Camping Rules & Regulations:

- ENFORCEMENT: Park staff have the authority to enforce all park rules and regulations and assign campsites. Failure to abide by park rules and regulations can lead to temporary or permanent exclusion or prosecution.
- All Golf carts must be registered with park office prior to operation on park property and a valid permit must be displayed at all times and be operated by a licensed driver without restrictions. Golf carts are not permitted on trails.
- Campers may have either one trailer/RV and one tent, or two tents per RV site.
- Each RV campsite may accommodate a maximum of six people or one family.
- A maximum of four people (or one family) may occupy a primitive tent site, with only one tent allowed per site.
- Off-road vehicles, including UTVs, ATVs, and dirt bikes, are not permitted.
- Check-in between 2:00 pm and 9:00 pm
- Check-out by 12:00 pm.
- Campsite changes must be approved by park staff.

- The maximum stay on a campsite is 14 nights. For information on extended stay policies, please consult park staff.
- Cancellation fees apply based on the notice provided. Please visit our website for details.
- Storage of RVs, campers, or boat trailers is not permitted.
- Campers must be at least 21 years old to register a campsite and must remain present for the duration of the stay.
- Quiet Hours: 10:00 pm – 7:00 am. Strictly Enforced.
- Fireworks are not permitted.
- All fires must be confined to designated grills or fire rings. Moving of fire rings is not permitted.
- Long term camping is not permitted.

The management and staff of Allison Creek Park sincerely thank you for choosing to stay with us. Our mission is to create a welcoming and enjoyable camping experience for all our guests. We look forward to welcoming you back to our park!

Pet Rules: Pets must be kept on a leash or under physical restraint at all times. Owners may be required to remove pets that are noisy, aggressive, or pose a threat. Pets are not permitted in swimming

areas or park facilities. Pet owners are responsible for any damages caused by their pets. For your convenience, pet waste stations are located throughout the park for proper disposal of pet waste.

Unlawful Acts include (but are not limited to) the following:

- Conducting or soliciting business within the park or its facilities is prohibited unless authorized by the Department. Additionally, distributing, posting, placing, or erecting any notices, advertisements, or similar materials is not allowed without prior consent from the Department.
- Destroying, defacing, disturbing, or removing any part of any building, sign, structure or equipment.
- Destroying, cutting, removing, defacing, damaging, or collecting any tree, shrub, plant, rock, mineral, or geological feature is prohibited unless authorized by a permit.

- Dumping refuse, waste, or gray water from trailers or vehicles is prohibited except in designated receptacles or disposal areas.
- Operating vehicles recklessly, exceeding posted speed limits, or driving in areas not designated for vehicular traffic is prohibited.
- Consuming or displaying any alcoholic beverages, including beer and wine, or controlled substances in public is prohibited.
- Engaging in disorderly behavior or making noise that disturbs or annoys others is prohibited.
