Welcome to Sebasticook Lake Campground

CAMPGROUND RULES and INFORMATION

- Speed limit within the campground is 5 mph. This is strictly enforced and applies to golf carts as well. We have speed bumps to slow traffic. You are not allowed to avoid speed bumps.**
- All visitors must register at the office and obtain a visitor car pass. Guests are required to pay the applicable fee or you can have their fee charged to your account or pre-pay. The person renting the site is responsible to be sure ALL guests register at the office and that they obey these rules while a guest in the campground. Day visitors are \$5.00 per day and \$10.00 per night plus tax. If your guest fails to stop and register your account will automatically be charged \$20.00 per person. Any vehicle without a valid campground tag will be towed at owner's expense.***PLEASE NOTE: ALL GUESTS NOT SPENDING THE NIGHT MUST LEAVE BEFORE 10 PM or you will be charged the extra for them as a overnight guest to your site.***
- Only 2 vehicles per site. These vehicles MUST BE PARKED ON YOUR SITE AND NOT IN THE ROAD. If they don't fit within your site, please park them at the designated parking areas. Any vehicle without a valid car tag will be towed at owner's expense.
- We do allow non-aggressive dogs. **PETS MUST BE ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES** as per Title 7- MRSA § 3911 in accordance to the Maine Leash Dangerous Nuisance Dogs. Please keep your dog(s) quiet and **PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR PETS. Not cleaning up after your pet will result in eviction without refund. You must have poop bags with you at all times when leaving your site to walk your dog. Dogs are not allowed to defecate in the woods. No pets allowed in pool areas or in any building.** Management reserves the right to refuse or evict any animal that poses a threat to other campers at any point during your stay. Pet owners will be charged for any damages done to campsite by their pet. The campground owners and managers are not to be held responsible for any damages or injuries caused by one's pet. Proof of vaccinations should be readily available if needed. Children should not walk dogs they can't handle. *** **Day Guest are not allowed to bring pets with them and if they arrive with a pet they will not be allowed into the campground ******
- All alcoholic beverages are to be kept at your own campsite and covered at all times.** Disorderly conduct, drunkenness, illegal drug use or obscene language will not be tolerated and will result in immediate eviction without refund.
- Fireworks are strictly prohibited.
- Boats and hauling trailers must be kept at your campsite or you must obtain a trailer tag at the office to place in storage area if space is available. Any trailer in storage area not registered at office with a tag will be towed at owner's expense.
- Pool: Children under 14 years of age MUST be accompanied by an adult present in the pool area! Entry into the pool must be done via the ladder or stairs, no food or drink in the pool areas. Please take all of your belongings when leaving pool areas. Read all pool rules before entering. **Swim at your own risk; no lifeguard on duty at the pool or lake.** Please be aware of your surroundings and of boat traffic.
- Please keep fires contained to the designated fire ring. Please observe your surroundings and keep a water source nearby. At times of extreme dryness and drought, fires may be prohibited. Do not leave food containers in burn ring overnight; this attracts animals. **** Do not move fire ring****
- No bike riding after dusk unless your bike has a working headlight.
- Boats, canoes, kayaks and jet skis are not allowed on the beach and there is no tying to the dock unless to load and unload and person must be present at all times. All personal boats, canoes and kayaks can be left at your site or under the trees near beach 2; any boat, canoe or kayak left on the beach will be removed by management and a fee of \$100. 00 will be charged each time to obtain it back.
- Check-in is 1:00 PM for campsites and 3:00 PM for cabins. Check-out is 11:00 AM for campsites and 10:00 AM for cabins. Absolutely no early check-in is allowed without prior approval from management.
- Restroom/Shower: No Smoking in either building. Adults must accompany children to restrooms and showers. No washing of clothes or dishes in restroom sinks. ****NO WASHING OF DOGS IN RESTROOMS/SHOWERS. NO PETS IN RESTROOMS/SHOWER.** Do not dispose of food in the wash sink drain. NO food in restroom trash, place in outside barrel.
- There is no washing of trailers, cars, trucks or motorcycles, please go to the local car wash.
- Violation of these rules will result in the violator being ejected pursuant to 30-A MRSA § 3838 or 3837.
