

RV & TIPI CAMP RULES & REGULATIONS

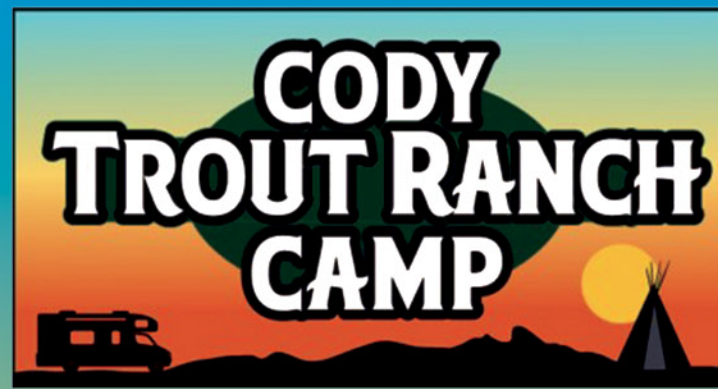
Please have fun and help ensure that your stay is safe and comfortable by complying with the following Rules and Regulations. We hope you enjoy your stay.

- REGISTRATION:** Upon arrival, please register with the front office. All facilities in this park/campground are for registered guests only. Site fees are for 2 adults per RV and 4 people for the tips. Children 7 and under are free. The fee for additional guests 8 to 17 is \$1.50, and over 18 is \$3.00 per night. All rents are non-refundable.
- DISCOUNTS:** We offer AAA, AARP, Military, 1st Responders, and Good Sam discounts. All discounts must be applied at check-in and appropriate card or ID must be present. No retroactive discounts will be given. Could change depending on office hours.
- CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT:** Check-in time is between 2:00 pm – 8:00 pm. Check-out time is not later than 11:00 am for both the RVs and tips. Please contact the registration office before 9:00 am if you wish to extend your stay (a day rate may be charged for late departures). Every effort will be made to extend your stay, dependent upon availability. Early check outs for RVs must inform the office no later than 48 hours before early check out date.
- SPEED LIMIT:** For the safety of all guests, the speed limit is 5 M.P.H. throughout the park/campground and is enforced.
- QUIET HOURS:** Quiet hours are 10:00 pm to 8:00 am. Loud, objectionable noise is not allowed at any time. Please be considerate of others. Inconsiderate guests will be asked to leave. Public intoxication, obscene language, and being outside without clothing will not be tolerated. We are a drug-free park/campground. Management reserves the right to require any guest to vacate the park/campground for any behavior that disturbs other guests.
- WI-FI:** Wi-Fi does not reach the tipis, but does reach the RV campground. If tipi guests need to use the wi-fi, the coffee house remains open for use at all times. The wi-fi login and password are on the bulletin board inside the coffee house.
- WI-FI ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY:** Cody Trout Ranch Camp provides free wi-fi access to its guests. In compliance with acceptable use policies, we ask that our service not be used for any of the following: illegal or fraudulent use, copyright or trademark infringement, threats or harassment, harm to minors, spamming, hacking, system disruption, impersonation or forgery, abuse of new groups, excessive use of bandwidth, viruses, etc.
- RVs:** Only well-kept RVs are allowed in the park/campground. All units must have sleeping facilities, window coverings and approved electrical, water & sewer hookups. We do not allow sleeping in cars, tents, or dead storage trailers at the RV sites. Management reserves the right to refuse admission of RVs not meeting park standards. RV guests are NOT allowed down the road that leads to the tipis. This is for the paying tipi guests ONLY!
- VISITORS:** Registered guests entertaining visitors are responsible for their conduct and liable for any damages they may cause while in the park/campground. Please inform them of our Rules & Regulations. Please have visitors park in overflow parking area.
- CHILDREN:** We are a family-friendly park/campground and encourage all to take advantage of the wonderful amenities offered at the Cody Trout Ranch Camp. Please remember children are not the responsibility of other residents or management. Parents are fully responsible for the acts and conduct of their children, financial or otherwise. Children under 16 MUST be accompanied by an adult while in the pond area and along the river. All parents renting a tipi along the river should be diligent with regards to the safety of their children.
- PETS:** Well-behaved pets are welcome; all others are not. Pets must be cared for at all times and MUST be on a leash, (e-leash is okay) while within the park/campground. Pets are to be kept inside at night and not allowed to be a nuisance to others at any time. Pets are NOT to be left in your tipi unattended. Pets are not allowed in any park/campground buildings or pond area. There is a pet area provided to exercise your pet. We ask that you please pick up after your pet. Management reserves the right to require any misbehaved pets to leave the park/campground.
- SEWER CONNECTIONS:** A sealed, airtight connection is required. DO NOT put any sewer hose down the sewer as it will cause a blockage.
- TRASH:** RV guests, please place trash in plastic bags and put them in one of the black dumpsters near the community fire pit. Tipi guests, please place trash in plastic bags and put it in the garbage can near the tipis. Cigarette butts are trash and should not be discarded on the property grounds; use designated receptacles.
- LAUNDRY:** Laundry rooms are for guest convenience. Please clean out dryer lint traps after use and help keep room clean. Laundry soap is available in the office, for purchase.
- CAMPFIRES & BARBECUES:** Wood-burning campfires are ONLY permitted in designated community campfire rings; please use common sense for safety purposes and do not cause any fire damage to the site area. Firewood is provided for the community fire pit gatherings. Outside portable propane and charcoal barbecues are permitted, please do not place on picnic tables, as they will melt. Burning real wood at the grills located next to each tipi is NOT permitted; only charcoal is acceptable for these grills. Guests will be charged if real wood is used in the grills.
- SITE:** Fire laws prohibit storage of materials under or around RVs. Only legitimate outside patio furniture is allowed. Altering or digging into a site is not permitted. Sites MUST be kept neat and clean at all times.
- TROUT POND:** There is NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. NO Swimming Allowed. Children under 16 years of age must be under the direct supervision of an adult while in the Trout Pond areas and river front. This is the guest's responsibility, and all risks are that of the guest and their party. Staff is not available for supervision. There is to be NO glass whatsoever in the Trout Pond area and smoking is NOT permitted in this area. Trout Pond hours are during the park/campground Office Hours, unless otherwise

posted or arranged in advance. All users must abide by the posted rules. This is the only pond that has public access. The river where the tipis are located is for the paying tipi guests ONLY. All other property outside of the tipi road and RV grounds is private property and trespassing will not be permitted.

- RIVER FRONT:** Due to our insurance regulations, the swiftness of the river and inherent danger, there is NO swimming or wading allowed in the river, at any time.
- NOT ALLOWED IN PARK/CAMPGROUND:** All motorized vehicles must be currently licensed. Generators are to be used only in the event of a power outage. Auto work is not allowed in the park/campground. Smoking is not allowed inside park/campground buildings or tipis (including bathrooms). Unauthorized soliciting or selling is not allowed in the park/campground. Clotheslines are not allowed due to safety hazard. NO discharge of firearms within the campground due to safety concerns. NO fireworks are allowed to be set off anywhere on the property.
- TIPIS & MISSING TIPI ITEMS:** Tipis are not to be changed and the smoke hole flaps at the top are to be left in the same position they were in upon arrival. If they are opened, a fee will be charged for the time taken to re-position and close them once you leave. If there are any missing items from the tipis found after check-out, the guest will be responsible to pay for the cost of replacing those items.
- EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES POLICY:** No refund will be given for any reason that is caused by natural conditions (rain, snow, wind, disease, etc.).

NOTE: This park/campground is privately owned. Violations of any Rules & Regulations, or anti-social behavior which may or may not be covered within these Rules & Regulations may result in eviction from the park/campground. We reserve the right to enforce our rules and to refuse to register any undesirable guests or RVs. Management is not responsible for loss due to fire, theft, vandalism, or any other means nor are they responsible for accidents. Guests are responsible for any damage they may cause to park property, including utility pedestals, water spigots, trees and outlets.
