

# POINTS OF INTEREST

- Madam Carroll The largest boat operating on an inland waterway in Indiana.
- Sportsman Inn Purchased in 1934 by late Roy Conrad from a group of Chicagoans who had gone bankrupt in The Depression.
- Tioga Bridge Built in 1890, it is the longest Whipple Truss Bridge in Indiana. It qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places.
- Monticello City Park The park was built by the Works Progress Administration in 1935-38. Playground, picnic and walking facilities are located in this lovely shaded area.
- South School Building One of Monticello's first public schools. The building presently serves as the superintendent's office. The school is on the National Registry of Historic Places.
- Forbis Hotel The original three story, twenty-two room hotel was the focal point for the traveling salesman doing business in Monticello. It was built in the 1890's.
- White County Historical Museum Formerly a Carnegie Public Library built in 1905. The museum is open to the public and admission is free.
- Thread Mill Did John Dillinger really rob the Thread Mill on June 24, 1933? William Shaw who was taken into custody for the robbery claimed his partner in crime was the notorious Depression era public enemy number one.
- Old Monticello Cemetery These grounds contain the graves of many of White County's first settlers.
- Monticello Dam Dating back to the mid-1800's, the dam was one of the first attempts to harness the power of the Tippecanoe River.
- Bluewater Beach This public beach was deeded to the city in 1934.
