

## RESERVATION POLICY

- Reservations are available at the Park District Office beginning the first business day of the year for the upcoming camping season only.
- All reservations require a deposit of the first night's fee and must be received within 7 days of making the reservation or it will be cancelled.
- A deposit shall hold one stay. A stay is defined as any night or continuous nights of camping.
- Reservations only guarantee the availability of the site for the days and nights reserved. Early arrivals/late departures are subject to site availability.
- Maximum stay on one site is 14 nights.
- Any camper who has a reservation and does not show up on the check-in date, and has not contacted the Park District office, forfeits the deposit and the entire reservation.
- Camping Fees for your entire stay are to be paid at the time of check-in unless paid in advance.
- Anyone making a reservation must be an adult (18 years or older), on the site at all times and that person is responsible for the actions of anyone underage on the site.
- Check-in time is 12:00 noon and check-out time is 12:00 noon. If you need to check in prior to that time or check-out late, you must receive approval from the Park District Office. Early check-in or late check-out may be subject to an additional fee.

## CANCELLATION POLICY

- Absolutely **NO REFUNDS** will be issued for any reason.
- Park District credit will be issued if cancellation is made within 14 days of your check-in date only. Credit may be used towards a future stay at our Campground.
- Canceling less than 14 days prior to your check-in will result in forfeiture of deposit and all fees paid in advance.
- No refunds will be issued for inclement weather, the condition of your site due to the weather, or if the Aquatic Center is not able to be open. We cannot control these issues.

## CAMPGROUND RULES

- All Campers must register at the Office or with the Ranger upon arrival to receive your camping permit and vehicle pass.
- Campers must have their permit displayed during your entire stay on the electric box.
- Only 1 vehicle pass in the windshield. Additional vehicles must be parked in a parking lot.
- No vehicle or camper is to be parked on the grass on any of the numbered sites. Any damage/ruts made by you or your guests are your responsibility.
- All sites are back-ins. Campers are not permitted to drive thru the grass in order to pull thru their site. Campers are not permitted to be parked sideways on the gravel pad.
- Electric sites can accommodate 2 tents or 1 camper and 1 tent. Units must be a distance of 15 ft apart.
- Maximum of 5 people per permit allowed. (Including children) Additional persons will be charged \$2.00 each per night.
- Maximum of 2 pets allowed per site. Pets must be leashed at all times and owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets. We do not allow any vicious breeds of dogs in our Campground. Pets must be up-to-date on all shots and have proof of rabies (if necessary).
- Pets are not allowed in any of our bathhouses or restroom facilities and bathing of pets in the campground is prohibited.

- Do not leave a pet unattended at your campsite. If your pet is loud or causing a bother to other campers, you will be asked to remove it from the premises.
- Quiet time is 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM. If you or your group can be heard from an adjacent site, then you are too loud. You will only be warned ONCE.
- All visitors must leave the Park by 12:00 midnight. Park District is closed from 12:00 midnight to 6:00 AM. Please be on your site by midnight.
- Radios are permitted, however they must be at a level not to be heard by other sites.
- Each electric site has 1 fire ring and 1 picnic table. These are NOT permitted to be moved to other areas. Fire rings are to remain in the same location to avoid many burn spots on the sites.
- Campfires must be contained within the provided fire rings and fires may not reach a height above knee level. All fires must be completely extinguished before leaving the campground.
- You may bring your own firewood, provided you are not transporting it from one of the quarantined counties. No burning of pallets or other materials containing nails, screws, paint, etc. will be permitted.
- No tree or shrub may be cut or trimmed at any time in the Campground. Do not fasten anything to any tree with a nail, screw, or rope.
- All sites are 30 amp with the exception of sites 66 and 67, which are 50 amp. Electric boxes are varying distances from sites. Please bring long cords if you are unsure of the distance for your particular site.
- No direct water hook-up is permitted. Please turn off water hydrants after use.
- Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children at all times. No child under the age of 10 is permitted in the bathhouse without adult supervision.
- Children may ride bicycles on any of our bike paths and in our Campground. Please keep bicycles off of main roads, intersections, and out of building entrances. Bike racks must be used where provided. All bikes must be back to your campsite by dusk.
- All campground roads are ONE-WAY and have a 15 MPH speed limit. Anyone not obeying these rules will be asked to leave with no refund.
- No firearms, fireworks, pellet guns, paintball guns, air rifles, slingshots, or weapons of any kind permitted on the premises.
- No motorized scooters, golf carts, or ATV's permitted in Campground or on bike paths.
- Sites must be left clean and trash placed in dumpsters (located at exit of campgrounds) before checking out.
- Smoking is not permitted in the bathhouse at any time.
- Firewood is available from the office during business hours or from the ranger station at their discretion. Please try to purchase from the office, if possible.
- Gray water may only be disposed of at designated locations or at the dump station.
- When arriving and departing your campsite, please be courteous of others and do not cut through other campsites. Use designated roadways.
- Please report any problems with the Park Rangers, located across from the bathhouse. Any issue that can wait until morning, please do so.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited anywhere on Park District grounds.
- Management reserves the right to refuse service to, or remove from the premises, anyone whose conduct may be deemed improper for our family-oriented facility.
