HERKIMER DIAMOND MINES

The Herkimer Diamond Mine is open daily from April 5 - October 31. At our above-ground surface mine, you can search for beautiful double-terminated quartz crystals. Reservations are not required. Daily wristbands can be purchased at The Miners' Village. For more details visit HerkimerDiamond.com

KOA REGISTRATION HOURS

Spring and Fall: Daily 10:00am - 6:00pm

Summer: Daily 8:00am - 10:00pm

RESERVATIONS, DEPOSIT, CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

A credit card deposit equal to your first night stay is required.

To request a specific site number, there is a one-time, non-refundable \$25.00 "Select My Site" fee.

If you need to cancel your reservation, please call prior to these deadlines: RV/Tent sites - 48 hours, Cabins - 7 days, Lodges and Cottages - 2 weeks. Reservations canceled before these deadlines have a fee of \$10. Cancellations with less than these times will result in forfeiture of all deposits. Holiday and special events requiring a minimum 3-night stay are excluded; there will be no refunds.

MINIMUM STAY REQUIREMENTS

All sites have a 2-night minimum on weekends (Friday & Saturday) from May 1 - October 10.

There is a 3-night minimum on all holiday weekends: Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day.

PET POLICY

Herkimer Diamond Mines KOA Resort is a pet friendly campground. To ensure all of our guests have a safe and enjoyable time, please observe the following:

Dogs of any breed that are aggressive or bark excessively will be asked to leave the campground. Dogs must be kept on leashes no longer than 6 feet when outside. Do not leave a tethered dog unattended. Service dogs are welcomed although leash and behavior rules still apply. You are required to pick up after your animal. Pet fees apply to our lodging accommodations.

New York State Law: A copy of your pet's rabies certificate and vaccines valid for the duration of your stay must be presented at time of check-in.

SPLASH ALLEY

Fishing, tubing, wading, and kayaking in the West Canada Creek is permitted **AT YOUR OWN RISK**. Please be sure to watch your children. The West Canada Creek is subject to sudden water surges from the upstream power dam. Please be on alert for rising waters and quickly move to shore.

There are public access points for the creek at each end of our campground. Please refrain from crossing through other campers' sites while entering and exiting the water.

Fishing requires a New York State fishing license for anyone 16 or older.

RESORT FEE

Resort Fees allow us to offer exceptional amenities to our campers. Every guest has exclusive access to the Pool, Common Areas, West Canada Creek, Children's Play Area, Free Activities, Yard Games, Sports Equipment, and more.

WI-FI / PHONE SIGNAL

We provide free high-speed Wi-Fi throughout the campground. A number of factors impact its strength including weather conditions and usage load. We have provided tables and chairs near the registration office where the signal is strong. Cell phone connectivity varies based on provider.

CAMPGROUND RULES

Vehicles: Please follow directional signs and park only in designated areas. Please do not drive or park in grassy areas. All vehicles on property must be registered at the Main Office.

Tents: Tents are permitted on "Tent Sites" only. If you would like to add a tent to an RV or Lodging site, please call 315.891.7355 or email reservation@herkimerdiamond.com

Vehicle Washing: Vehicle and RV washing is not permitted.

Quiet Hours: Quiet Hours are 10:00pm - 8:00am. Unruly guests will be required to leave the Resort. No refunds will be issued.

Campfires: New York State Law: No firewood may be brought into any campground that is NOT harvested within a 50-mile radius of that campground. You may purchase a bundle of wood at the KOA Office or have it delivered to your site. Open fires are permitted in fire rings only. Please be sure your fire is out before retiring for the evening.

Speed Limit: The speed limit on the campground is 4 mph. Please help to keep our guests safe and to minimize dust.

Visitors: If you are expecting visitors during your stay, they must pay an entrance fee and register their vehicle at the Main Office.

Golf Carts: Golf cart rentals are available; reservations are recommended. If you wish to bring your own golf cart, please contact us. You must be 18 or older and provide a valid driver's license in order to operate any cart on the property. 2-stroke gas-powered golf carts are not permitted.

Pool: The pool will be open daily: Memorial Day - Labor Day, 10am - Sunset. There is NO lifeguard on duty. All children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

PERSONAL CODE OF CONDUCT

Alcohol is permitted for adults over 21. Illegal drugs are strictly prohibited. Inappropriate language and conduct will not be tolerated.

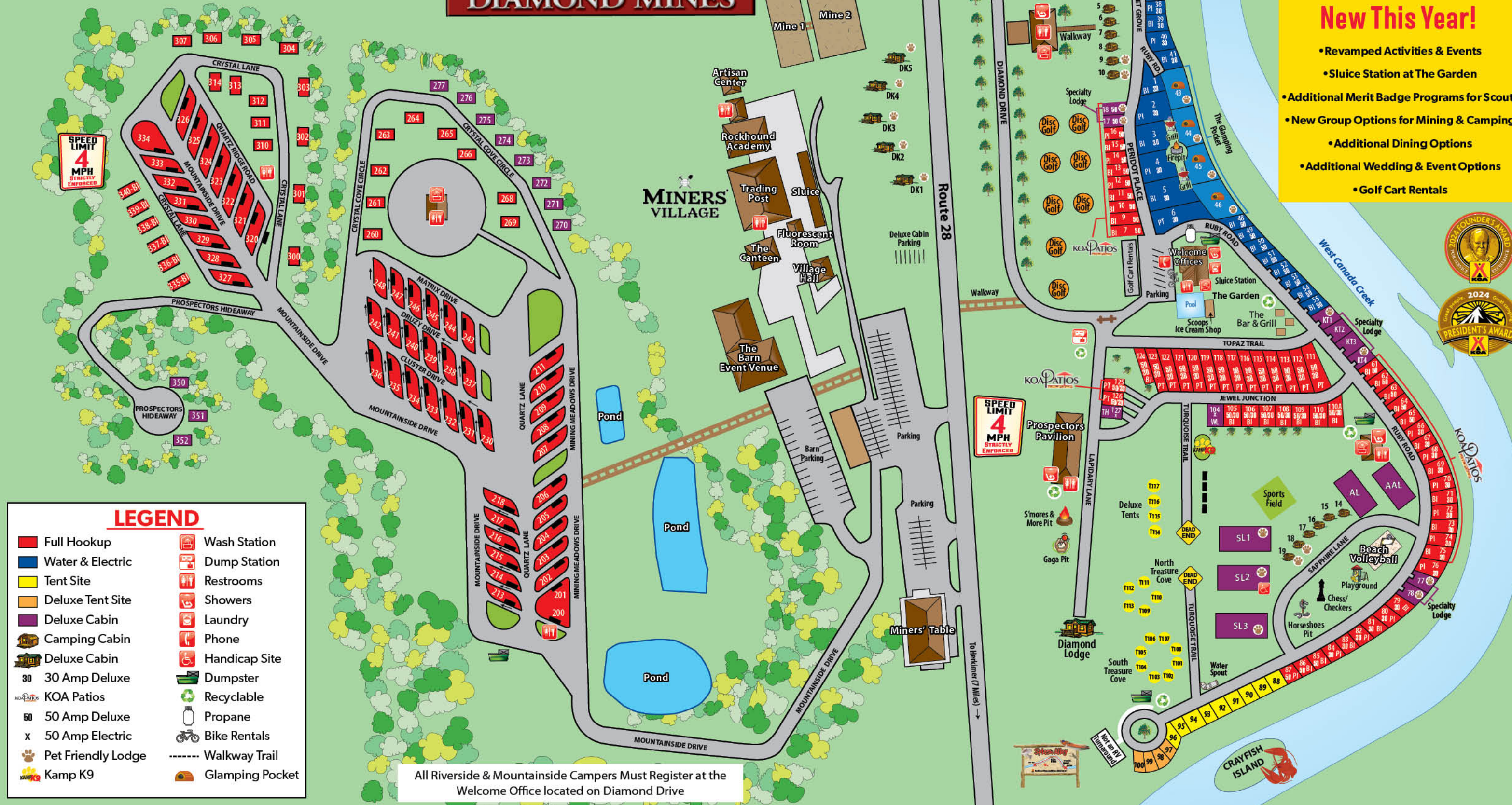
