

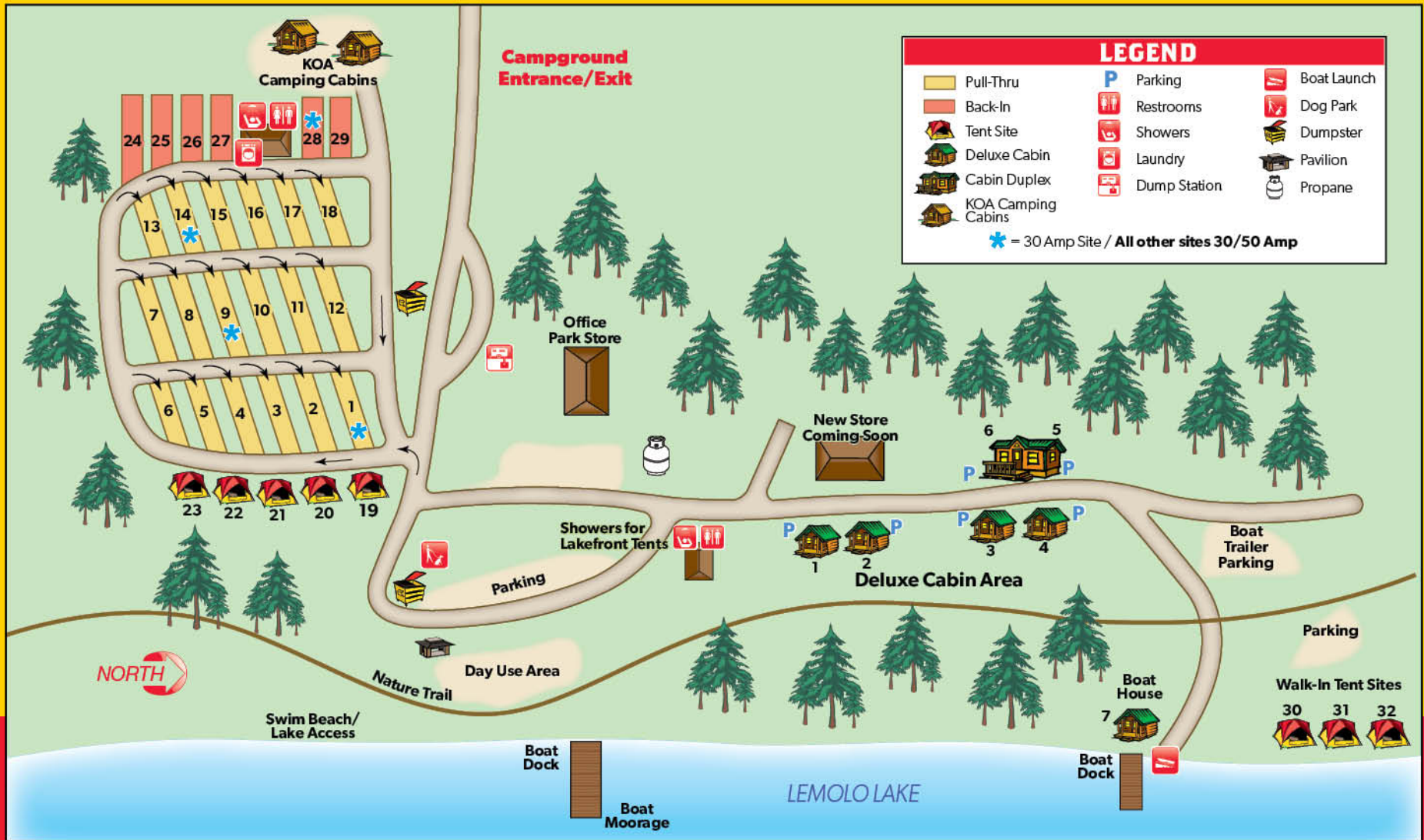

Located in the heart of Umpqua National Forest, far from civilization, but very close to nature and all the beautiful, relaxing, rejuvenating exploration that comes with it. Stop for a little while and enjoy both the quiet and the majestic, star-filled night sky after dark. It really does get dark here. Then plan your exploration of the National Park, waterfalls, lake and hiking/biking trails. We're here to help you explore.

Crater Lake National Park: The north entrance to Oregon's only national park is just 18 miles south (see map 1 below) and its unmatched beauty is a "must see" for anyone visiting the area. While the park is open year round, the north entrance is closed during the early part of each camping season due to snow.

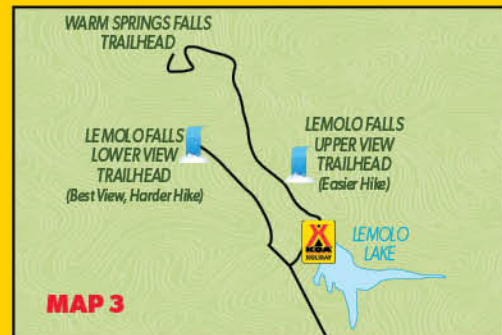
Fishing: Our campground sits on a beautiful mountain lake with 540 water acres for all types of boating and fishing enjoyment. It features fantastic views of Mount Thielsen and the surrounding hills. The lake is famous for its trophy-sized German Brown Trout, but also contains Kokanee and is stocked regularly with Rainbow Trout.

Hiking/Mountain Biking: In addition to a 10+ mile hiking/biking trail

surrounding our lake, the North Umpqua Trail is less than a mile from the campground and features some of the best hiking and mountain biking trails to be found.

Waterfalls: There are 6 beautiful waterfalls within 20 miles of the campground. All but one are 15-20 minute hikes or less from their trailheads, and many are "can't miss" waterfall hikes. See maps 2 & 3 below for locations of the trailheads.

Boat Rentals: We have both motorized and non-motorized boats for rent to get you out on the water including pontoon boats, 14' fishing boats, canoes, kayaks, pedal boats and paddle boards. Stop in the store for details, availability and pricing.

Guidelines for Everyone's Safety & Enjoyment

- **Check-In:** Tents & RVs 1:00 PM / Cabins 3:00 PM
- **Check-Out:** Tents & RVs 12:00 PM / Cabins 11:00 AM
Please check on availability by 11:00 AM if you want to stay longer.
- **Please observe** the 5½ MPH speed limit.
- **Quiet hours** are from 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM. No generators please.
- **Please use trash** and recycling receptacles located in the campground, in each cabin and next to the parking area for the walk-in tent sites.
- **Children** should be under adult supervision at all times.
- **Pets** are welcome as long as they are quiet, picked up after and leashed. Please do not EVER leave them unattended in RV or cabin.
- **Please DO NOT tie** anything to trees or shrubs.
- **Please use paths** and roads. Do not walk through other sites.
- **Fires** in Designated Fire Rings & Wood Completely inside Fire Rings Only!
- **ALL VISITORS/GUESTS MUST CHECK IN AT KOA OFFICE BEFORE ENTERING CAMPGROUND. NO VISITORS AFTER 10:00 PM.**
- **If anything needs attention, please tell us.**

Rules for Pet Owners

- Pets must be kept on a maximum 6 foot leash.
- Pets must be kept quiet at all times.
- Pets must never be left outdoors unattended.
- Owners - you must pick up after your pets wherever you go.
- Pets are not allowed in restrooms, store, laundry room or playground.
