra charge on a first come basis to registered campers. **(No swimming allowed)**

CAMPSITES: Each camper is responsible for his or her campsite: This includes your personal property. If you are away from your campsite make sure anything of value is put in a safe place. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items. When your camping stay is over please give the site a quick once over and use dumpsters for any last minute garbage and pet droppings. Water pressure is 60- 80 lbs; please fix any leaking connections **(also, no dumping of gray water on the ground).**

PLEASE DO NOT: Give out our combination to the bathroom/shower door. This is for your own security.

We would encourage anyone walking at night to please use a flashlight, as the grounds may be unfamiliar in the darkness. Be safe - not sore!

All of us at The Soo Locks Campground want your stay here to be a pleasant experience. When you check in you will receive more information on our campground. We strive to provide a clean, safe, comfortable surrounding for all.

If there is anyone who is not complying with our rules and regulations, they will be asked to leave.
