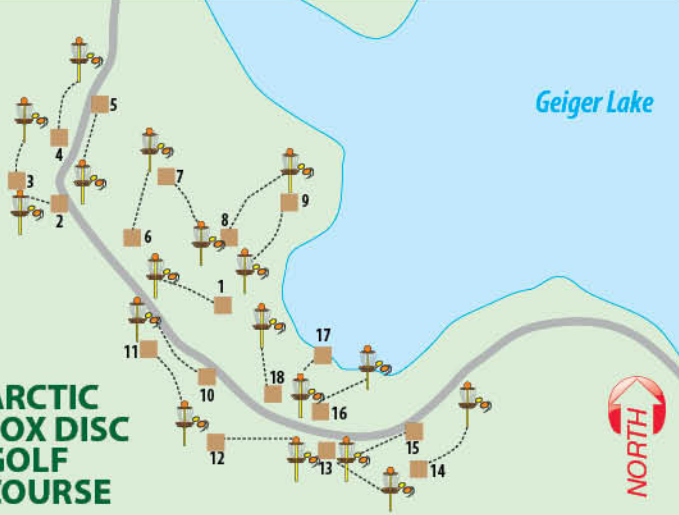

1. Boaters must abide by the Mississippi Boating Act of 1960 (including all revisions since its adoption) and the Alcohol Boating Safety Act of 1995.
 2. No Wake areas must be observed. Buoys and/or PVC pipe markers on the north end of the lake.
 3. No Wake on the Lake from 8 pm to 8 am.
 4. NO WAKE is intended to be trolling/idle speed only, as to not cause any wave action on the lake that may interfere with other lake users.
- Please clean up after your pets.
 - Pets must be on a leash at all times.
 - Golf carts: You must have a valid driver's license to operate.
 - NO drinking and driving.
 - NO more than 8 people per site.
 - NO washing Campers or Vehicles.
 - NO discharging of gray water on the ground.
- All guests & visitors are subject to entrance fee requirements.
 - Government issued ID is required upon check-in.
 - Camping rate (excluding primitive) includes but is not limited to fishing and boat launch Call Park and see Rule 1.2 General Rules and Regulations, Sections C and G for more information.
 - Standard – Water/Electricity/Sewer

- Premium – Full + Location
- Primitive – Tent only
- Reservable – Any day in the future
- 65+ /Disabled must show proof of age. Disabled must provide proof of 100% disability by showing one of the following:
 - Railroad Disability Letter stating "100% Disabled"
 - Veterans Administration Letter stating "100% Service Connected Disability"
 - Updated Social Security "TPQY" Form listing the person as "Disabled Individual"
