Welcome to our park located in the beautiful Black Hills. Tonight you are camped on a historic site. The highway which brought you to the Campground, Highway 14A, was the route of the Deadwood to Cheyenne Stage Line from 1878 to 1885. The property on which you are camped is called Placer 601 which was filed by Charles Scott & John Crist in the Lost or Whitewood Mining District. The area was the site of the first mining camp in the Northern Hills called Gayville - named after William and Albert Gay. Gayville was in existence from 1875 until about 1914.

GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY & ENJOYMENT

Help everyone enjoy a pleasant and safe day by noting the following:

We have made every effort to provide our guests with a safe and enjoyable campground. However, all persons entering the campground do so at their own risk. The management is not responsible for damage, injury or loss to either person or property. Please notify the office if you encounter any problems while staying with us. If there is anything we can do to make your stay more enjoyable, be sure to let us know. **Failure to comply with campground rules and regulations may terminate your stay without refund.**

VEHICLES: You may have one camping vehicle (RV, van, tent) and one passenger vehicle (auto or truck) on your site. If you have extra vehicles, the office will be glad to assist you. All vehicles need a valid pass visibly displayed.

CHILDREN: Children under 14 are to be accompanied by an adult in the store, restrooms and pool area. Parents please supervise your children.

PETS: Pets are welcome! They must be kept quiet and on a leash. There is a Kamp K-9 park for off-leash play. Please clean up after your pets. Pets are NOT allowed in buildings, playground or pool area. DO NOT leave pets outside, tied down or unattended. Aggressive dogs are not allowed in the park.

GUESTS: Are welcome to visit between the hours of 8am and 10pm. Please check in at the office to register and receive day passes.

POOL AREA: For use by registered guest only. There is no lifeguard on duty. **SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.** Please no jumping, diving or horse play. Street clothes are not allowed in the pool or hot tub. Please obey all posted rules and dry off before entering the buildings.

CAMPFIRES: Fires are a constant danger in our area. Therefore, fires are to be confined to barbecue grills only using charcoal or propane only. **NO WOOD FIRES ARE ALLOWED.**

GARBAGE: Thank you for bagging and sealing your garbage and placing it in the trash dumpster located diagonally across the driveway from the office.

DISHWASHING: Sanitation laws prohibit washing of dishes or clothing in restrooms. A large sink is provided near both bath houses.

LAUNDRY: Laundry is available in the office building. Hours are posted. Please start your last load at least one hour before the posted closing time. Change machine available in the laundry room.
