



Campground Rules & Policies

- REGISTRATION** - Register upon arrival. Re-registration or check-out time is 11:00AM.
- SPEED LIMIT** - Posted speed is 5 MPH in the park at all times and strictly enforced. Please do not drive through sites. No parking on grass.
- PARKING YOUR RV** - If we are not there to help you park, please follow the instructions upon registration and according to the flow of traffic. **Parking in an opposing direction or crosswise in a site is not permitted.**
- SIDE BY SIDES** are to be driven in & out of the park only.
- QUIET HOURS** - FROM 9:00PM to 8:00AM. All persons under 18 years of age must be back at their site by dark unless accompanied by an adult. Generators are not to be operated in the park at any time.
- GROUNDS** - Please keep your site clean. Tarps are not allowed. No cigarette butts on the ground. **Our trees can be fragile, please do not climb, tie or suspend anything from the limbs** without the approval of management.
- WASHING OF CARS OR RVs IS NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME.**
- TRASH** - There are bins marked on your site map. **DO NOT** put your site trash in bathroom, laundry or pool receptacles.
- NO SMOKING** in any room, building or pool area.
- RESTROOMS** - Open 24 hours for your convenience. **Cleaning hours are from 11:00AM to 1:00PM daily.** Children under 16 years of age should be escorted to and from the restrooms. **PLEASE NOTE: WE ARE ON A SEPTIC SYSTEM. ONLY TOILET TISSUE SHOULD BE FLUSHED.** Diapers should NOT be disposed of in bathroom toilet or trash. Please use outside trash bins.
- POOL** - **NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.** Enjoy the pool safely and at your own risk. Pool rules are strictly enforced: **No one under 14 years of age in the pool area unless accompanied by an adult. Absolutely NO DIVING, RUNNING, JUMPING or HORSEPLAY allowed.** Be respectful of others and keep noise to a minimum. Read posted pool rules prior to entering water. Children in diapers are not allowed in water. Proper swim wear only. Floors are slippery when wet. Please dry off before entering restrooms, laundry or office. Registered guests only.
- PETS** - **ALL DOGS AND CATS MUST BE UNDER CONTROL AND ON A LEASH (6' MAX) AT ALL TIMES IN THE PARK.** Our Dog Park area has been created to allow your pet to run freely. Implements are provided in this area for clean-up. **"Accidents" around the site should be cleared up immediately. Your pets are not to be left unattended around vehicles, or tied to trees or campground equipment.** Pets are not allowed in playground, rec hall, laundry, kitchen, restrooms or pool areas. Excessive barking or vicious animals will not be tolerated at any time.
- REFUND POLICY** - Campers have one hour after registration to leave with a refund if unhappy with accommodations. No refunds for non-cooperative weather. Refunds during holiday weekends or special event days will not be granted.
- WE RESERVE THE RIGHT** - Rules of good camping and good citizenship are always in effect. **Failure to abide by the rules and policies will be taken as non-compliance and you may be asked to leave, without a refund.**

Tombstone's Historic District

Boothill Cemetery
 Boothill Cemetery was laid out as a burial plot in 1878 and used until around 1884. This plot of ground, more than any other, tells the tale of Tombstone's history.

Bird Cage Theater
 The Bird Cage was the most famous honky-tonk in America between 1881-1889. The New York Times referred to it as the wildest, wickedest night spot between Basin Street and the Barbary Coast. The entertainment ranged from nightly can-can dancers to risqué performances to national headliners such as Eddie Foy, Lotta Crabtree and a host of others. It is Tombstone's only historic landmark in its original state.

Accommodations

RV Sites
 Our RV Sites come with full hook-ups (water, sewer and electric). Most sites are convenient pull-thru sites with picnic tables and BBQ grills. Fire rings are available upon request.

Big Nose Kate's
 The Grand Hotel, now known as Big Nose Kate's Saloon, was the largest building on Allen Street and considered one of the most elegant hotels in the area. The Grand Hotel played host to the Earps, the Clantons, and the McLaurys from the infamous OK Corral gunfight.

The majority of our daily sites are convenient pull-thru sites while our monthly spots are mostly back-in spots with just beautiful high desert behind you. Monthly sites are individually metered so you only pay for the electricity you use!

Tents
 We have a number of beautiful tent sites. These are dry sites (no electricity or sewer). Fire rings are available upon requests. Some sites do have water, BBQ grills and picnic tables.

Cowboy Motel
 Motel rooms are furnished with one queen bed, refrigerator, microwave oven, coffee pot and TV. Linens and towels are provided.

Tombstone Courthouse
 Built in 1882 at an approximate cost of \$50,000, it served Cochise County until 1929 when the county seat was moved to Bisbee. In 1959, it became an Arizona State Historical Park, housing an extensive collection of artifacts honoring Tombstone's historic beginnings.

Reservations for cabins and motel rooms are only available by phone. Cabins and motel rooms are not rented on a monthly basis.

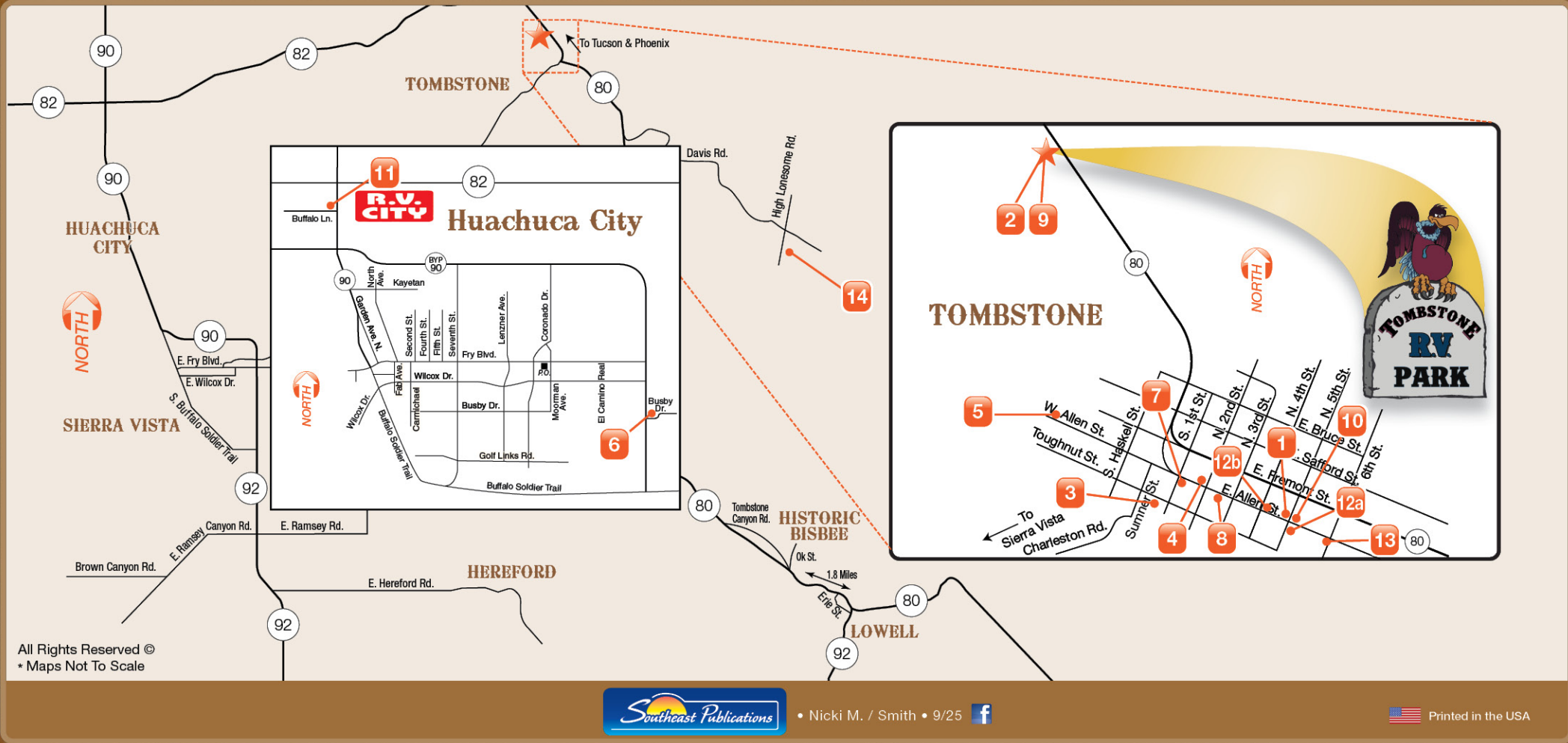
